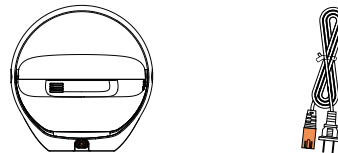
Remote Control



First Use

Step1

Take the projector out of the packing box, remove the packaging bag, place the projector on an ordinary horizontal table, plug in the power cord provided with the machine, and then turn on the AC power. At this point, the indicator light on the projector panel will turn white.



Step2

Press the power button on the projector or the power-on key on the remote control to start the projector. At this point, the lens lights up, the indicator light on the panel goes off, and the projector starts up and enters the startup wizard interface.

Step3

According to the startup guide, set the projection mode, language, connect to the Wi-Fi network, and enter the HOME page of the projector.

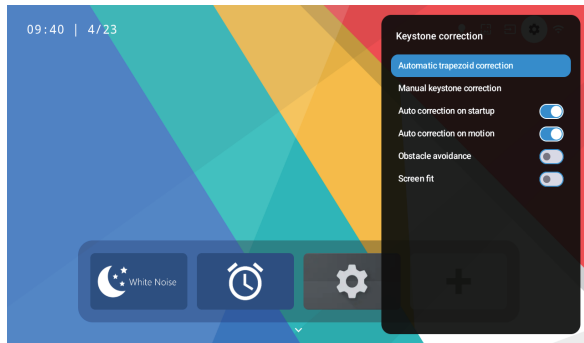
Focus

The machine is equipped with an auto-focus function. You need to turn on either "Auto Focus On Motion" or "Auto Focus On Startup" in the settings. Of course, you can also perform manual focusing using the 「Focus」 button on the remote control.



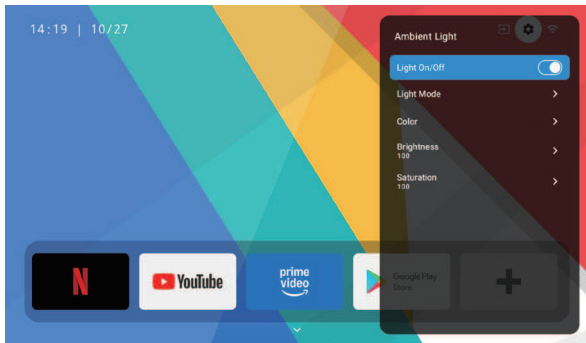
Keystone

The machine is equipped with functions such as automatic keystone correction, automatic screen alignment, and automatic obstacle avoidance. You need to turn on the corresponding options in the settings. Meanwhile, you can also manually correct the four points and four sides by remote control.



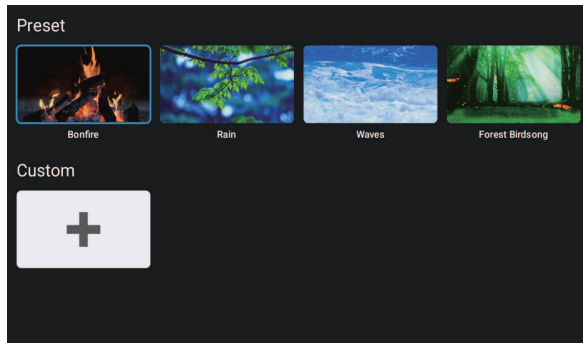
Ambient Light

1. Press the 「Ambient Light」 button on the remote control to open the ambient light menu and turn on the ambient light.
2. In the 「Light Mode」 menu, you can choose different lighting effects, including multiple themes that follow the sound changes.
3. You can also change the color, saturation, and brightness of the ambient light.
4. In BT speaker mode and white noise mode, press the 「Ambient Light」 button to switch the lighting theme, and long press to turn on and off the light.



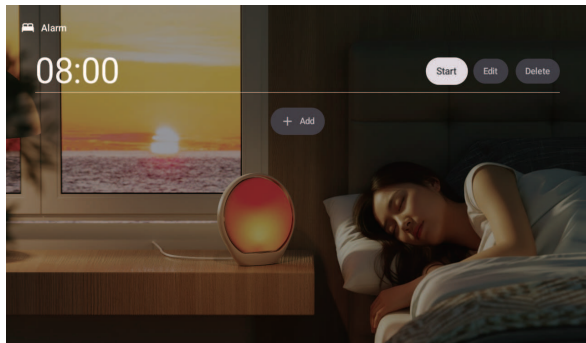
White Noise

1. Go to "My Apps" and open the "White Noise" app.
2. Select one of the 4 preset white noise themes. The device will play the corresponding audio and video, and the ambient light will turn on.
3. You can turn the ambient light on/off, turn off the projector screen, adjust brightness, and set a timer for automatic shutdown.
4. After turning off the projector screen, press the 「Ambient Light」 button on the remote control to switch white noise themes, and press the 「Power」 button to turn the screen back on.



Wake-up

- 1.Go to "My Apps" and open the "Wake-up" app. (You can also press the 「Power」 button on the remote control to access it directly.)
- 2.On the app interface, add an alarm time, and set the alarm sound and lighting effects.
- 3.Do not unplug the power supply once the wake-up function is activated. When the alarm sounds, press any button on the remote control to stop it.



Bluetooth Speaker

- 1.Press the 「Power Button」 on the remote control to select 「Bluetooth Speaker」.
- 2.Find the device named 「Model No.」 in the Bluetooth settings of your mobile phone and click to connect.
- 3.After the Bluetooth connection is successful, the projector can play music from the mobile phone.
- 4.At this point, you can choose whether to turn off the projector's light source.
