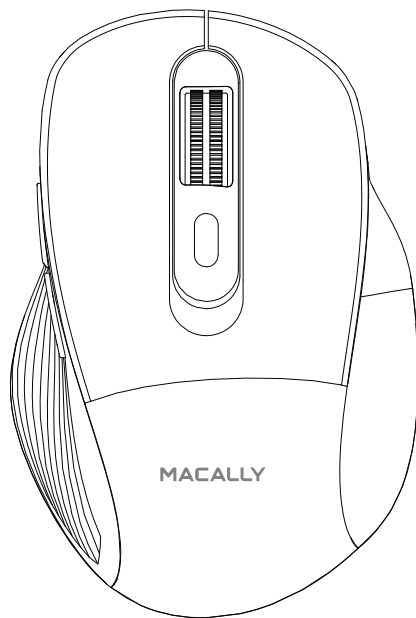

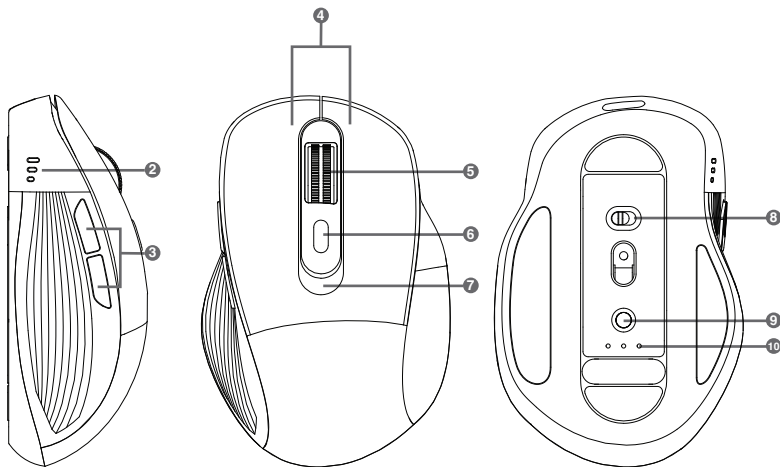

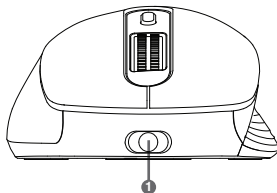

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- Bluetooth-enabled Apple computer, laptop, iPad, mobile device and Windows PC.
- Laptop, desktop etc. with an available USB-C port for charging the mouse.
- USB-C wall charger for charging the mouse (alternative if your laptop/desktop does not have a USB-C port).

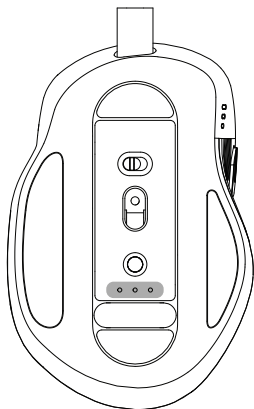
HARDWARE BASICS





- 1.USB-C Charging Port
- 2.Battery LED
 - (Low battery warning: Top DPI LED indicator 7 will flash, user needs to charge the mouse)
 - i.Solid Red – Charging
 - ii.Green – Fully Charged
 - iii.Off – Normal status if mouse works and charging cable isn't plugged in; Or charging doesn't work if charging cable is plugged into a computer or charger)
- 3.Back and forward buttons
- 4.Left and right click buttons
- 5.Scroll Wheel and middle button
- 6.DPI Button
- 7.LED indicator lights briefly for DPI
 - i.Red – 800 DPI
 - ii.Green – 1600 DPI
 - iii.Blue – 2400 DPI
 - iv.Yellow – 3200 DPI
 - v.Purple – 4000 DPI
- 8.On/Off Switch
- 9.BT button – Pairing and channel switch
10. Bluetooth indicators
 - i.B1 Blue – Bluetooth Channel 1
 - 1.Blinking Blue – Pairing
 - 2.Solid Blue then Off – Paired
 - ii.B2 Blue – Bluetooth Channel 2
 - 1.Blinking Blue – Pairing
 - 2.Solid Blue then Off – Paired
 - iii.B3 Blue – Bluetooth Channel 3
 - 1.Blinking Blue – Pairing
 - 2.Solid Blue then Off – Paired

BLUETOOTH PAIRING INSTRUCTIONS



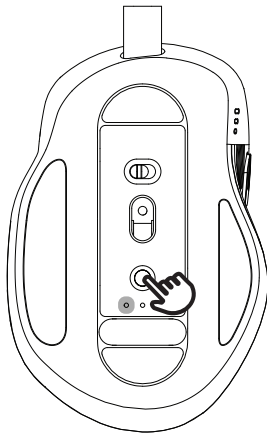
Take a look at the bottom of the mouse. Like what is highlighted grey in above picture, you should see 3 LEDs labeled B1, B2 and B3. That is the Bluetooth indicator.

To pair your mouse to a Bluetooth-enabled device (Computer, Laptop, Phone, tablet), make sure the mouse is on and charged, then follow the steps below:

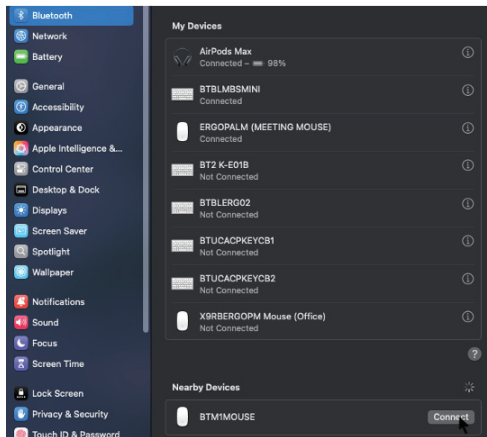
NOTE

We will use Bluetooth channel 1 (B1) in these steps.

1. Open the Bluetooth settings on the device you are pairing the mouse to (laptop, desktop, tablet, phone, etc).



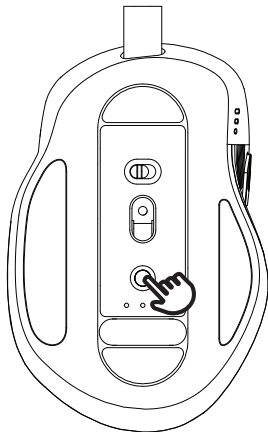
2. Press the BT button briefly to select B1 channel, then hold down BT button until the LED on the Bluetooth Indicator B1 flashes rapidly.



3. Click or tap the name BTM1MOUSE on your screen to pair the mouse. Once paired, the B1 LED should stay solid blue, then shut off.

To pair the mouse to a second device, follow the same steps above for the other two Bluetooth channels (B2 & B3).

SWITCHING BETWEEN MULTIPLE DEVICES

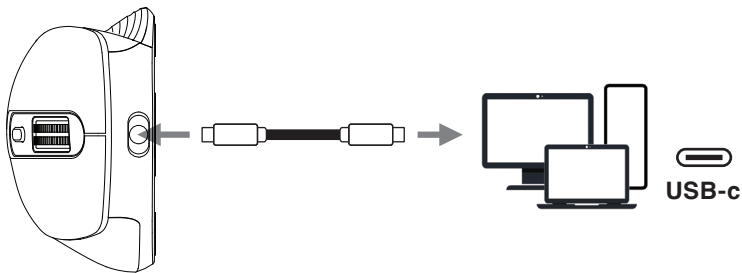


Once you have all your devices paired to the mouse, switching between them is as simple as pressing the BT button briefly.

NOTE

Reconnect time may vary depending on the Bluetooth version of the connected devices.

CHARGING THE MOUSE



To charge the mouse, simply plug the USB-C end of the provided cable into any available USB-C port on your computer, laptop, or USB-C wall charger, and insert the other USB-C end of the cable into the USB-C port located in the front of the mouse.

NOTE: Using the cable only charges the mouse. It does not convert the mouse into a “wired” device.

Battery LED:

(Low battery warning: Top DPI LED indicator 7 will flash, user needs to charge the mouse)

- Solid Red – Charging
- Green – Fully Charged
- Off – Normal status if the mouse works and the charging cable isn’t plugged in; Or charging doesn’t work if the charging cable is plugged into a computer or charger.

NOTE

1. the mouse cable can be connected to a USB-C port wall charger; 2. if you have USB-A port in either computer or wall charger, you need to get a female USB-C to male USB-A adaptor plugged into Macally cable included, or use your own USB-C to USB-A cable in order to charge.
