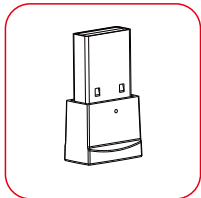

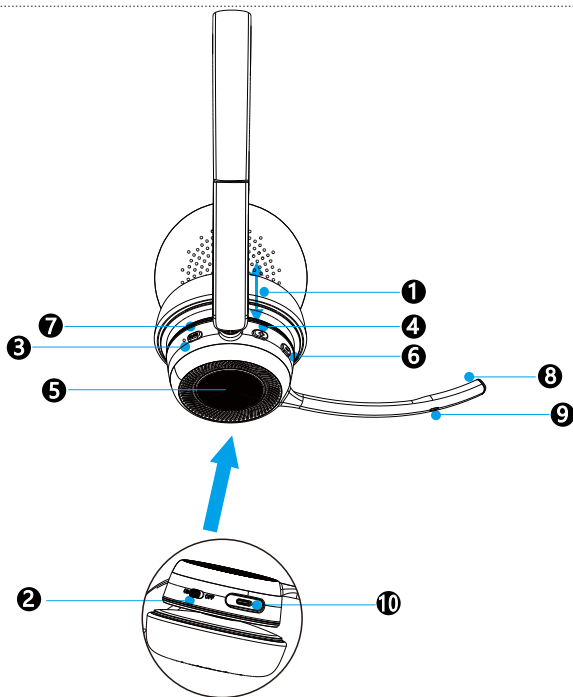

How to Wear?

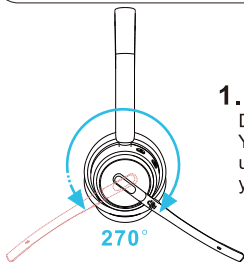
For the best comfort and sound quality, please follow these steps to wear your headset correctly:



Right Ear Wearing Status



Left Ear Wearing Status



1. Wear it on either side — The DH21 features a reversible design. You can rotate the microphone boom up to 270° to wear the headset on either your left or right ear.

3. Adjust the headband — Extend or retract the headband until it fits snugly and comfortably.

4. Set the mic boom — Position the microphone about 0.4–0.8 inches (roughly 1–2 finger widths) from your mouth for the clearest voice pickup.

If the microphone is positioned too far from the corner of your mouth, the other party may have difficulty hearing you, or your voice may sound too faint.

Basic Operation

Button	Function	Operation Instruction
Power ON/ OFF Switch	Power on	the OFF state, toggle the switch to the ON position to power on.
	Power off	In the ON state, toggle the switch to the OFF position to power off.
MFB-Multi-Function Button(Mobile phones only)	Answer a call	When a call is incoming, single-click the "MFB" to answer.
	Hang up a call	During a call, single-click the "MFB" to hang up.
	Reject a call	When a call is incoming, press and hold the "MFB" for 2 seconds to reject the call.
	Redial a call	When the headset is connected and not in use for a current call, double-press the "MFB" to redial the last number.
	Play/Pause music	During music playback, single-press the "MFB" to pause or play.
	Reset/Delete pairing records	Turn off the headset, plug in the Type-C charging cable. Then press and hold both the Volume Up and Volume Down buttons at the same time. After about 2 seconds, the blue LED will flash 2 times .The headset will reset, and the pairing record will be cleared.(Note: To reset, make sure the headset switch is in the OFF state. The ON state cannot be reset.)
Volume + Button	Volume up	When making a call or playing music, single click the "Volume +" button to increase the volume.
	Next song	Press and hold the "Volume +" button for 2 second.
Volume - Button	Volume down	When making a call or playing music, single click the "Volume -"button to decrease the volume.
	Previous song	Press and hold the "Volume -" button for 2 second.
Mute Button	Mute/Unmute	During a call or online meeting, single click "mute button" to mute/unmute your microphone."
	Voice Assistant	In connected standby mode, press and hold the mute button for 2 seconds, then release to activate the voice assistant.

Headset LED Light Guide

Mode	LED Indicator
Power on	The LED indicator light flashes blue for one second, and then it flashes red and blue alternately.
Power off	The red indicator light stays on for 1 second and then turnsoff.
Pairing mode	LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately.
Connected standby mode	The blue LED indicator flashes every 8 seconds.
Delete pairing record	The red light stays on for 2 seconds, then the blue light flashes twice, and then the red light stays on.
Charging	The indicator light remains solid red.
Fully charged	The red LED off.

Voice Prompts Guide

State	Voice Prompt
When the switch is toggled ON	Power on
When the switch is toggled OFF	Power off
When the headset enters pairing mode	Pairing
When the headset is successfully connected	Connected
When the headset is disconnected	Disconnected
When the microphone is muted	Mute on
When the mute is canceled	Mute off
When the battery is low	Battery low
