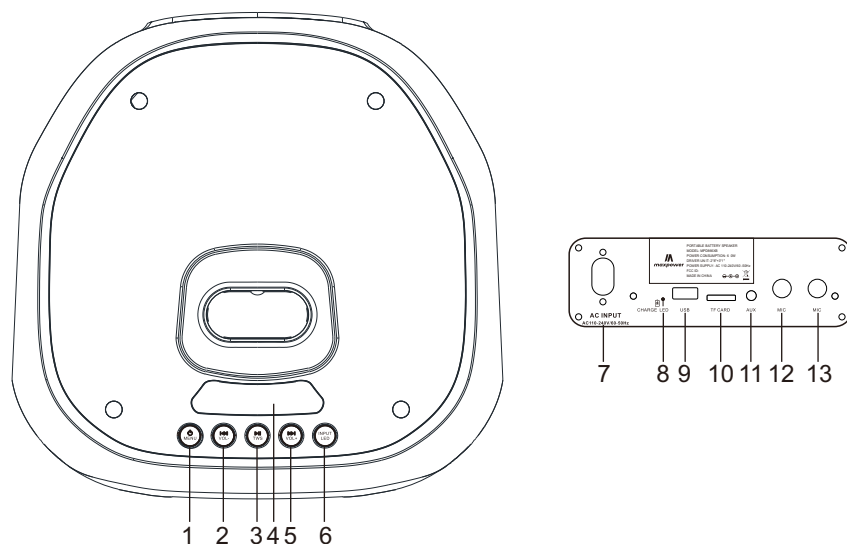


PORTABLE BATTERY SPEAKER

Control Panel Function



1. Long press to power on/off, short press to access the menu (volume, treble, bass, microphone volume, Echo)
2. Press and hold to adjust volume -, short press to switch previous song tracks (FM stations)
3. Press and hold TWS for a long press, short press to pause playback (FM search)
4. LED display
5. Press and hold to adjust volume+, short press to switch next song tracks (FM stations)
6. Short press to input selection (BT/USB/FM/AUX), Press and hold the LED
7. AC power input
8. Charging Indicator
RED = Charging Light off = Fully Charged
9. USB Jack
10. TF card input
11. AUX input
12. MIC1: Microphone input
13. MIC2: Microphone input

Operating instructions

1. playing

Turn on the power switch, Press and hold the volume up or down button to adjust the volume to the desired level.

Switch on, and EQ adjustment in accordance with your preferences.

You then are able to enjoy the wonderful & professional glamour brought by the product.

2. Karaoke performance

Plug in the microphone, and then turn the knobs to adjust microphone volume for optimizing the performance, press power switch.

Note: after using, please turn down the volume first. Then switch off the power and pull out the power plug.

FM Operation

Press INPUT button to switch to FM mode, short press PLAY/PAUSE button to automatically scan radio station, by pressing PREVIOUS or NEXT you can select a previous or next radio station.

Bluetooth:

Press the INPUT button on the panel control to select Bluetooth mode. Simultaneously open the Bluetooth setting on your phone, tablet or any other Bluetooth enabled audio device and select "Tk-866C".
