

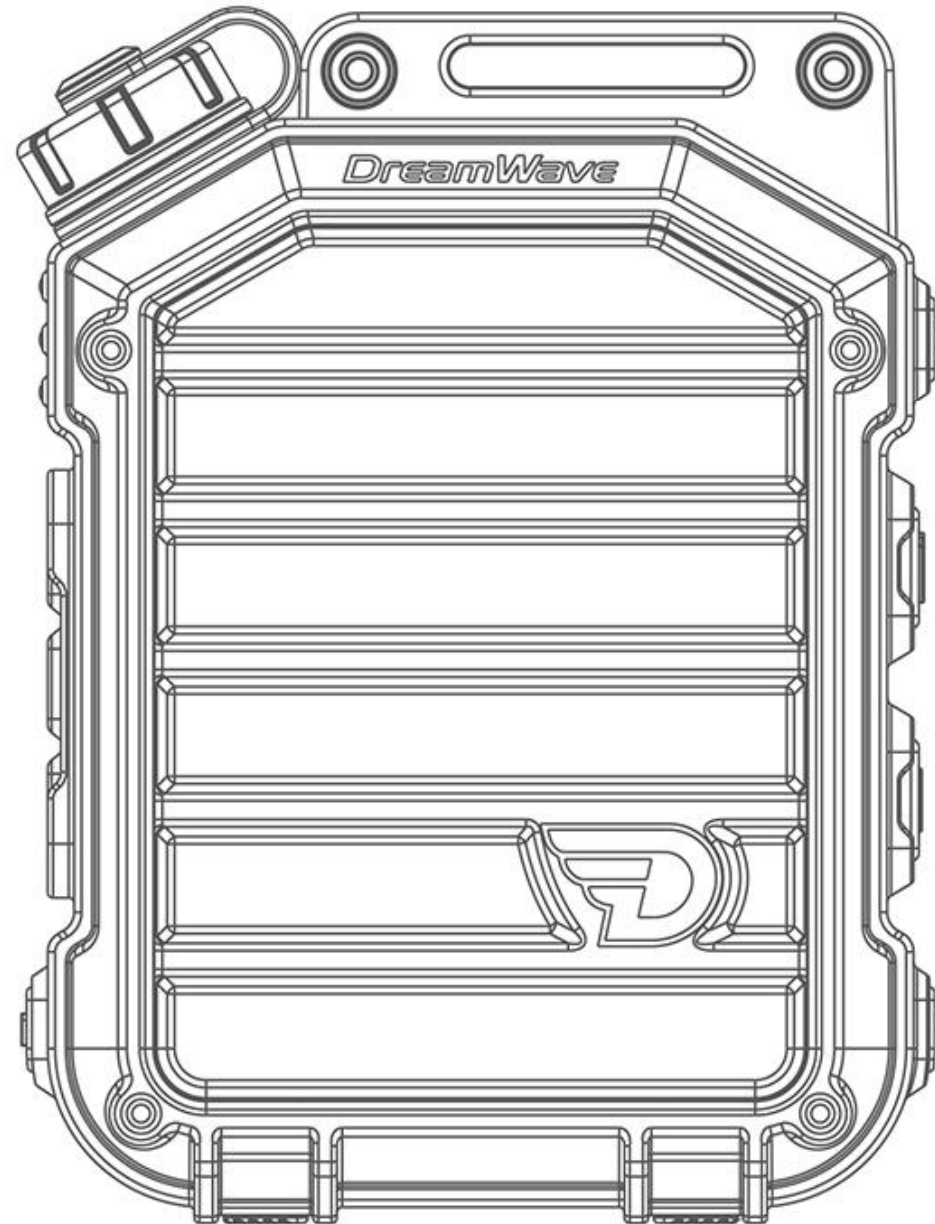

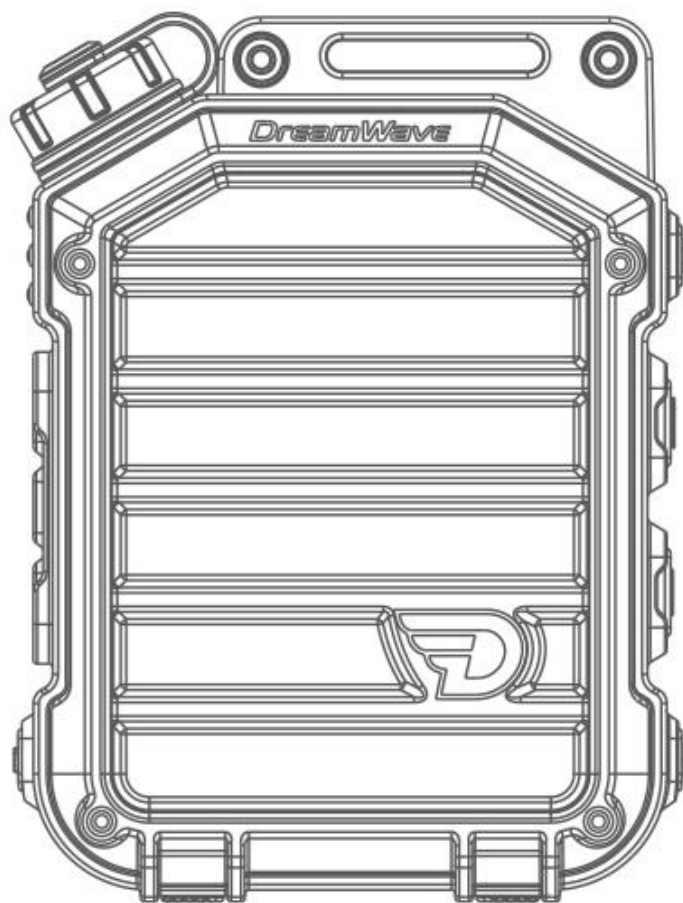

This device has been evaluated to meet general RF exposure requirements. The device can be used in portable exposure conditions without restriction.

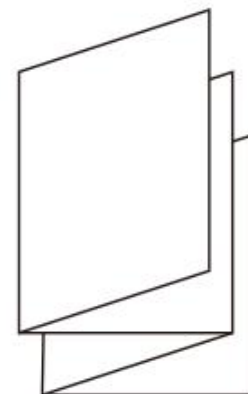

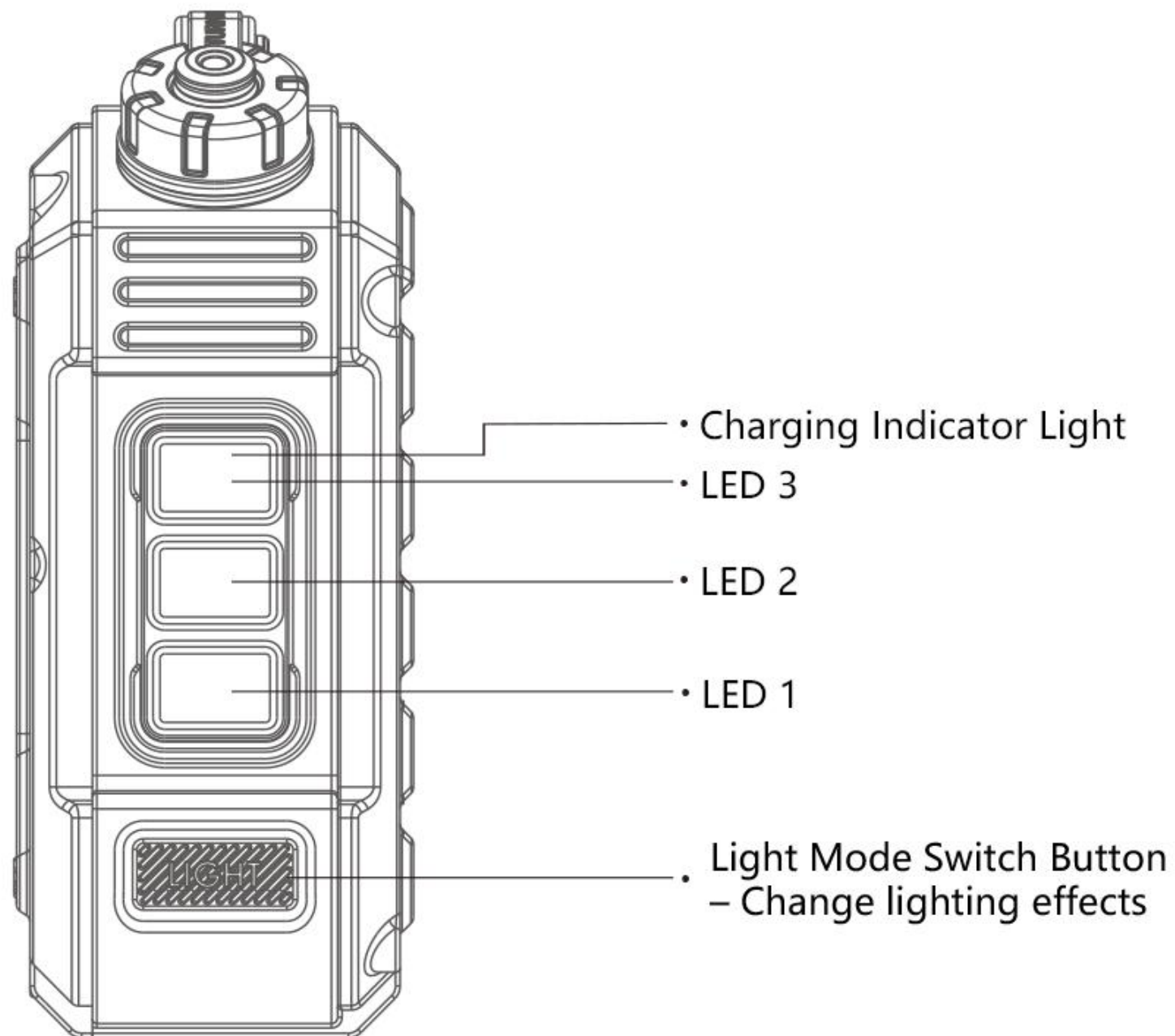

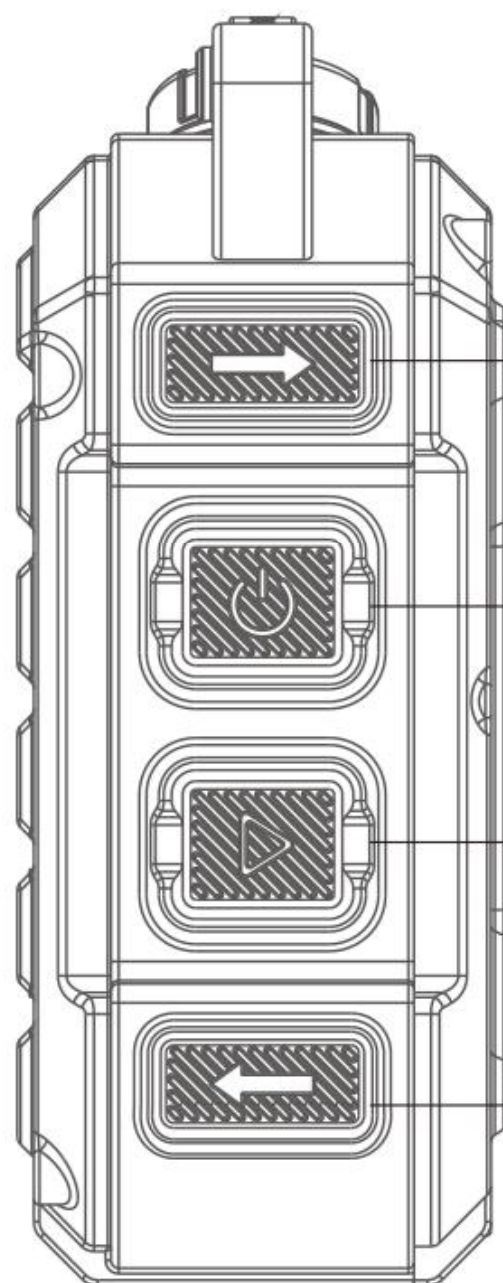

Power / Party Mode Button

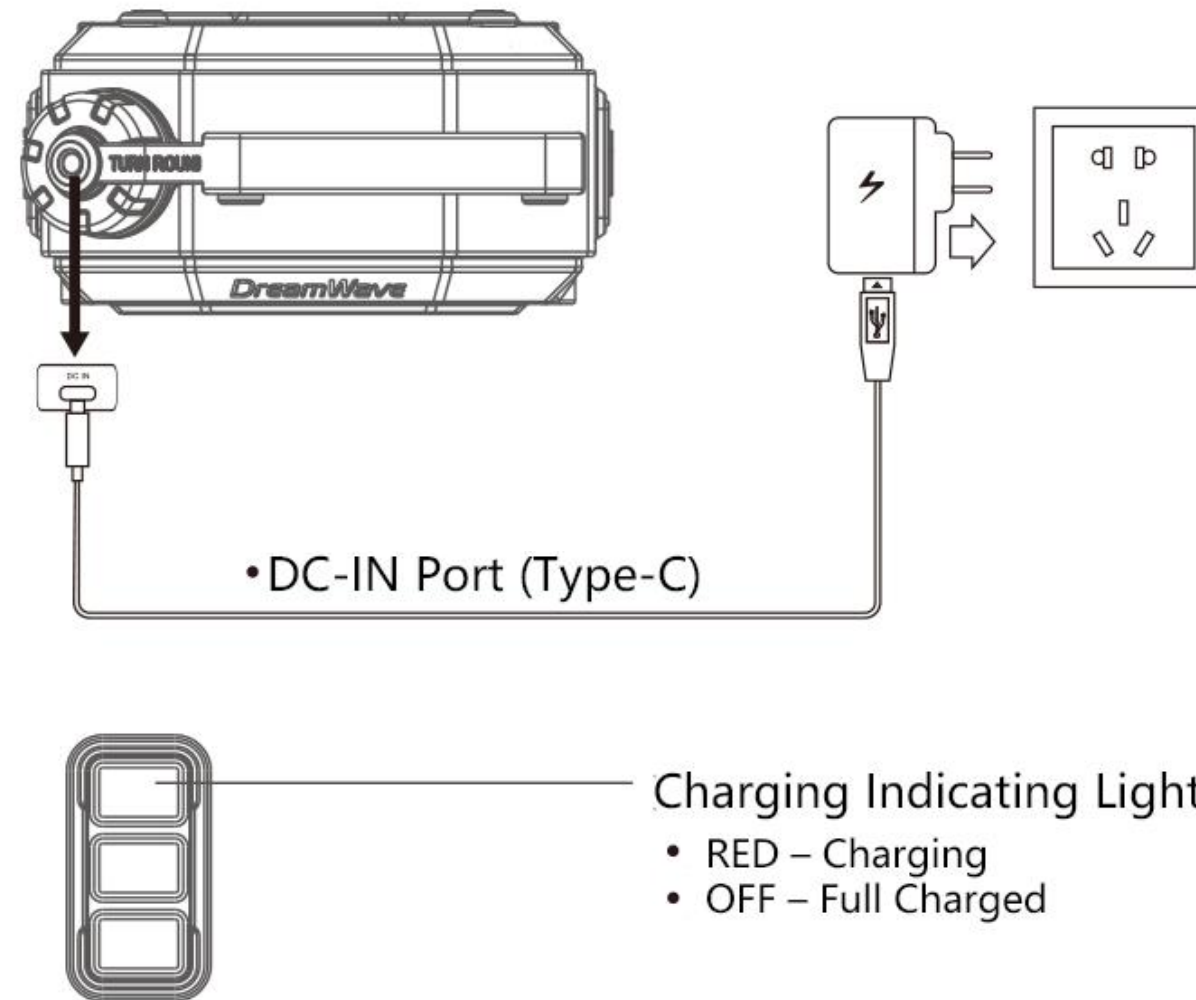
- Long press >5 sec: Power ON/OFF

Volume – Decrease volume

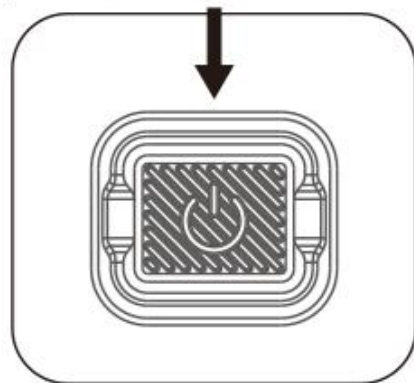
Charge Your Portable Speaker



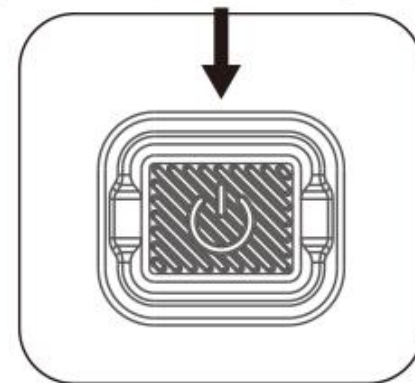
Use included Type-C cable with a 5V/1.5A or higher adapter
(adapter not included)

Power ON/OFF

Press and hold for 3 seconds
the power button to ON

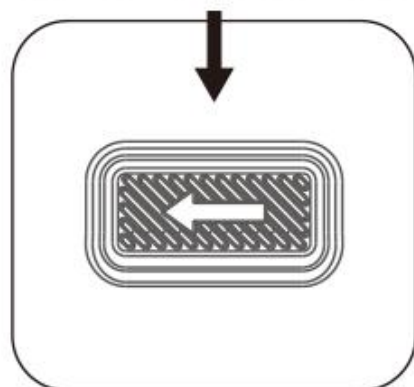


Press and hold for 3 seconds
the power button again to OFF

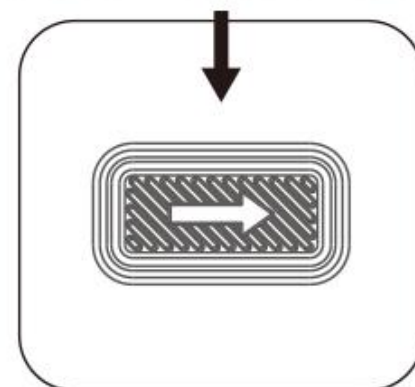


Volume Adjustment

Press to increase volume

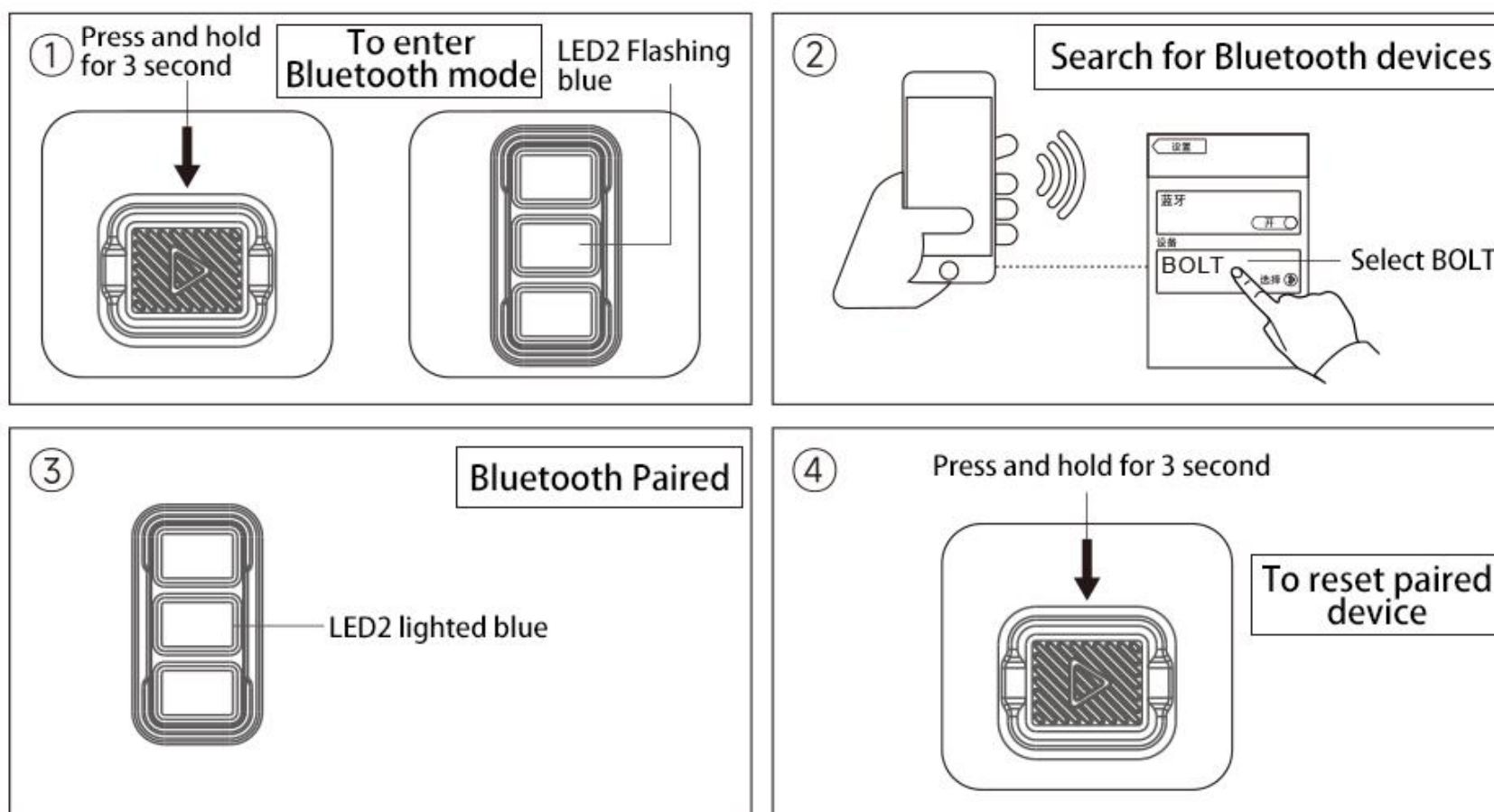


Standby Mode

The speaker will automatically power off after 10 minutes of inactivity (no music playing).

Bluetooth Connection

- ① Turn on the speaker – Long press the power button for 3 seconds. The speaker enters Bluetooth pairing mode automatically, and the Bluetooth indicator flashes blue.
- ② Pair your device – On your phone, tablet, or computer, turn on Bluetooth, search for "BOLT," and tap to connect.
For iOS 5.0 or higher (iPhone), the battery level will be shown on your device after pairing.
- ③ Connection successful – The Bluetooth indicator stays solid blue.
- ④ Re-pair or switch devices – Long press the Bluetooth button for 3 seconds to re-enter pairing mode.



TWS Dual Pairing Mode (True Stereo Mode with Two BOLT Speakers)

Pair two BOLT speakers for true wireless stereo (left + right channels).

Before you begin: **Make sure both speakers are disconnected from any Bluetooth devices.**

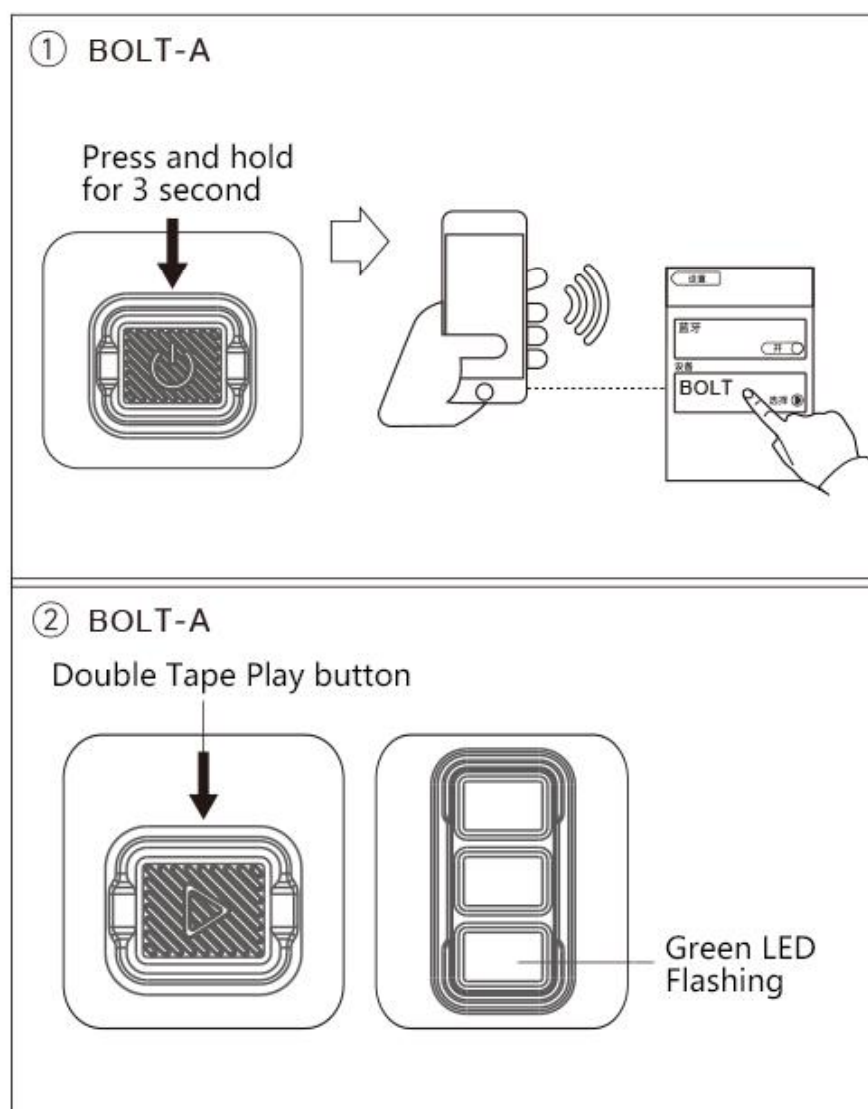
Set up TWS:

Master BOLT-A Slave BOLT-B

Step 1 Turn on BOLT-A (host) – Long press the power button for 3 seconds. Pair it with your phone.

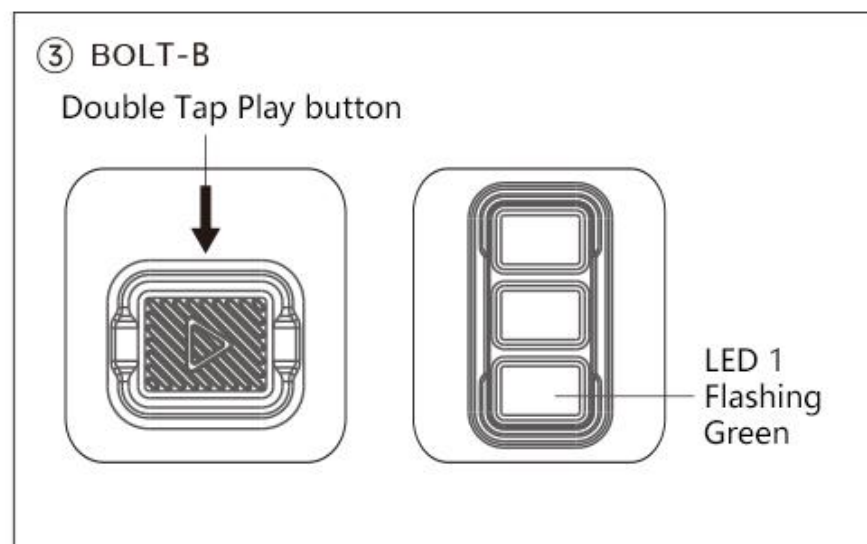


Step 2 Enter TWS mode on BOLT-A – Short press the play/pause button. The indicator flashes green quickly.



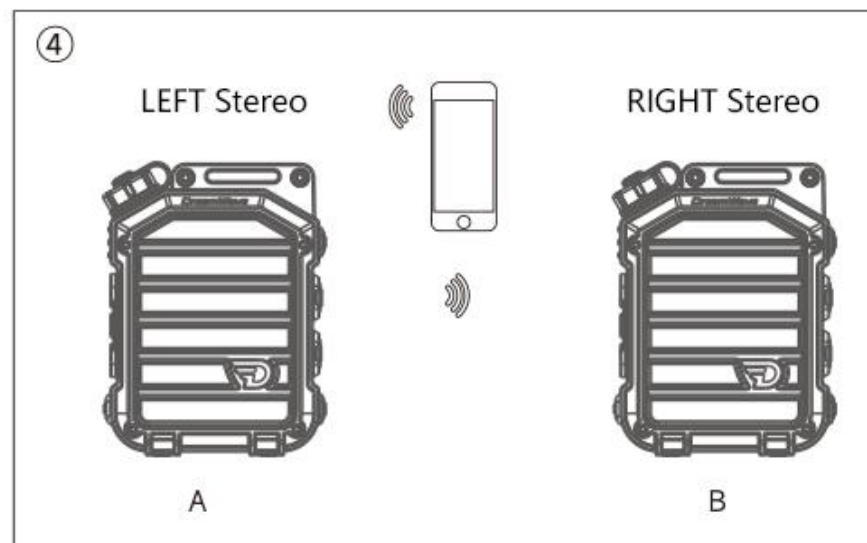
TWS Dual Pairing Mode (True Stereo Mode with Two BOLT Speakers)

Step 3 Double Tap
Play button of BOLT-B
Till LED flashing green.



Step 4 BOLT-A & BOLT-B
will automatically pair
with each other.

The master device' s
LED display flashing blue
LED + Green LED, slave
device' s LED will only
show green LED. Pair the
phone with the master
device to play the music.



Notes:

1. To exit TWS mode, short press the play/pause button on either speaker. Both will exit.
2. Once paired, the two speakers will automatically reconnect in TWS mode the next time you turn them on.

Multi-Speaker Pairing Mode (Host + Multiple Speakers)

Set up TWS:

Master BOLT-A Slave BOLT-B Slave BOLT-C.....

Steps:

- ① Turn on BOLT-A – Long press power. Pair it with your phone via Bluetooth.



- ② Enter multi-pairing mode on BOLT-A – Short press the power button. The red light stays on.

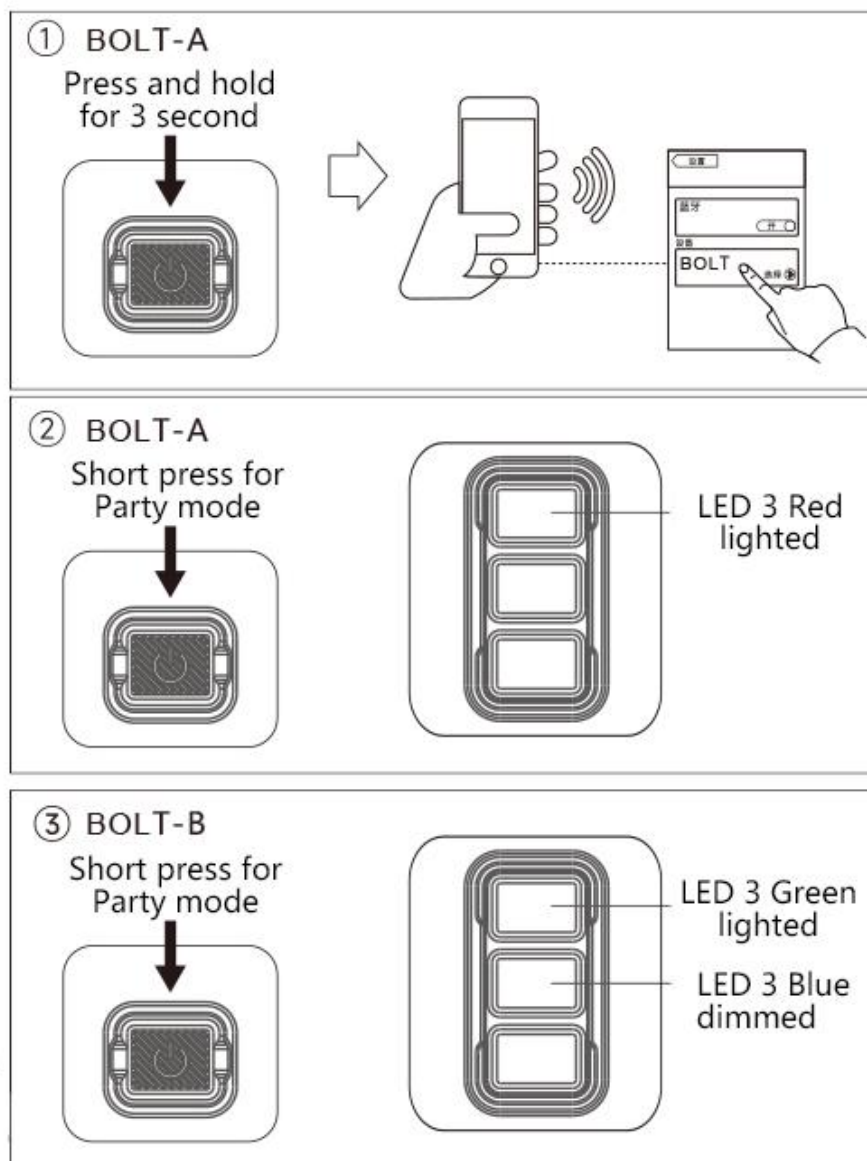


- ③ Connect BOLT-B – Make sure BOLT-B is disconnected from all devices. Short press its power button. The green light stays on (Bluetooth light off), and it will automatically connect to BOLT-A.



- ④ Add more speakers – Repeat step 3 for BOLT-C, BOLT-D, etc.

To exit multi-speaker mode: Short press the power button on any speaker.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Cause	Suggested Solution
Speaker won't turn on	• Battery is low	• Charge the speaker by connecting the Type-C cable to a power adapter. If the speaker hasn't been used for a long time, charge it once every 1–2 months to extend battery life.
Speaker is unresponsive	• Software glitch	• Turn the speaker off and then back on again.
No sound	• Wrong audio source selected • The connected music source device volume is muted or low volume	• Make sure your device is connected to the speaker and check if another connected device is playing music. • Increase the volume on your device or on the speaker.
Sound is distorted / crackling	• Poor quality audio file • Volume too high on your device or speaker	• Try playing a lossless or higher quality music file. • Lower the volume on your device or speaker.
Sound cuts out / Bluetooth keeps disconnecting	• Device too far from speaker, or blocked by obstacles	• Keep your device within 10 meters (about 33 feet) of the speaker, with no walls or doors in between.
Sound cuts out / volume is low	• Battery is very low	• Charge the speaker by connecting the Type-C cable to a power adapter.
Can't connect or pair Bluetooth device	• Speaker is already connected to another device • Too many paired devices in your Bluetooth list	• Long press the Bluetooth button to disconnect, then try pairing again. • Clear old paired devices from your Bluetooth list, then search for the speaker again.
