Assembly instructions



Remote control and dinosaur charging



The dinosaur and remote control is equipped with a built-in battery. It is recommended to use a 5V · 2A charging adapter(not included in package) and the charging cable included in the package for charging.

When charging, indicator of the vehicle and remote control lights up red, and it turns off when fully charged.

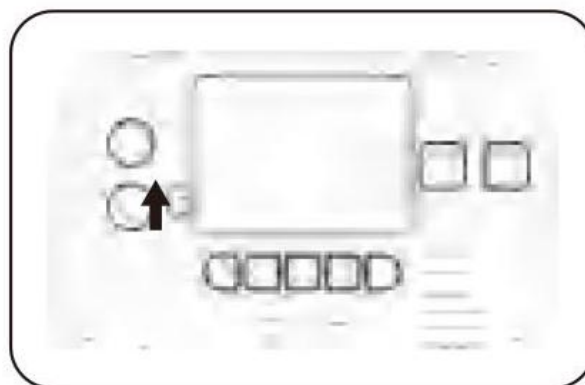
Charging Safety Instructions

1. Do not use incompatible chargers.
2. Charge under adult supervision. Do not charge on bed, sofa or flammable surfaces.
3. Unplug the power in time after fully charged.
4. Do not charge in high temperature, humid or closed environment. Stop charging if overheating, swelling or odor occurs.
5. Turn off the dinosaur and controller before charging.
6. Keep away from children during charging.
7. Do not disassemble or dispose of dinosaur at will.

Operation Guide

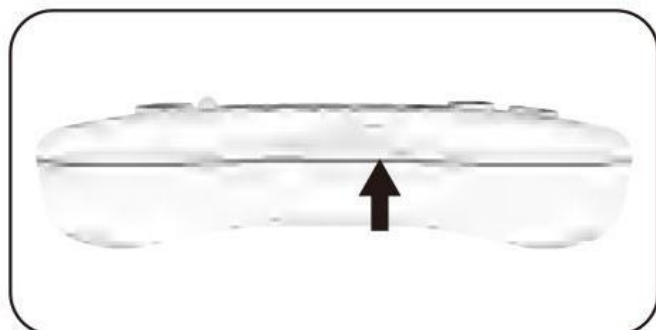


Step 1. Turn on dinosaur



Step 2. Turn on remote control

Note: The remote control will automatically pair with the dinosaur once powered on.



Step 3. Install the SD card

Please install an SD card into the SD card slot of the remote control before using it to take photo or video.

Supports up to 32GB SD card (not included).

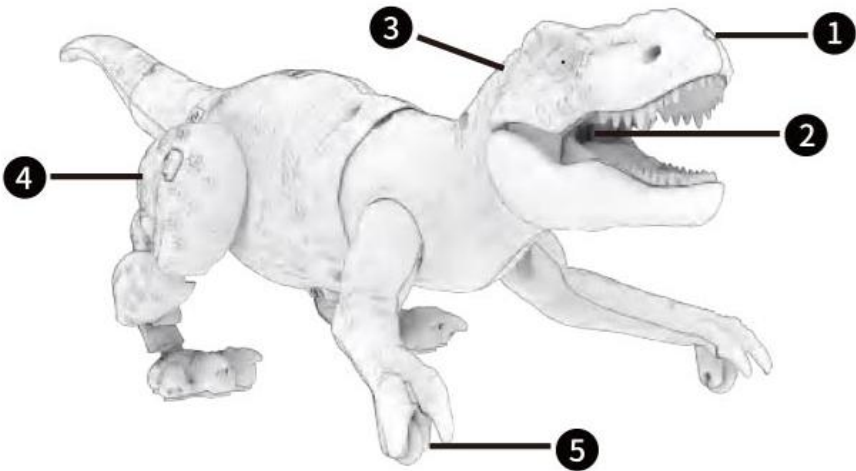

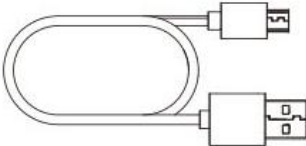
Component names
