

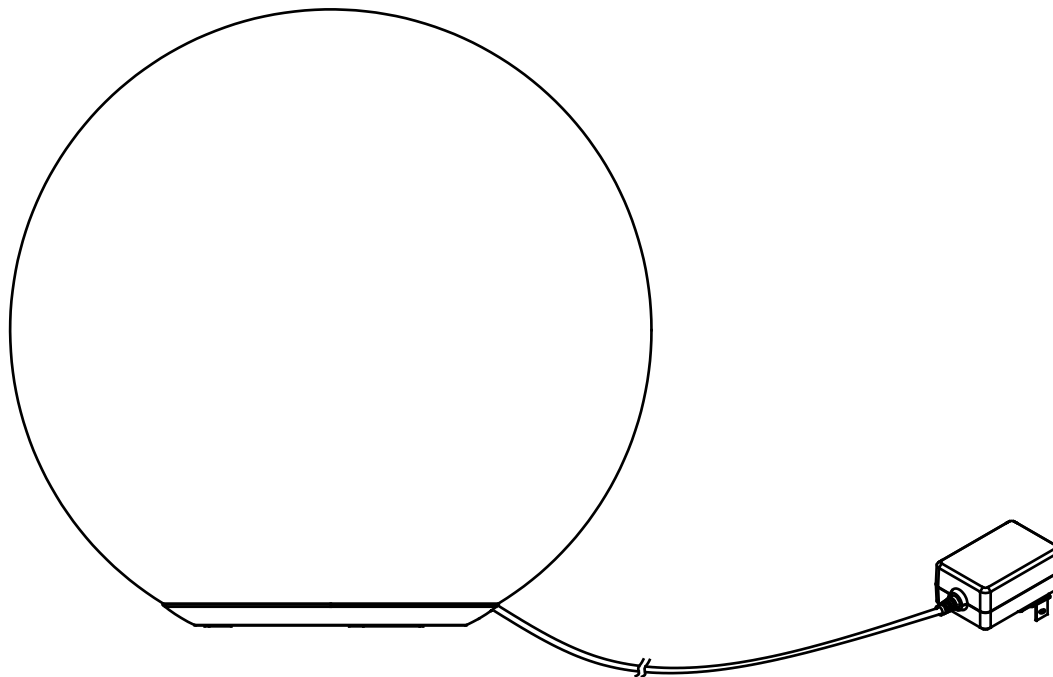

⚠ SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate or install the product.

WARNING

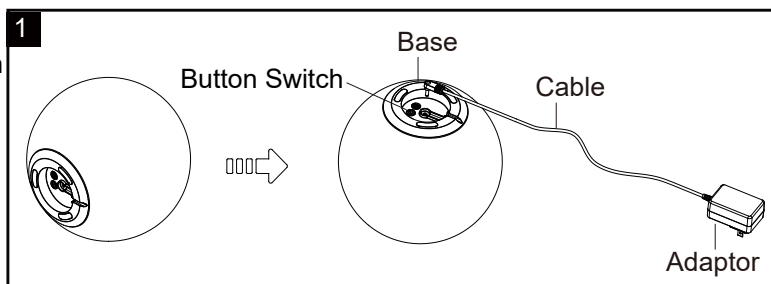
- Do not plug lamp into an electrical outlet before installation is completed.
- CAUTION- This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. DO NOT alter the plug. AC ONLY.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, DO NOT use the product if power cord is damaged or broken. Be careful NOT to damage any wiring during installation.
- CAUTION-The use of a bulb with higher wattage than specified may cause electrical shock or fire hazard.

PREPARATION

Before beginning assembly, installation or operation of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and diagram on previous page. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product.

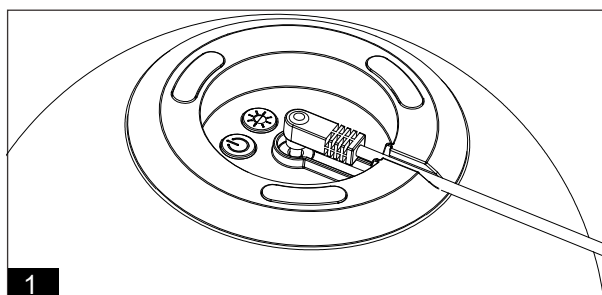
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Connect the cable to the base, and plug the adaptor into the outlet. Turn on the light with the button switch on the bottom of the lamp.



WAY TO OPERATION

1. Manual Control by using button switch.
 - a. Short press “” for on/off;
Long press for dimming.
 - b. Short press “” to switch 2700K, 5700K and RGB;
Long press and hold for 5 seconds to reset and start connecting to the network.

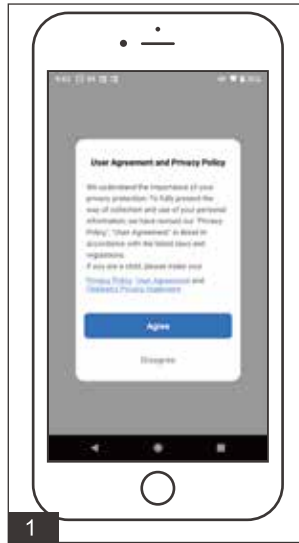


REGISTRATION / LOGIN / PASSWORD RETRIEVAL

Setting for single light through mobile device (Take iOS for example as below. Android will be slightly different).

Before you start

1. Download the Smart Life APP  from the Apple App Store or Android Google play store.
Registration
If you do not have the app account, you may choose to register. The registration process is described on this page and the next. Click "Agree" to proceed to the registration page.



2. Click "Sign up" to enter the next page shown in Fig.3.



3. The system will identify automatically the country/region you are in, or you may choose to select manually a country/region. Enter your email and click "Get Verification Code" and enter the verification code you received, then enter the password and click "Completed" to finish registration as shown in Fig.3, Fig.3a, Fig.3b.



Account ID + Password Login

If you already have an app account, click "Log in" to proceed to the login page.

- a. The system will identify automatically the country / region you are in, or you may also choose to select manually a country / region .
- b. Enter the email you have registered and enter the password in to log in.

Smart Life Login.

1. Enter the email you have registered and enter the password into log in as shown in Fig.1, Fig. 1a.



USER GUIDE

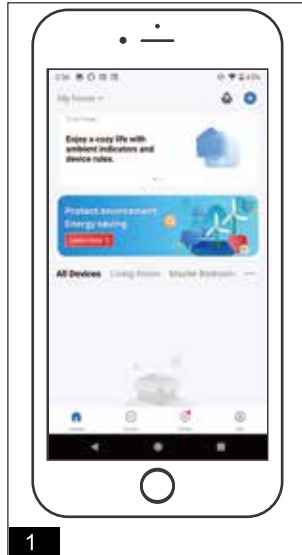
The Smart Life app supports two configuration methods: "Add Manually" and "Auto Scan". Ensure Bluetooth is turned on and connect to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network before linking the lights with the app.

Auto Scan

Ensure the light on the smart device is flashing rapidly. If it is not, please choose one of below steps to operate:

1. Long press and hold "⏻" at the inline switch for 5 seconds to reset and start connecting to the network.
2. Use the wall switch by turning it off, then on, then off again, then on, and finally off and on once more (off-on-off-on-off-on) to trigger the flashing mode.

1. Click "+" and "Add Device" at the top right corner of the App home page shown in Fig.1, and enter the next page shown in Fig.2.



2. Click "Add" to enter the next page shown in Fig3.



3. Enter the Wi-Fi account and password and click "Next" to enter the next page shown in Fig.4.

Note: The Wi-Fi account and password in the APP must be the same as on the mobile phone.



4. Once connected, the App will enter another page. Click "Done" to complete connecting as shown in Fig.4a, Fig.4b.



Add Manually mode

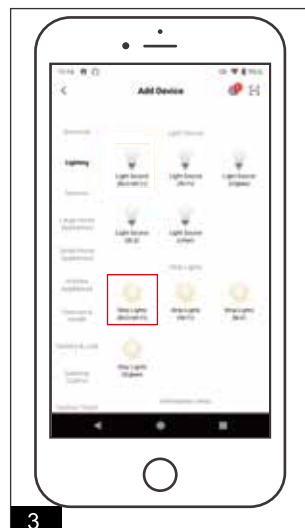
1. Click "+" and "Add Device" at the top right corner of the App home page upper right corner and enter the next page shown in Fig.2.



2. Click "Lighting" to enter the next page shown in Fig.3.



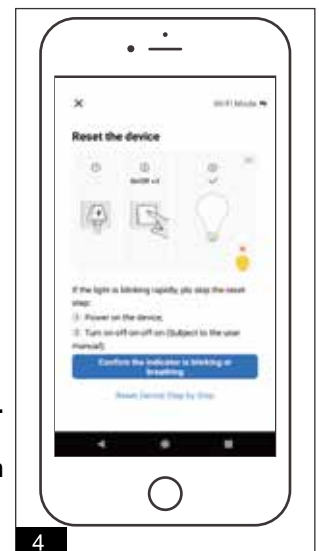
3. Click "Strip Lights (BLE+Wi-Fi)" to enter the next page shown in Fig.4.



4. Click "Confirm the lamplight is blinking or breathing" to enter the next page shown in Fig.5.

Note: Ensure the light on the smart device is flashing rapidly. If it is not, please choose one of below steps to operate:

1. Long press and hold "⏻" at the inline switch for 5 seconds to reset and start connecting to the network.
2. Use the wall switch by turning it off, then on, then off again, then on, and finally off and on once more (off-on-off-on-off-on) to trigger the flashing mode.



5. Select the Wi-Fi in your home, enter the Wi-Fi password shown in Fig.5. Click "Next" to enter the next page shown in Fig.6.

Light Mode

Control Device

After the device is successfully connected, the paired device will be displayed on the main interface.

Click to enter the White light interface (See Fig.4).

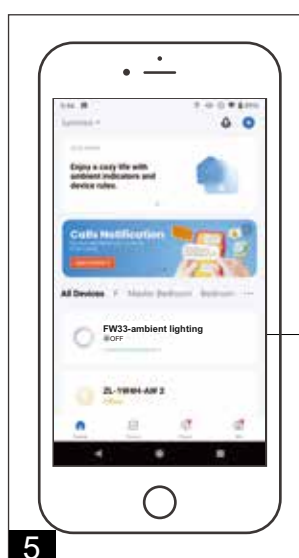
Click to enter the RGB light interface (See Fig.4).

Click to enter the Scene mode interface (See Fig.4).

Click to enter the Music mode interface (See Fig.4).

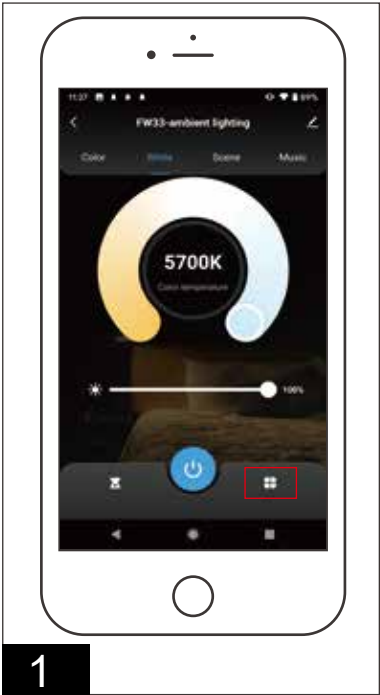
Note:

1. When the device is online, it supports quick operations.
2. When the device is offline, "offline" is displayed (See Fig. 2). At this time, the device cannot be operated. At this time, you can check whether the device has been successfully powered on.

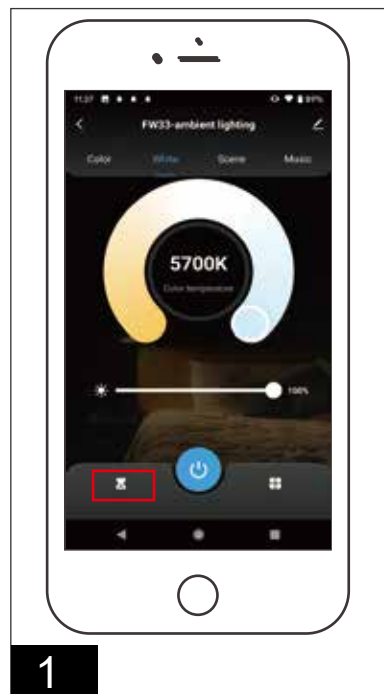


If "offline" is displayed, the device cannot be operated.

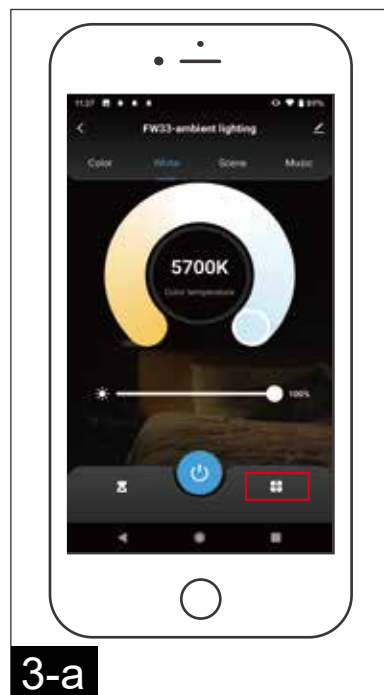
Rhythms Mode
Control Device



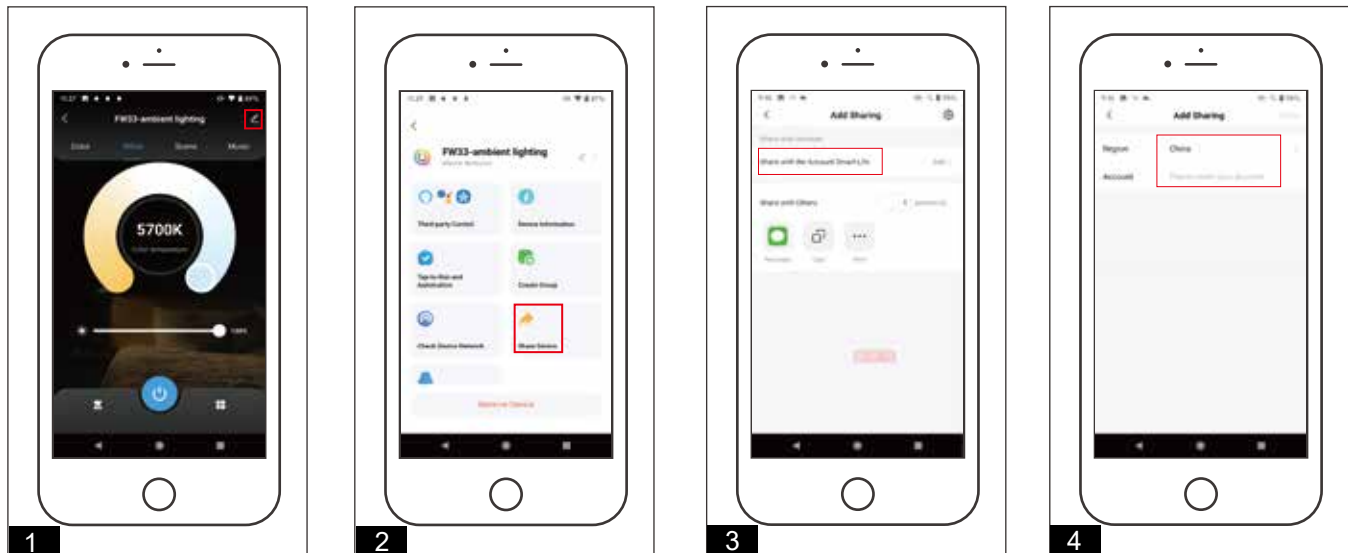
Countdown off

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- To clean, turn off and wipe with a damp, non-abrasive cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- 1) **The light does not work:**
 - a) Check that the connection between the two power connectors is correct.
 - b) Make sure the wall switch and circuit breaker are on.
 - c) Check to see if the lights are turned off with the APP.
- 2) **APP connection failure or the device doesn't connect to network.**
 - a) Make sure Bluetooth is turned on and connect to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network.
 - b) Make sure the WiFi password that you enter is correct.
 - c) Make sure the internet connection speeds is over 10mbps.
 - d) Mobile device requirements: Iphone 4S or newer running IOS 9.0 x or later. Android v5.0 or later.
- 3) **The light keeps flashing.**
 - a) Make sure it gets connected to a WIFI network.
 - b) Turn the light fixture OFF-ON while it is flashing over 180 seconds, it will stay on without flashing.
- 4) **If the remote controller can not control the lamp:**

Make sure the batteries are sufficiently charged.

Caution: Make sure main power is turned off before serving this fixture.

If unable to fix any of the above issues, please consult a certified electrician.

FCC Statement
