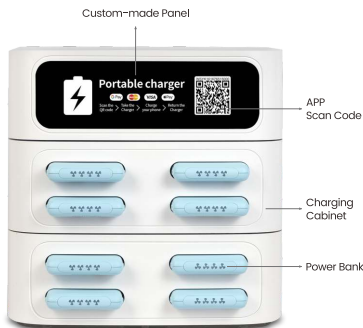

I. Product Schematic Diagram

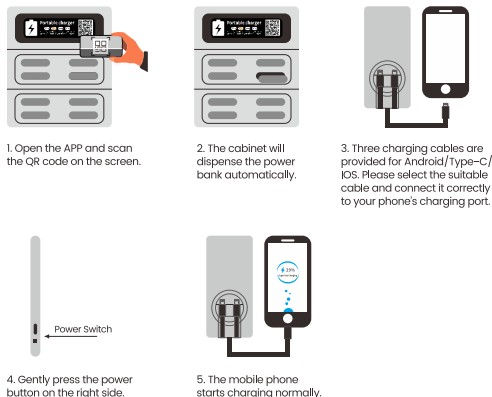

III. Operation Instructions

Note: All pictures in this manual are schematic diagrams. Due to product updates or upgrades, the actual product may differ slightly from the schematic drawings. Please take the real product as standard.



IV. Precautions

- Do not expose the product to high-temperature environments or near heat-generating devices, such as inside parked cars under direct sunlight, heaters, microwave ovens, ovens, or open flames. Otherwise, it may cause an explosion.
- If charging with a power adapter, please purchase a matching adapter with CCC certification that complies with relevant standard requirements.
- Improper battery replacement may cause an explosion. The battery shall only be replaced by professional personnel with the same or equivalent type of battery; otherwise, fire, explosion or other hazards may occur.
- This product is suitable for safe use only under non-tropical climatic conditions.
- Do not place the product in unventilated enclosed spaces such as handbags for a long time, as this may easily cause fire hazards.
- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations. Do not dispose of it as domestic waste. Improper disposal may lead to explosion risks.
- Do not use this product during thunderstorms to avoid product malfunction or electric shock hazards.
- This product contains a built-in battery. Do not disassemble, strike, squeeze or throw it into fire. Stop using it immediately if the battery is severely swollen.
- Do not use the product if the battery has come into contact with water.
- Keep this product out of the reach of children. It is normal for the product temperature to be slightly higher than ambient temperature during use. It is recommended to keep continuous contact time within 10 seconds.

RF Exposure Statement.
