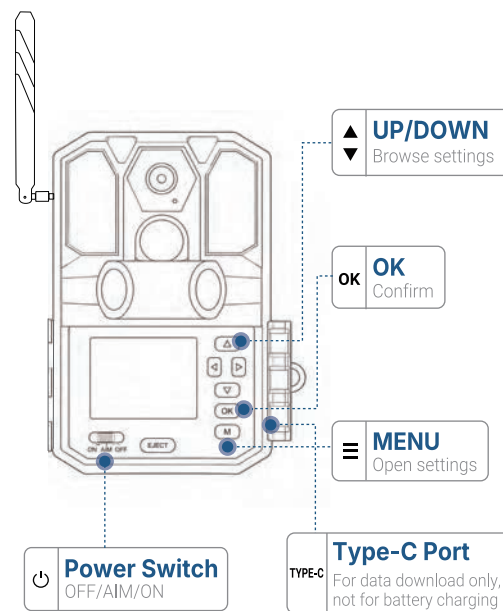
Start in 60 Seconds

- 1 Install AA battery**
 - Insert 8 new AA batteries into the battery pack
 - Install the battery pack into the camera.
- 2 Insert SD Card**
 - Class 10 or higher class up to 512GB max
 - Required before use
- 3 Switch to AIM**
 - Adjust settings
 - (Time / Date / Camera ID)
- 4 Switch to ON**
 - Camera starts monitoring
- 5 Install WiFi Antenna**
 - Attach the Wi-Fi antenna to the camera

1. Download the Wosports app & sign up for an account.



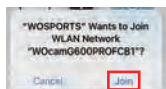
2. Switch the camera to **AIM mode**, press and hold the **M** button for 3 seconds to show the QR code



3. Click the "+" button and enter the AP Networking interface, scan the QR code on the camera's screen by the phone



4. After scan the QR code successfully, switch the camera to **ON mode**, click the device on the App and join the device's WiFi network

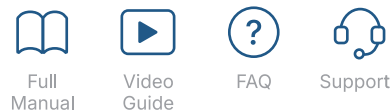
