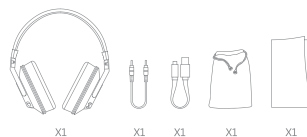

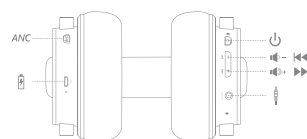

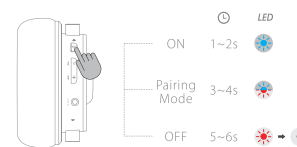
① Package

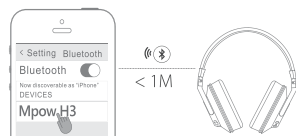
Set "ON" State for the Bluetooth button.
Stellen Sie den "EIN"-Zustand für die Bluetooth-Taste ein.
Réglez l'Etat "ON" pour le bouton Bluetooth.
Ajuste el estado "ON" para el botón Bluetooth.

Long press for 4 s until the red and blue indicator lights flash quickly. When you complete the pairing, you'll hear a voice prompt and search Bluetooth devices and select "Mpow H3" to connect.

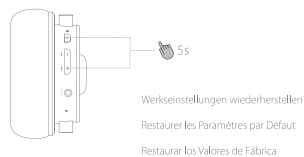

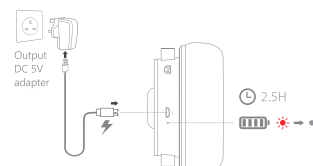
