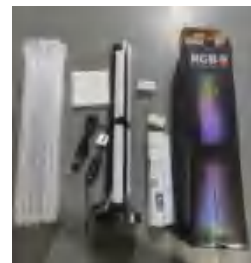

6.Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lights do not turn on	Power supply not connected	Check the power connection or batteries
Lights are dim	Batteries are low	Replace the batteries
Lights flicker	Loose connection	Check and secure all connections
Some lights do not work	Product damage	Stop using the product and dispose of it properly
