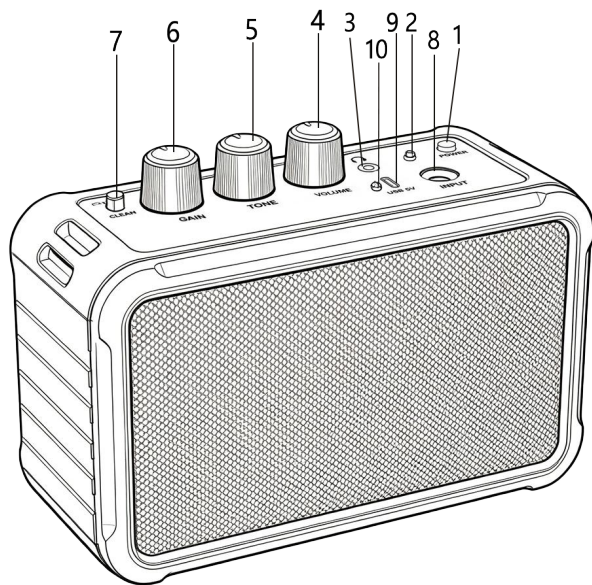

FUNCTION

- 1.Power:ong press for 2 seconds to turn on/off,Click to turn on Wireless function after booting up,Click again to turn off Wireless function,Mobile wireless connection name: B2,All operations have voice prompts
- 2.Blue indicator light for power on/off
3. 3.5mm headphone jack
- 4.Volume knob:This knob only adjusts the volume of guitar input sound

- 5.Tone knob:This knob controls the tone
- 6.Gain knob:This knob adjusts the gain output
- 7.CLEAN/OD:The button to switch the overdrive and the clean channel.
- 8.Guitar input jack:6.35mm Guitar input jack
- 9.TYPE-C charging port
- 10.Charging indicator :The indicator light will be red when you charge the lamp,when the battery is fully charged ,the indicator light will turn green

Power supply

this product has a built-in lithium battery.when the product is not used for a long period,please charge the product every six months in order to extend the built in battery's cycling life.in order to make fill use of the performance of the lithium battry,please make sure that the external temperature is between-10℃to 60℃.
