

Operation and Features:

Function Buttons

1.  Click to switch between wireless, TF CARD, USB, and FM. When both the TF CARD and USB are inserted, only the TF CARD will function. Long press to turn the LED on/off.
2.  Click to play the previous song in wireless and USB modes, and play the previous radio station in FM mode. Press and hold to decrease the volume.
3.  Short press to play/pause music. Long press to automatically search for radio stations in FM mode.
4.  Click to play the next song in wireless and USB modes, and play the previous radio station in FM mode. Press and hold to increase the volume.

Ports and Switches

1. **DC 5V Charging Port**
Used to charge the built-in battery. The red LED adjacent to the charging port will illuminate when the charging cable is inserted and the battery is charging. The red LED light will turn off when the battery is fully charged.
2. **OFF/ON Switch**
This switch turns the speaker power on/off.
3. **USB Port**
Supports USB and can play music in .mp3 and .wav formats.
4. **TF Card Port**
Supports TF CARD and can play music in .mp3 and .wav formats.

Wireless Connection/Pairing

- Turn on the product power and press the  to enter wireless mode.
- Open a wireless device (mobile phone, computer, etc.), enable pairing mode, and search for the speaker (the device name is M009).
- After the speaker is successfully paired for the first time, it will automatically reconnect the same device the next time.
- Each product can only be connected to one wireless device at a time.

Notes:

1. It's best to charge this device while turned off and not in use.
2. Do not use any corrosive cleaner / oil to clean the speaker.
3. If the speaker comes in contact with liquid, please wipe it off immediately.
4. If submersed in water, do not turn the speaker on until completely dried.
5. Please use the original charging cable provided by the manufacturer.
