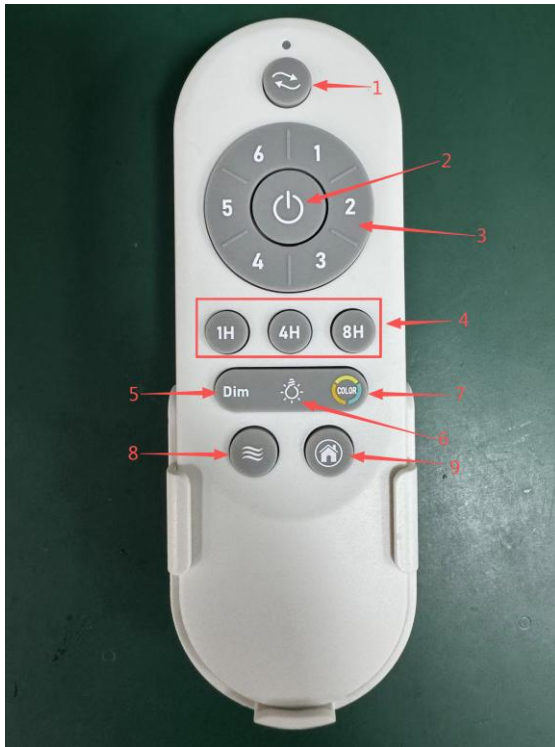


ITL-F433L Remote Control User Manual



As shown in the figure:

- 1、 Fan forward/reverse: Press this button to switch the fan's rotation direction.
- 2、 Fan Off Button: Press this button to turn off the fan.
- 3、 Fan speed settings: Press the corresponding fan speed control to adjust the fan's rotation speed.
- 4、 Timer: Turn off the fan when the set time is reached.
- 5、 Light intensity: Short press and long press to increase or decrease the light intensity.
- 6、 Light switch: Controls the on/off state of the light.
- 7、 Color Temperature Key: Press briefly to switch color temperature
- 8、 Natural Wind: Press and hold at position 1 for approximately 15 seconds, then move to position 6. Stay at position 6 for about 15 seconds, then return to position 1 and repeat this cycle.
- 9、 Anti-theft: Press this button to enter the anti-theft mode by turning off the fan. The motor will be shut down. Regardless of whether the lights are on or off at this moment, they will remain illuminated for 5 minutes before going out. After 2 hours, they will remain illuminated for another 5 minutes, and this cycle will repeat.
