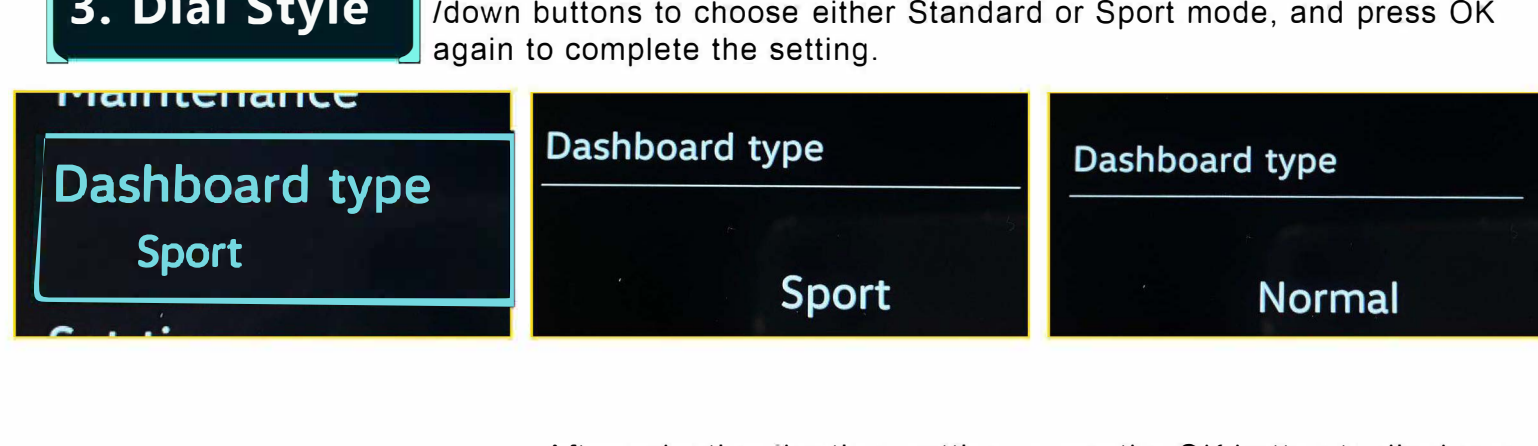
1. Ambient lighting

2. Maintenance Information

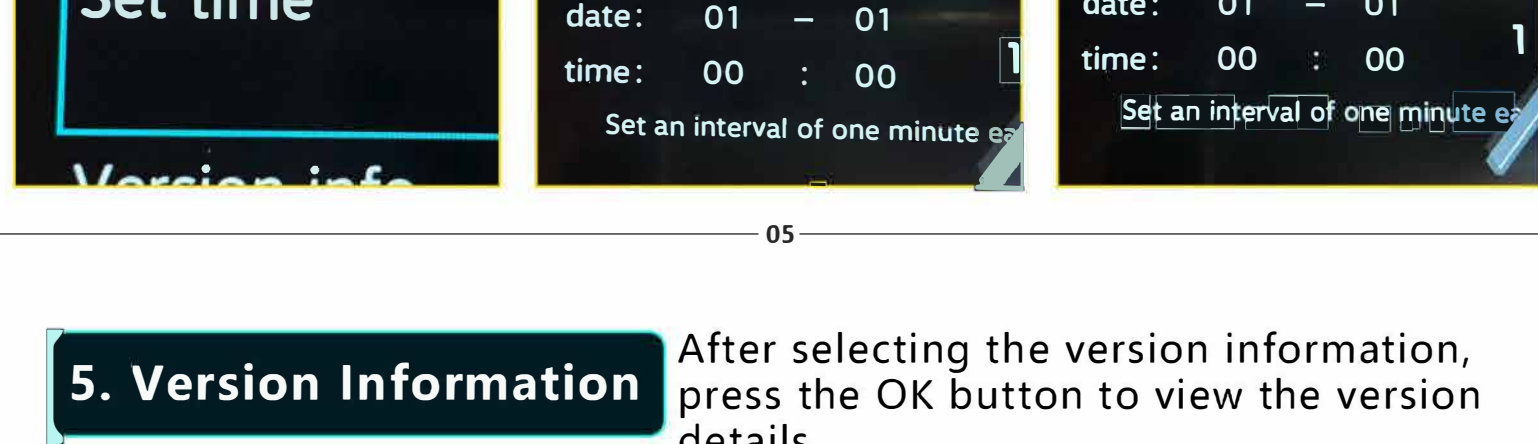
You can view maintenance information or reset maintenance information.

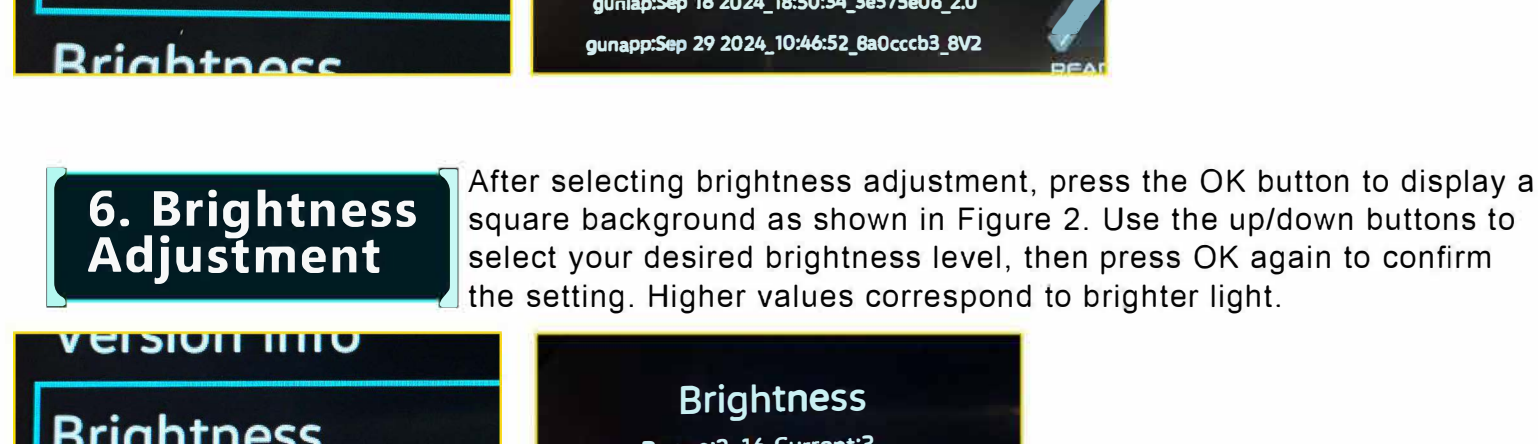
3. Dial Style

4. Time Settings

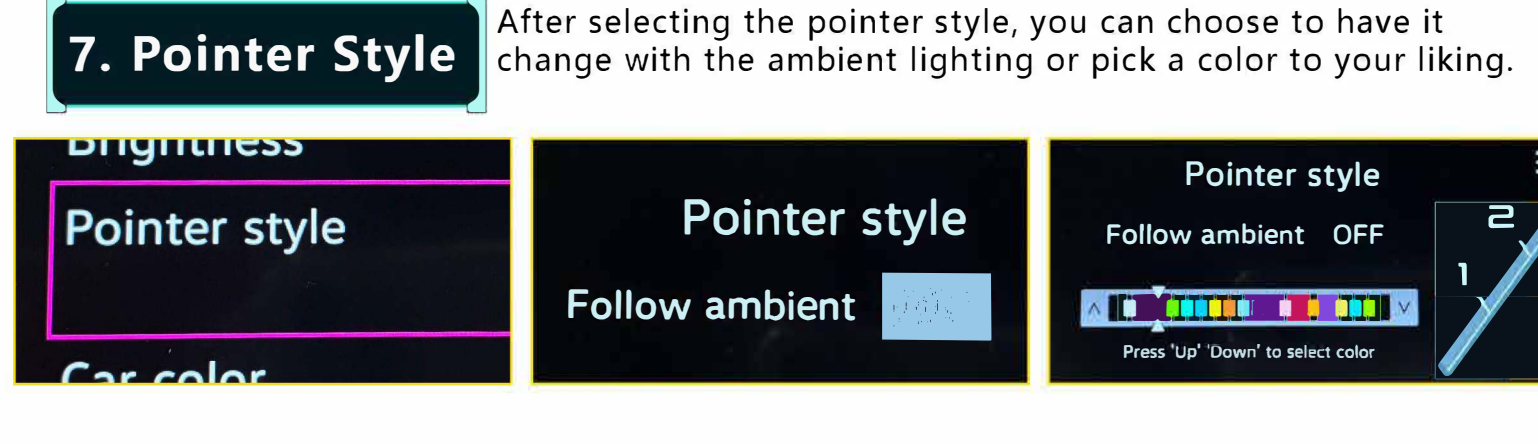
After selecting the time setting, press the OK button to display a square background as shown in Figure 3. Use the up/down buttons to select the desired time and date, then press OK again to complete the setting.

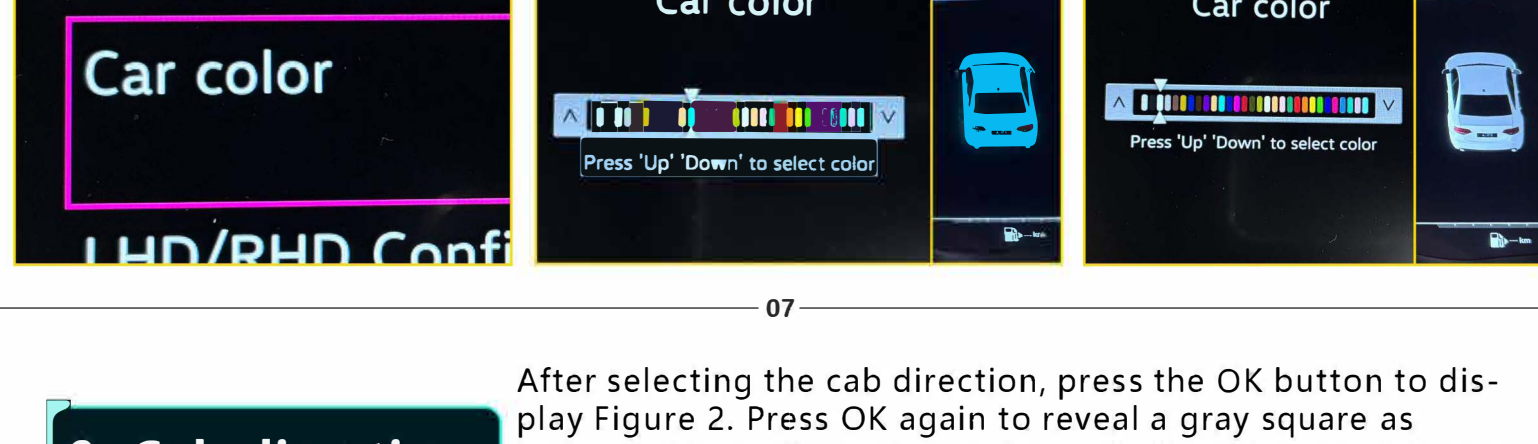
5. Version Information

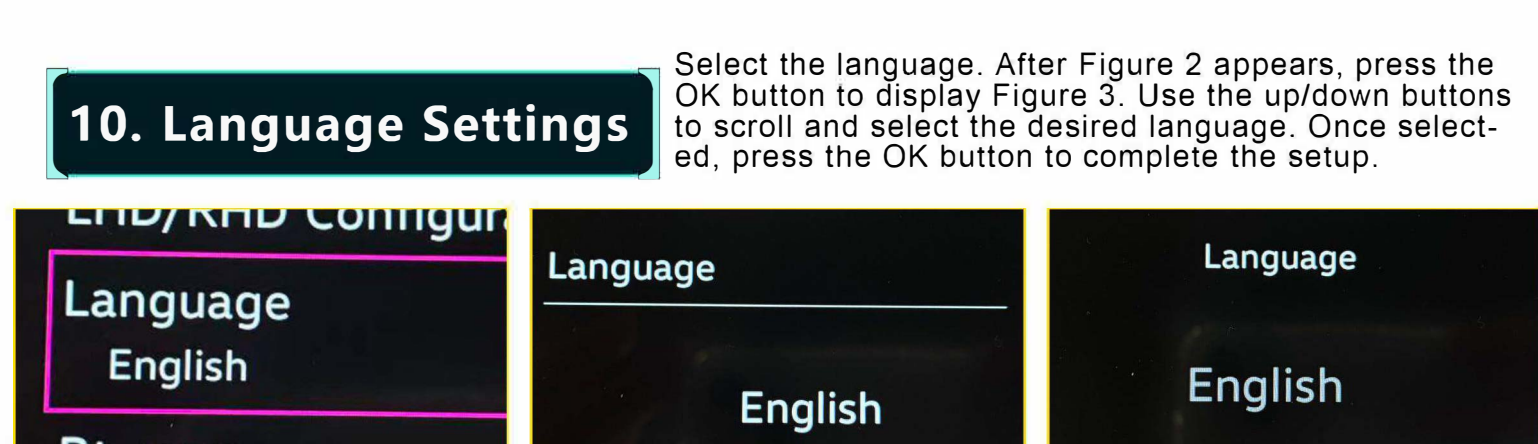
7. Pointer Style

8. Vehicle Color

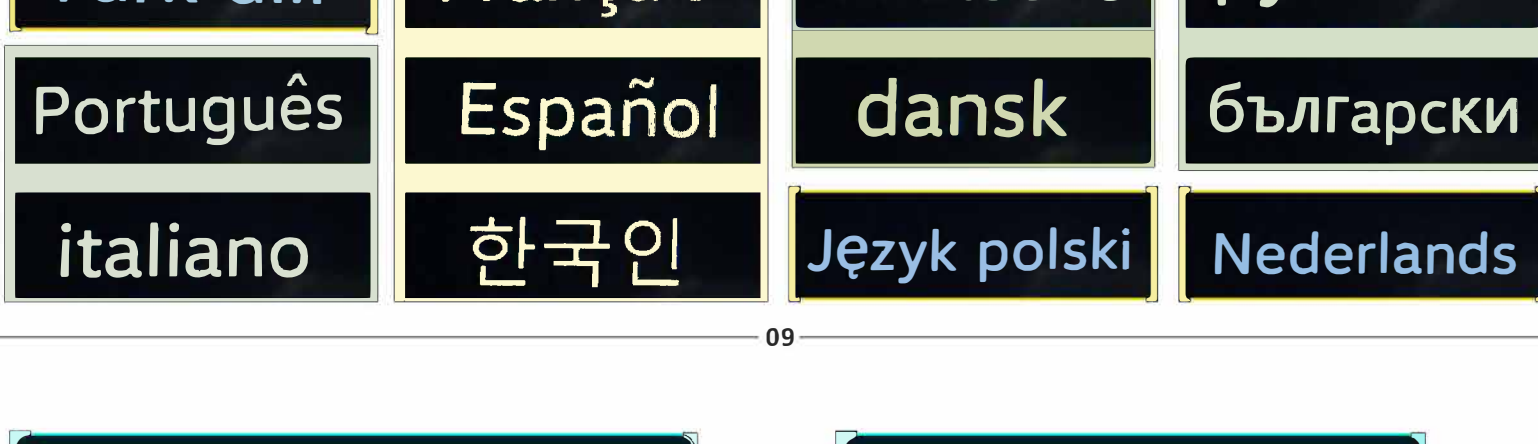
After selecting the car color, press the OK button, then use the up/down buttons to choose your preferred color. Press OK again, then exit. The car color will now be set to your chosen shade.

9. Cab direction

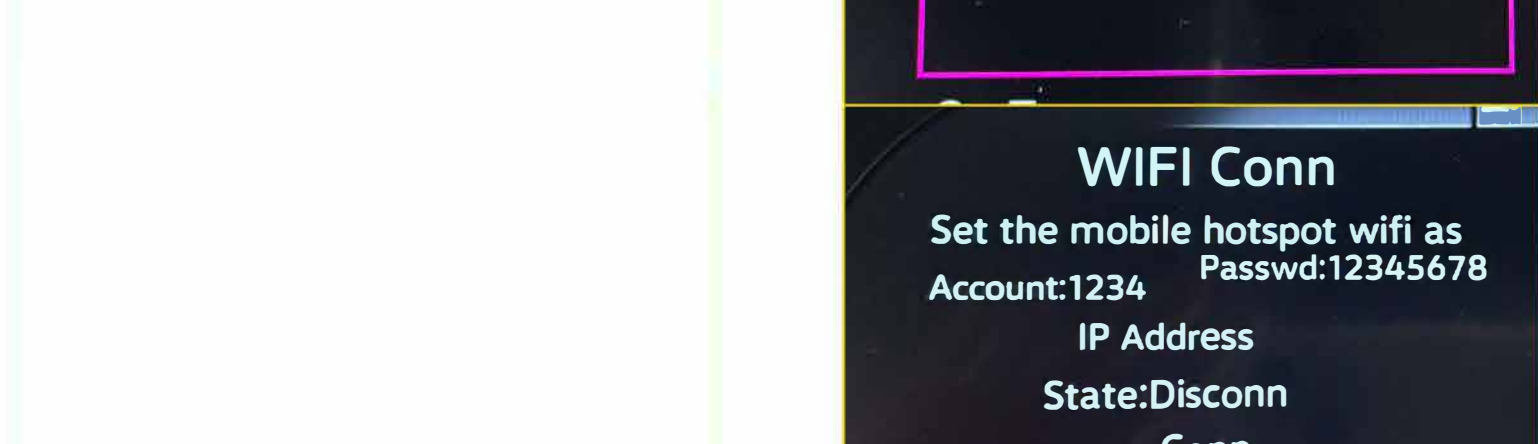

10. Language Settings

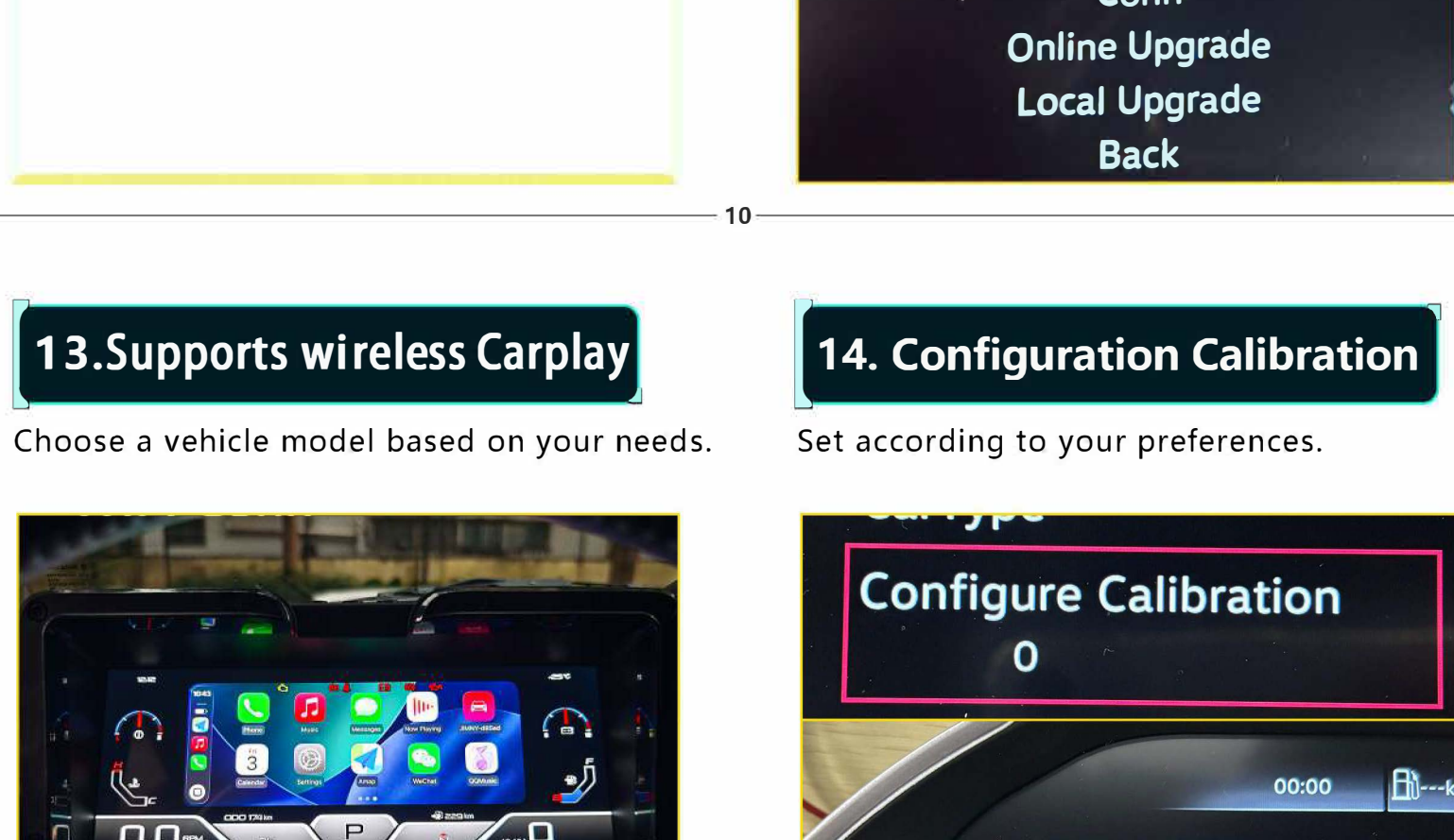

12. Wi-Fi Connection

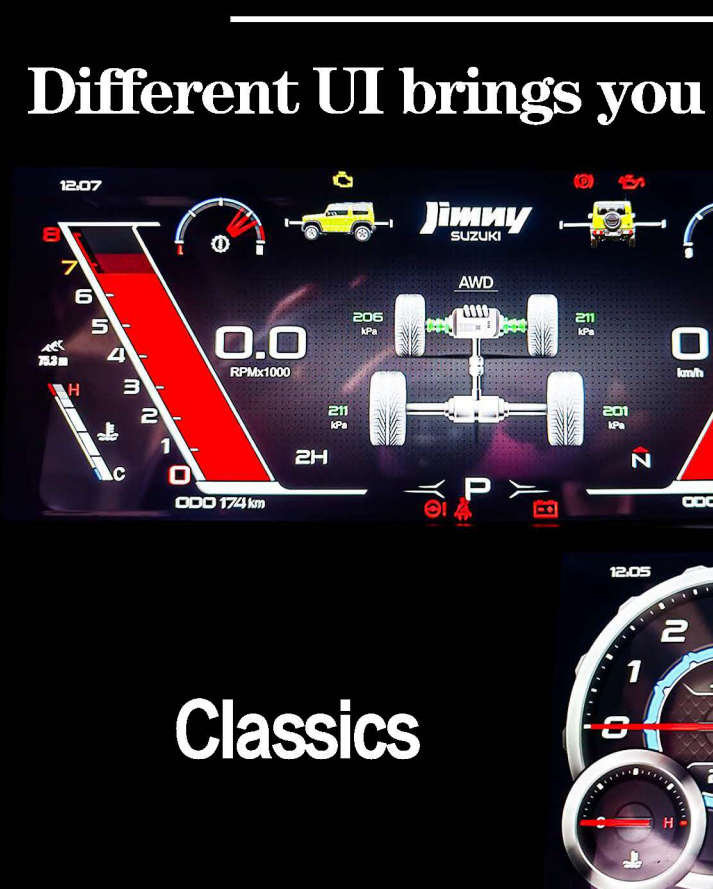
Select the Wi-Fi connection, then follow the prompts to connect to the Wi-Fi.
