

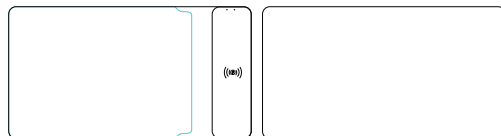
Wireless Charging Laptop Sleeve User Manual



Product Introduction

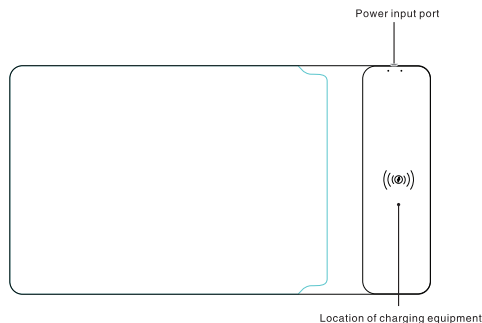

Location of charging equipment

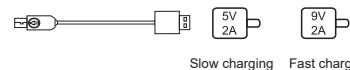
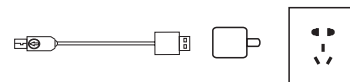
Compatible Devices

Note: All external receiving modules must comply with the WPC Qi standard for normal compatibility.

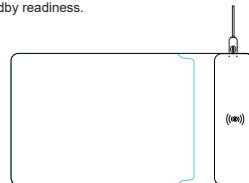
Operating Instructions

- 1.Connect the USB charging cable to an external power adapter.

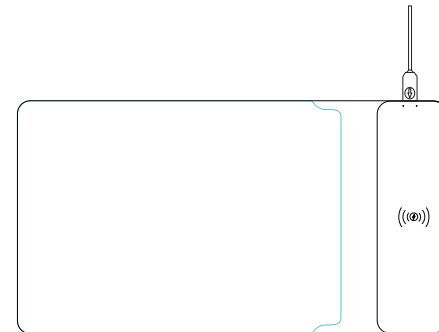


Slow charging Fast charging

- 2.Plug one end of the USB cable into the power input port of the wireless charging sleeve. After power-on, the charging indicator light will flash once to signal standby readiness.



- 3.Place your device with wireless charging receiver onto the marked charging zone. The indicator will stay solid blue during charging; the light will turn off once the device is removed.

Precautions

- 1.Keep the charger and receiving devices away from water and all other liquids.
- 2.Disconnect the power supply completely before cleaning the product.
- 3.Operating ambient temperature shall be maintained between 0°C and 45°C.
