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Safety Instructions

- ▶ The operation voltage of this bulb is 120 V~. It is not designed for universal voltage and cannot be used in 220 V~ environments.
- ▶ The bulb should not be used if the diffuser is broken.
- ▶ This bulb is intended for connection to E26 lampholders for outlet boxes or E26 lampholders provided in open luminaries.
- ▶ This bulb is rated 120 V AC and must be connected to a suitable power source.
- ▶ This bulb is intended for indoor dry or damp household use only.
- ▶ Do not attempt to disassemble, repair, or modify the bulb.
- ▶ Do not use this bulb with a dimmer switch.

Before First Use

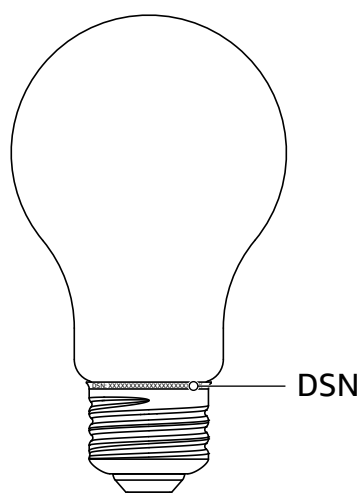

Set Up the Smart Bulb

You can set up the smart bulb with the 2D barcode on the *Quick Setup Guide* (recommended) or without a 2D barcode.

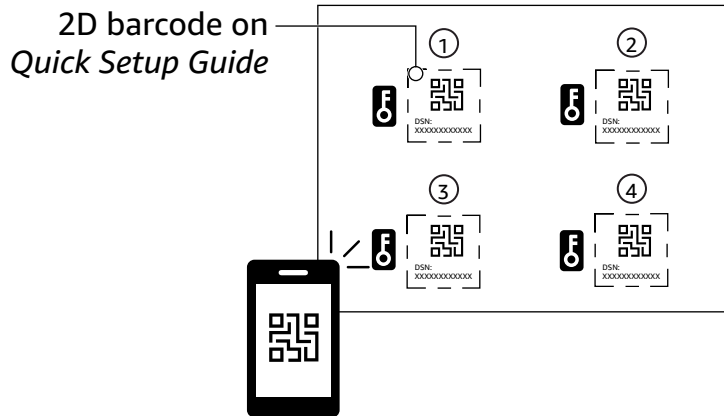
Set up with the 2D barcode on the *Quick Setup Guide* (recommended)

Note: Certain devices may automatically connect to Alexa using Amazon's Frustration-Free Setup technology.

1. Download the latest version of Alexa app from the app store, and log in.
2. Screw in the light bulb, then turn on the light.
3. Open the Alexa app, tap **More** (from the bottom menu), + add, then **Device**.
4. Tap **Light, Amazon Basics**, then choose **Amazon Basics Light Bulb**.

- Follow the steps in the Alexa app to complete setup. When prompted, scan the 2D barcodes on the *Quick Setup Guide*.

If you have more than one smart bulb and are scanning the 2D barcode in your Quick Setup Guide, match the DSN number on the smart bulb with the 2D barcode.



NOTICE Do not scan the barcode on packaging. If the 2D barcode scan fails or if you lose the *Quick Setup Guide*, refer to “Alternative setup method” on page 5.

Alternative Setup Method

Set Up without the Barcode

Use these instructions if the 2D barcode setup does not work.

- Screw in the light bulb, then turn on the light.
- Open the Alexa app, tap **More** (from the bottom menu), **+** add, then **Device**.
- Tap **Light**, then tap **Amazon Basics**.
- When prompted to scan the barcode, tap **DON'T HAVE A BARCODE?**
- Tap **NEXT**, then follow the on-screen instructions to complete setup.

Using the Smart Bulb

- ▶ To use the Alexa app, tap Devices from the bottom menu, then tap Lights.
- ▶ Use the voice control on your Amazon Alexa. (For example, “Alexa, turn on living room light.”)

Changing the Light Style

To change the light color, light temperature, or brightness:

- ▶ Use the Alexa app.

OR

- ▶ Use the voice control on your Amazon Alexa. For example, you could say:
 - ▶ “Alexa, set living room light to warm white.”
 - ▶ “Alexa, set living room light to 50%.”

Understanding LEDs

Light bulb	Status
Flashes twice softly	Bulb is ready for setup.
Flashes once softly, then remains soft white at full brightness	Bulb is connected
Flashes five times quickly, then flashes twice softly in soft white	Factory reset is complete, and the bulb is ready for setup again

Changing Settings with Alexa

Use the Alexa app to rename a light, add lights to a group/room, or set up routines that automatically turn a light on or off.

Resetting to Factory Defaults

- ▶ Delete your light bulb from the Alexa app to factory reset the bulb.

OR

- ▶ Use a light switch to quickly turn the light on and off five times. When you turn the light on the sixth time, the bulb flashes quickly five times, then flashes twice softly. This indicates that the bulb has been factory reset, and it is ready for setup again.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- ▶ To clean the Smart Filament LED Bulb, wipe with a soft, lightly damp cloth.
- ▶ Never use corrosive detergents, wire brushes, abrasive scourers, metal, or sharp utensils to clean the bulb.

Troubleshooting

If the smart bulb is not functioning properly, try the following solutions.

Problem

Light bulb does not turn on.

Solutions

- ▶ Make sure that the light switch is turned on.
- ▶ If installed in a lamp, make sure that it is plugged into a working power outlet.

Problem

Alexa app cannot find or connect to the smart bulb.

Solutions

- ▶ Make sure that you scan the 2D barcode on the *Quick Setup Guide*. Do not scan the barcode on the packaging for setup.
- ▶ Make sure that your phone/tablet and the Alexa app are updated to the latest software version.
- ▶ Make sure that your phone/tablet and smart LED light bulb are connected to the same 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. The bulb is not compatible with 5GHz networks.
- ▶ If you have a dual Wi-Fi router and both network signals have the same name, rename one and try reconnecting to the 2.4GHz network.
- ▶ Make sure that your phone/tablet is within 9.14 m (30 ft.) of the smart bulb.
- ▶ Do a factory reset. See "Resetting to Factory Defaults."

Problem

How do I reset the light bulb?

Solutions

- ▶ You can do a factory reset by deleting your device from Alexa app.
- ▶ If you are not able to delete your device from Alexa app, use a light switch to quickly turn the light on and off five times. When you turn the light on the sixth time, the bulb flashes quickly five times, then flashes twice softly. This indicates that the bulb has been factory reset, and it is ready for setup again.

Problem

If I lose the Quick Setup Guide or no barcode is available, how can I set up my smart bulb?

Solutions

- ▶ You can set up your device without a barcode. The instructions can be found in "Alternative setup method" on page 5.

Problem

Error code (-1 :-1 :-1 :-1) displays on the screen.

Solutions

- ▶ Make sure your phone has Bluetooth turned on throughout the entire setup process and the device you are trying to setup is in pairing mode. Restart your device by powering it off and on, and then set up again.

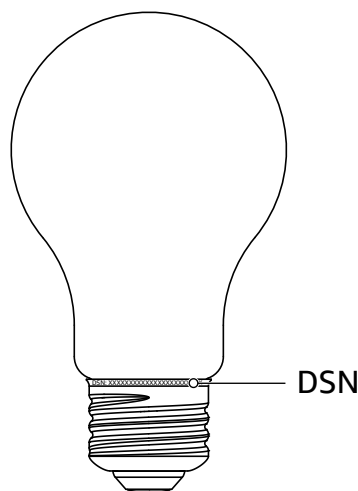

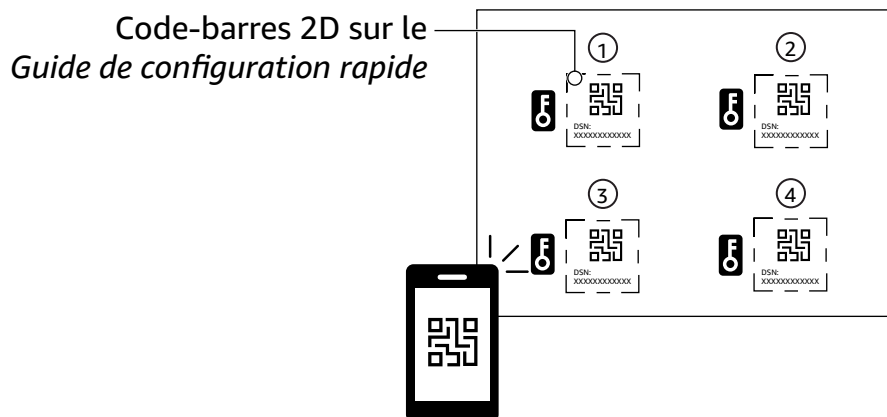

Modification des paramètres avec Alexa

Utilisez l'application Alexa pour renommer une lumière, ajouter des lumières à un groupe ou une pièce ou configurer des routines qui allument ou éteignent automatiquement une lumière.

Rétablissement aux paramètres d'usine

- Supprimez votre ampoule de l'application Alexa pour la réinitialiser aux paramètres d'usine.
- OU
- Activez un interrupteur pour allumer et éteindre rapidement la lumière cinq fois. Lorsque vous l'allumez pour la sixième fois, l'ampoule clignote rapidement cinq fois, puis deux fois lentement. Cela indique que l'ampoule a été réinitialisée aux paramètres d'usine et qu'elle est à nouveau prête à être configurée.

Nettoyage et entretien

- Pour nettoyer l'ampoule à DEL intelligente à filament, essuyez-la avec un chiffon doux et légèrement humide.

Dépannage

Problème

Solutions

Problème

L'application Alexa ne trouve pas l'ampoule intelligente ou ne peut pas s'y connecter.

Solutions

- ▶ Assurez-vous de numériser le code-barres 2D dans le *Guide de configuration rapide*. Ne numérisez pas le code-barres sur l'emballage pour la configuration.
- ▶ Vérifiez que votre téléphone ou votre tablette ainsi que l'application Alexa sont bien à jour.
- ▶ Assurez-vous que votre téléphone ou votre tablette et votre ampoule à DEL intelligente sont connectés au même réseau Wi-Fi 2,4 GHz. L'ampoule n'est pas compatible avec les réseaux 5 GHz.

Problème

Comment puis-je réinitialiser l'ampoule?

Solutions

- ▶ Vous pouvez effectuer une réinitialisation aux paramètres d'usine en supprimant votre appareil de l'application Alexa.
- ▶ Si vous ne parvenez pas à supprimer votre appareil de l'application Alexa : éteignez et rallumez la lumière cinq fois à l'aide de l'interrupteur. Lorsque vous l'allumez pour la sixième fois, l'ampoule clignote rapidement cinq fois, puis deux fois lentement. Cela indique que l'ampoule a été réinitialisée aux paramètres d'usine et qu'elle est à nouveau prête à être configurée.

Problème

Si je perds le Guide de configuration rapide ou si aucun code-barres n'est disponible, comment puis-je configurer mon ampoule intelligente?

Solutions

- ▶ Vous pouvez configurer votre appareil sans code-barres. Les instructions se trouvent dans « Autres méthodes de configuration » à la page 13.

Problème

Le code d'erreur (-1:-1:-1:-1) s'affiche à l'écran.

Solutions

- ▶ Assurez-vous que le Bluetooth est activé sur votre téléphone tout au long du processus de configuration et que l'appareil que vous essayez de configurer est en mode de jumelage. Redémarrez votre appareil en l'éteignant et en le rallumant, puis reprenez la configuration.

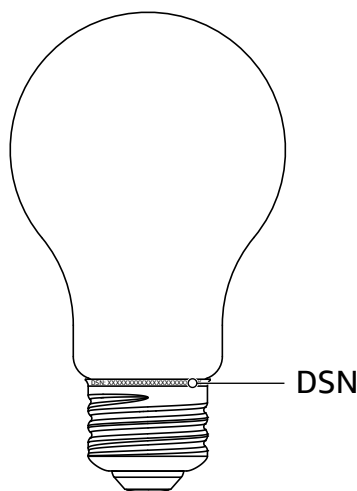

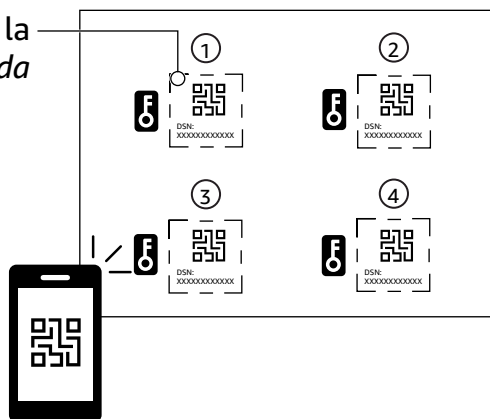
