

Instructions for Use

Design for extending service life

To extend the lifespan of this lamp, it is designed to automatically shut off after 5 hours of use. This is not a malfunction.

Remote control usage

Like many products that use infrared remote controls, please place the lamp at an appropriate distance and ensure that the light is not blocked by other objects. If the remote control is not responsive, try adjusting the angle of the remote or repositioning the lamp.

Rotating lens notice

The lighting effect of this product is created by a rotating optical lens. Due to the rotation mechanism, you may hear a faint sound if the lamp is shaken by hand, this is normal and not a defect.

Safe placement

Always place the lamp in a stable and secure location. Avoid placing it in areas where it may fall from a height, as this could cause damage.

Remote Battery care

If the remote control will not be used for an extended period, we recommend reinserting the insulation tab into the battery compartment to prolong battery life. To replace the battery please refer to the user manual for detailed instructions.

About motor speed

The motor's rotation speed is affected by the ambient temperature; the lower the temperature, the slower the speed. You can use the remote control to adjust the Nebula's rotation speed.

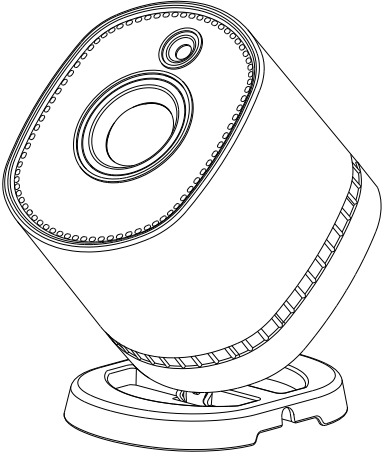
For products with replaceable button/coin cell batteries shall additionally include:

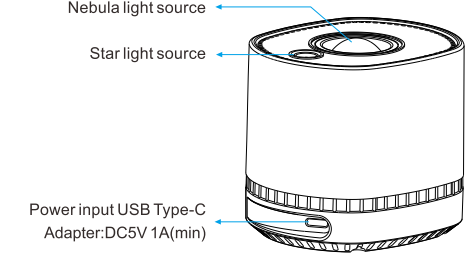
- 1. Please do not look directly at the light source output hole of the projector light while using it, otherwise it may cause eyes discomfort.

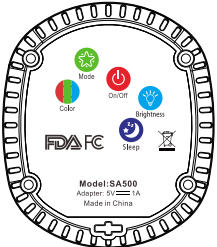

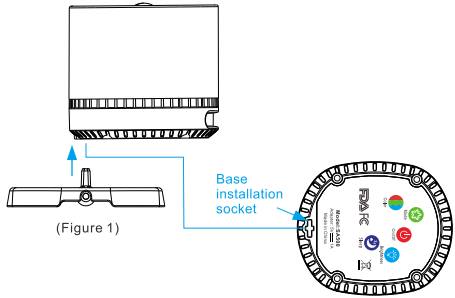

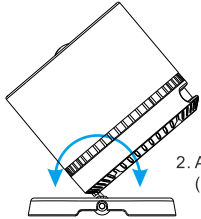
To avoid strong light radiation, please do not disassemble the panel.

Replacing Battery(please follow steps as photo shows below):

- ③ Push back the battery tray and fix the battery compartment with screw.
