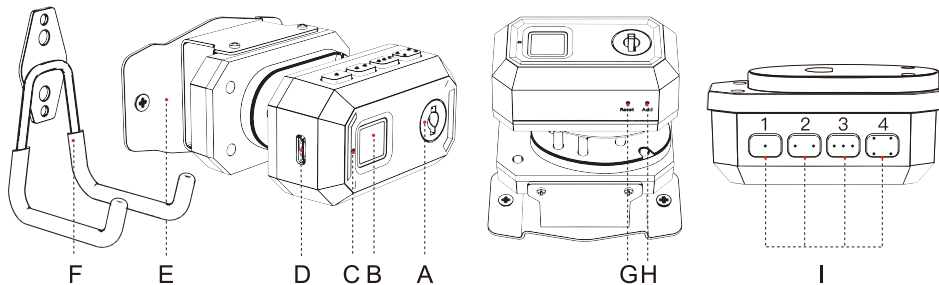
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A. Keyhole

H. Add Button

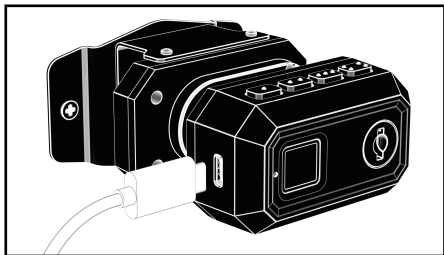

Assembly and Setup Guide

Step 1: Charge the Trigger Lock

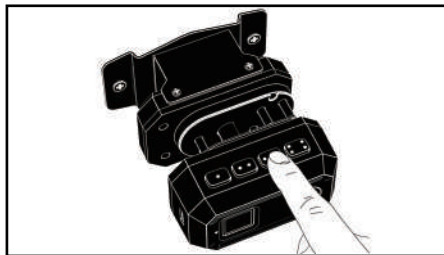
Plug the included USB-C cable into the charging port.
Charge the trigger lock for 4 hours before first use.

⚠ Low battery warning: Beeps 4 times and the indicator light flashes red 4 times.



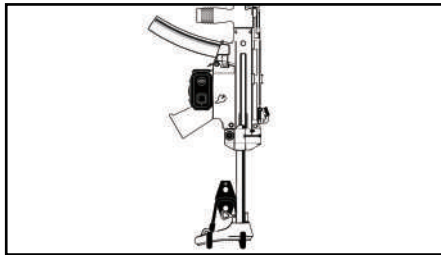
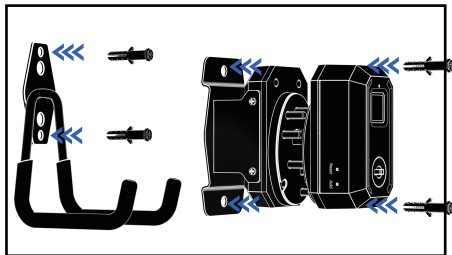
Step 2: Set Your Unlock Password

Set your unlock password before first use. See Page 4 for detailed instructions.



Step 3: Install the Trigger Lock

Use the included screws to secure the wall mount and gun support hook to your desired location.



Note: For convenient charging, we recommend installing the gun lock near a power outlet.

Trigger Lock Quick Setup



Please use the included "Pin" on the cover page to press "**Reset**" and "**Add**"

Password Setting

Enter default password "**12341**"



Press "**Add**" within 60s (Indicator starts flashing **blue**)



Enter a 5-10 digit password



Press "**Reset**" (Indicator turns **green** with a long beep, then remains flashing **blue**)



Re-enter the same password



Press "**Reset**" again (Indicator turns **green** with two long beeps)

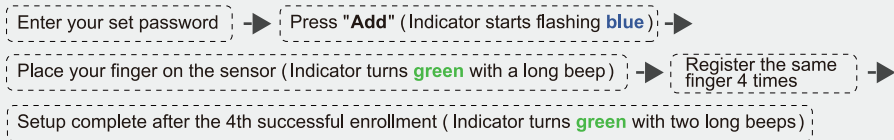


Setup complete

Note: If the indicator turns red, setup has failed. Please restart the setup process from the beginning.

⚠ To change the password, the trigger lock must first be reset. See page 6 for instructions.

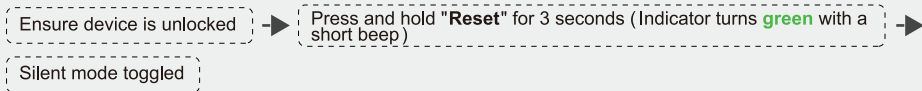
Fingerprint Setting



Note: If the indicator turns red, setup has failed. Please restart the fingerprint entry process.

⚠ To add more fingerprints, repeat the steps above. Up to 100 fingerprints can be enrolled.

Toggle Silent Mode



Reset the Trigger Lock

- Ensure device is unlocked → Press "**Reset**" 3 times within 60s (Indicator turns **green** with a long beep)
- Factory reset complete → To set up a new password or fingerprint, please refer to the instructions on page 4-5

Delete Fingerprint

- Ensure device is unlocked → Press and hold "**Add**" for 3 seconds (Indicator starts flashing **red**) →
- Place the finger to be deleted on the scanner (Indicator turns **green** with a short beep) →
- Fingerprint deletion complete

Note: A flashing red power indicator light during any of the above setup procedures indicates that the setup has failed. Please try again.

Trigger Lock Installation Demonstration

For a secure fit on more firearms, this trigger lock features multiple steel pins. Simply adjust the lock's position to match the shape of your firearm's trigger guard and trigger.

- Key Position: Contact Point with the Trigger
- Auxiliary Position: Contact Point with the Trigger Guard

Q & A

Q: How long does the battery last in standby mode?

A: The battery lasts about 3 to 5 months in standby mode, or up to 2,000 unlocks. We recommend charging the battery every 2 months.

Q: Why can't my fingerprints be recognized?

A: Before enrolling fingerprints, it is necessary to set a password first. Additionally, please ensure that your fingers are clean and free of dirt or moisture, as these may affect fingerprint recognition.

Q: What should I do if I lose my key?

A: For security reasons, replacement keys are not available. Please store your keys in a safe and secure location.

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
