RADIO OPERATION

1. Turn on the radio using the Volume control knob, then adjust it to appropriate volume.
2. Choose bands: use the BAND switch to select AM, FM (or other supported bands).
3. Turn the TUNING knob to choose the required station.
4. Adjust the Telescopic antenna position to get the best receiving effect.

USB/TF OPERATION

Insert the TF card into the TFcard slot or USB drive into the USB jack. Use the BAND switch to move to MP3 mode. It will automatically play music files (supporting MP3, WMA, WAV formats). Press PREV/REW or NEXT/F.FWD to switch tracks, and press PAUSE/TWS to pause.

BLUETOOTH OPERATION

Use the BAND switch to move to MP3 mode, and the unit will enter Bluetooth mode automatically. Turn on Bluetooth on your mobile phone or Bluetooth device, search for and connect to " BC-M7070 ". Once connected successfully, you can play audio from the device.

TWS STEREO PAIRING OPERATION

(Requires Two Identical Speakers)

Ensure both speakers are in Bluetooth mode (by switching to MP3 mode with the BAND switch) and not connected to other devices. Double press the PAUSE/TWS Key on one of the speakers to enter TWS pairing mode. The two speakers will pair automatically. Once paired successfully, left-right channel separation is achieved for a stereo effect.

PRECAUTIONS

1. Before first use, open the battery compartment (18650X1 PCS), and remove the insulating sheet on the rechargeable battery to ensure the product powers on normally.
2. If the rechargeable battery is not used for a long time, please remove it. Do not reverse the positive and negative poles when installing the battery.
3. Avoid scratching the SOLAR PANEL with hard objects and keep its surface clean to ensure charging efficiency.
