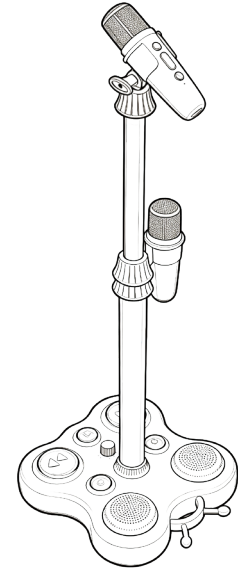


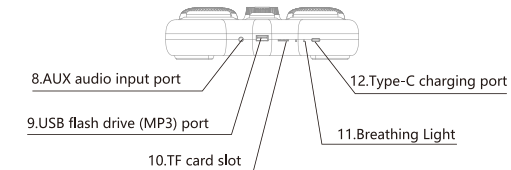
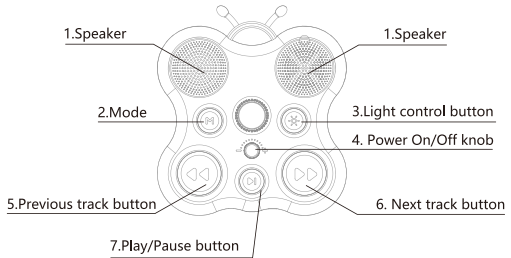

●1. Product Appearance and Function Description

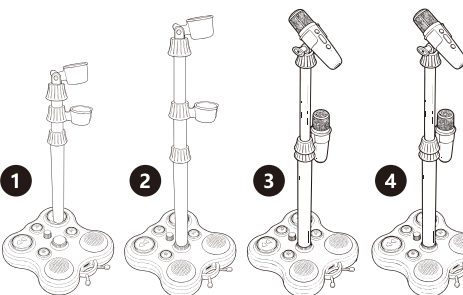

●2. Assembly Steps (Vertical Stand)

- Align the bottom of the white telescopic pole with the socket on the main unit's base and insert it vertically until it clicks into place;
- Twist the locking mechanism on the side of the pole to adjust the height to suit the child, then tighten it to secure the position;
- Snap the two wireless microphone holders into the designated slots on the pole to hold the microphones;
- Once assembled, place the unit on a flat, level surface; the widened base design ensures stability and prevents tipping.



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●3. Charging Instructions

- Take out the included Type-C charging cable; insert the small connector into the Type-C charging port on the main unit, and connect the large connector to a 5V mobile phone charger or a computer USB port.
- The indicator light on the unit turns on while charging and automatically turns off when fully charged.
- From a completely drained state, it takes 2-3 hours to fully charge; a full charge allows for approximately 4 hours of singing.
- Note: The microphone and the main unit share the same charging cable; if the microphone runs out of power, it can be charged separately by plugging in the cable.
- If the device is not used for an extended period, please charge it once a month to preserve the lithium battery's lifespan.

●4. Multi-Device Connection Instructions

- Mode 1: Bluetooth Connection (Recommended for smartphones, tablets, and computers)
Turn the knob clockwise to power on, then briefly press the MODE button to switch to Bluetooth mode; the indicator light will flash, signaling it is ready for pairing. Enable Bluetooth on your phone, search for the device name "BK06," and select it to pair. A prompt will sound upon successful connection; open a music app to start playing songs. Supports simultaneous singing with dual wireless microphones.
- Troubleshooting pairing failures: Turn the knob counter-clockwise to power off and restart, then search for the Bluetooth device again.
- Mode 2: TF Card Playback
While the device is powered off, insert a TF card containing MP3 music files into the TF card slot on the main unit. Power on the device and briefly press MODE to switch to TF mode; the music on the card will play automatically.
- Mode 3: AUX Wired Audio Input
Connect one end of a 3.5mm audio cable to the AUX port on the main unit and the other end to the headphone jack of a smartphone, computer, or TV.
- Press MODE to switch to AUX mode to play audio from the external device.
- Mode 4: Type-C Audio Input
Connect a Type-C data cable directly to your computer or smartphone for synchronized audio playback.

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●5. Wireless Microphone User Guide

- Turning on the microphone: Press and hold the power button on the side of the microphone for 2 seconds to turn it on; it will automatically pair with the main unit—no extra steps required.
- Dual-microphone synchronization: Both microphones can be turned on simultaneously for duets, preventing arguments between children.
- Voice changing: Short press the microphone's function button to cycle through 5 fun vocal effects (Cute Girl, Deep Male Voice, Robot, Echo, and Original Voice).
- Volume: Using the + and - buttons on the microphone to adjust.
- Power off: Long press the microphone's power button for 3 seconds to turn it off.

●6. Lighting, Voice Changing, and Reverb Functions

- Ambient lighting: Short press the main unit's light control button to cycle through lighting modes: rhythmic pulse, steady on, and off. The lights flash in sync with the music rhythm.
- Echo/Reverb effect: Rotate the main unit's volume knob to adjust the vocal reverb level, creating a KTV-style singing experience.
- 5 voice-changing effects: Switch instantly using the microphone button—perfect for fun role-playing and interactive games for children.

●7. Daily Use & Feedback Prevention Tips

- Volume Adjustment: It is recommended to lower the overall volume for young children to protect their hearing.
- Feedback Prevention: Keep the microphone away from the main unit's speaker base during use and avoid pointing the microphone directly at the speaker face; doing so may cause harsh feedback (whistling).
- Portability: A concealed handle on the back allows for easy one-handed carrying—perfect for indoor use, picnics, or birthday parties.
- Foot-Controlled Song Switching: Use the foot pedal on the base to switch songs; this allows for hands-free operation while singing, ensuring a smoother performance.
- Screen-Free Eye Protection: Operates via physical buttons, helping to reduce children's screen time.

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●Safety Precautions:

- This product is intended for children aged 3 and older. Children under 3 require constant parental supervision to prevent the accidental ingestion of small parts.
- Do not drop, throw, or apply heavy pressure to the unit; keep away from water, rain, and other liquid sources.
- Use a standard 5V safety charger; do not use high-power fast chargers for extended periods.
- Do not disassemble the internal circuitry of the main unit or microphone to avoid electric shock or damage to the lithium battery. Store the product properly after use; do not allow children to use it at high volumes for prolonged periods to protect their hearing development.
- The product is made of eco-friendly soft rubber and ABS, featuring a fully rounded design with no sharp edges.

⚠ WARNING

- This product contains a sealed rechargeable lithium battery, not user-replaceable.
- Do not disassemble, puncture, crush, heat or incinerate the battery module. Risk of fire, explosion or chemical leakage if damaged.
- Keep product away from open flame, high temperature and direct sunlight for long periods.
- Keep this product and all batteries out of reach of children under 3 years old.
- Do not charge with incompatible chargers; only use the supplied charging cable.
- Unplug charger once fully charged, do not overcharge overnight.
- If battery swells, leaks or emits odor, stop use immediately and dispose properly.

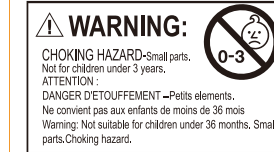
