Bluetooth pairing

step one

Open the top cover of the charging compartment and the headphones will automatically turn on.

Step 2

Turn on your phone's Bluetooth and search for the device name: JM28

First time pairing

1. Open the charging compartment cover, and the headphones will automatically power on and enter the pairing state.

2. Open Bluetooth on your phone and search for the device name: "JM28", select it and connect.

Connect again

After pairing for the first time, you only need to open the lid of the charging compartment to reconnect again, and it will automatically reconnect.

*The above operations ensure that the product charging compartment is powered on.

Operating Instructions

1. Turn on and off the machine

Earphones on and off

Power on: Press and hold the headset touch function button for 3 seconds (headphone prompt tone: TONE sound) Indicator light: white and green lights flash alternately
Shut down: Press and hold the headset touch function button for 5 seconds (headphone prompt sound: TONE sound)Indicator light: white light flashes 3 times and turns off)

Display switch

Power on: Press and hold the button for 3 seconds to start the screen;
Shut down: Press and hold the button for 5 seconds, the shutdown interface will pop up, click to shut down

2. Mode selection

Phone Mode

Reject incoming calls: Long press for 2s
Incoming call: Click answer, then click Hang off

Music mode

Left ear double touch: Play the previous song
Touch the right ear: Play the next song
One Touch: Play/Pause

Ear mode

Three touches on the left ear: volume down
Three touches of the right ear: volume increases
Wake up SIRI: Press and hold for 1.5S

3. Screen instructions

Language settings

Swipe up or down to select the appropriate language and click to complete the switch.

When the headset is connected to the Bluetooth of the mobile phone, you can control the mobile phone to take pictures by clicking on the camera icon.

If the pairing or connection is not performed for a long time, the Bluetooth headset pairing function will be turned off. Please turn on the Bluetooth headset to "pairing state". If the mobile phone program is wrong, please restart the phone. If the Bluetooth headset program is wrong, please restart the Bluetooth headset.

Warn
