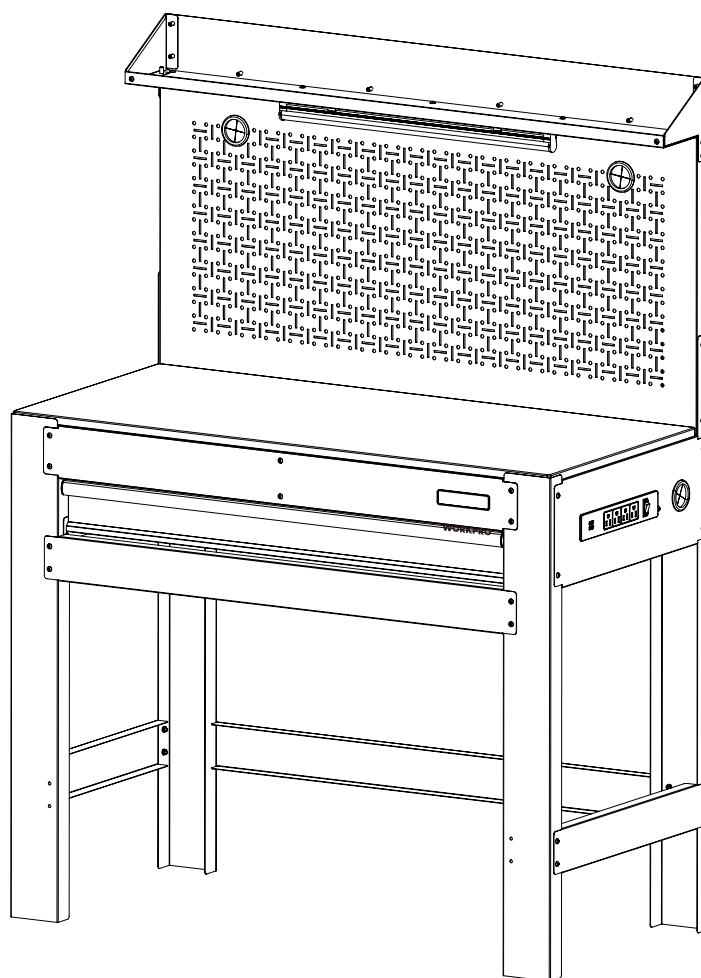

1. THIS PRODUCT IS INTENDED FOR INDOOR USE ONLY.

2. THIS PRODUCT IS NOT DESIGNED FOR COMMERCIAL NOR INDUSTRIAL USAGE.

CAUTION!

- Check all nuts and bolts periodically for tightness. When required, tighten them.
- DO NOT leave children unattended near this product.
- Keep the product on level surfaces. The product could become unstable and it may tip over if stored or moved on an uneven surface, which may cause personal injury, death or product damage.
- DO NOT alter this product in any manner. For example, do not weld external bar locks or attach electrical equipment. This may cause product damage or personal injury.
- Any assembly or maintenance of the product must be carried out by adults only.
- Use at least two people to move, assemble or install this workbench. Failure to do so can result in personal injury or product damage.
- DO NOT stand on the product and do not use it as scaffold.

3. EXTENSION CORD:

- Only use a three-wire extension cord with all three prongs intact. Never remove the round grounding prong.
- Extension cord must be connected to a 125Volt GFCI protected outlet with proper ground. If GFCI outlet is not available, use an extension cord with GFCI protection built in.
- Check the insulation and plugs of extension cord before using. Do NOT use cord if it is worn or damaged.
- Do NOT overload extension cord.
- Do NOT connect extension cord to outlet that also supplies critical safety equipment with power.

- Make sure the power supply cord is unplugged before any servicing or cleaning.

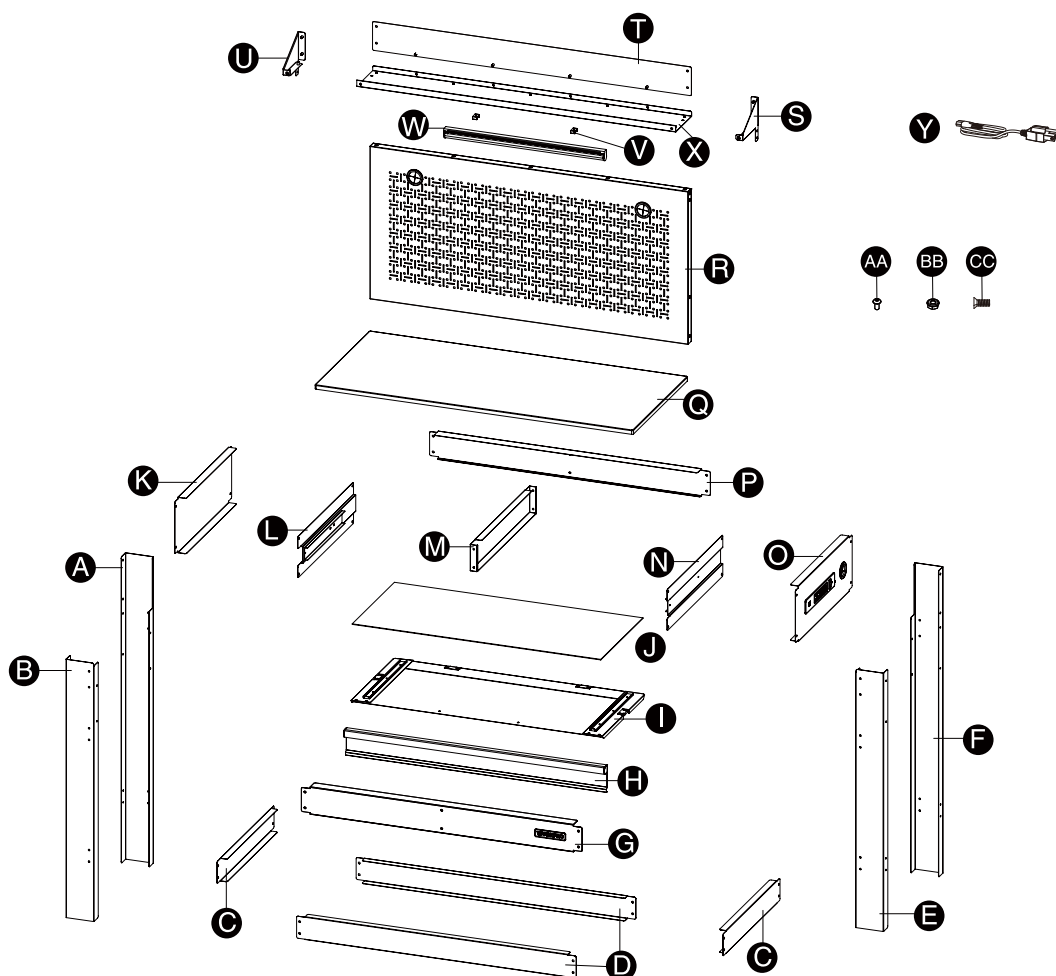

NOTE:

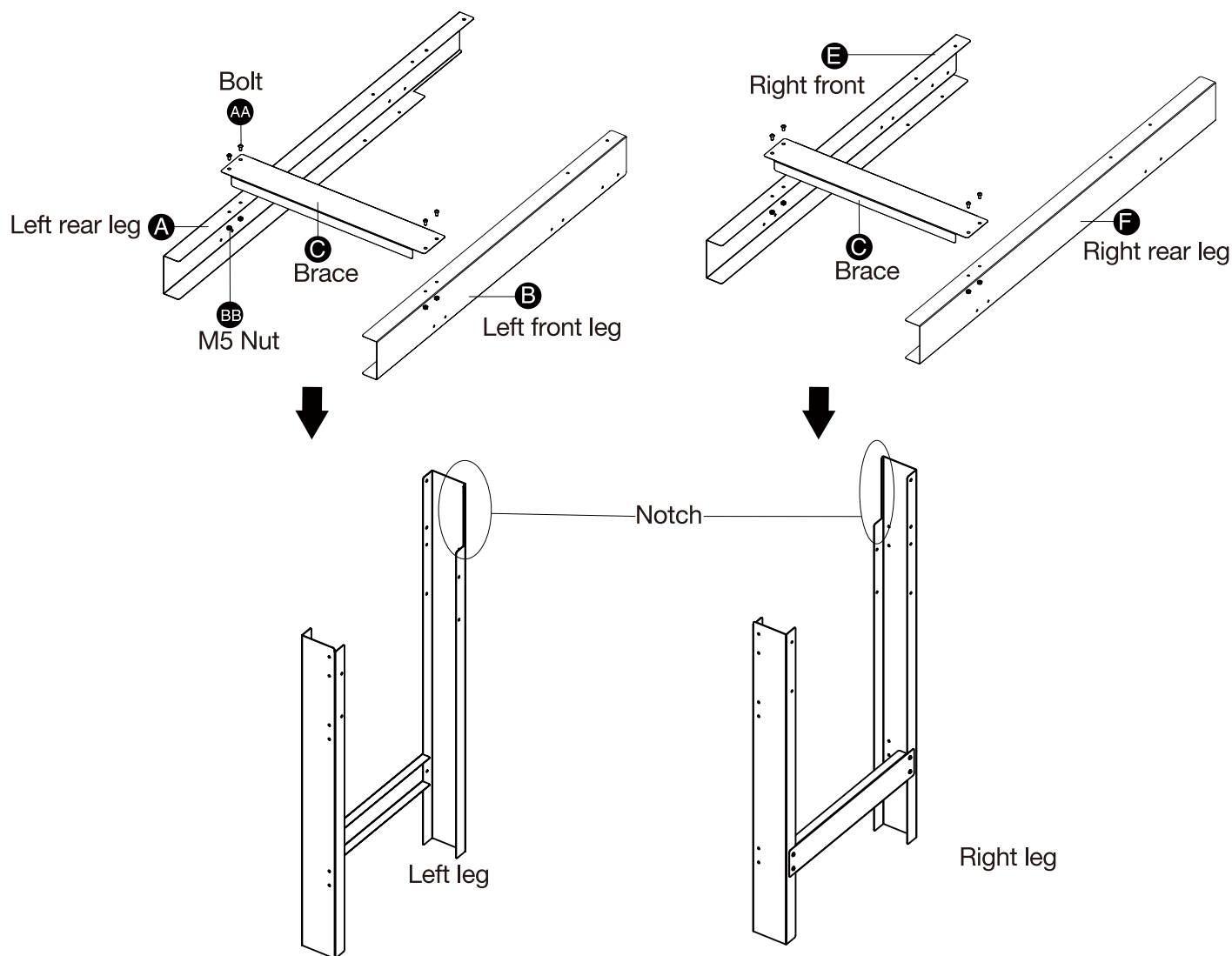
- Do not tighten all the bolts and nuts before the step 7. After the workbench is completely assembled, fully tighten each bolt.
- Two people are recommended for assembly.
- Assemble on a flat surface. A piece of cardboard is recommended to keep the product from being scratched during assembly.

STEP 1: INSTALL THE LEGS AND BRACES

- Assemble on a flat, level, hard and smooth surface capable of safely supporting a workbench.
- Attach the brace (C) to the left rear leg (A) and left front leg (B) and finger tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB). Do not tighten the bolt and nuts completely.
- Repeat above step to install the right legs (E&F) and brace (C).

NOTE:

- Make sure the rear legs (A&F) with notch facing inward.
- Place the legs on the side for easy installation.

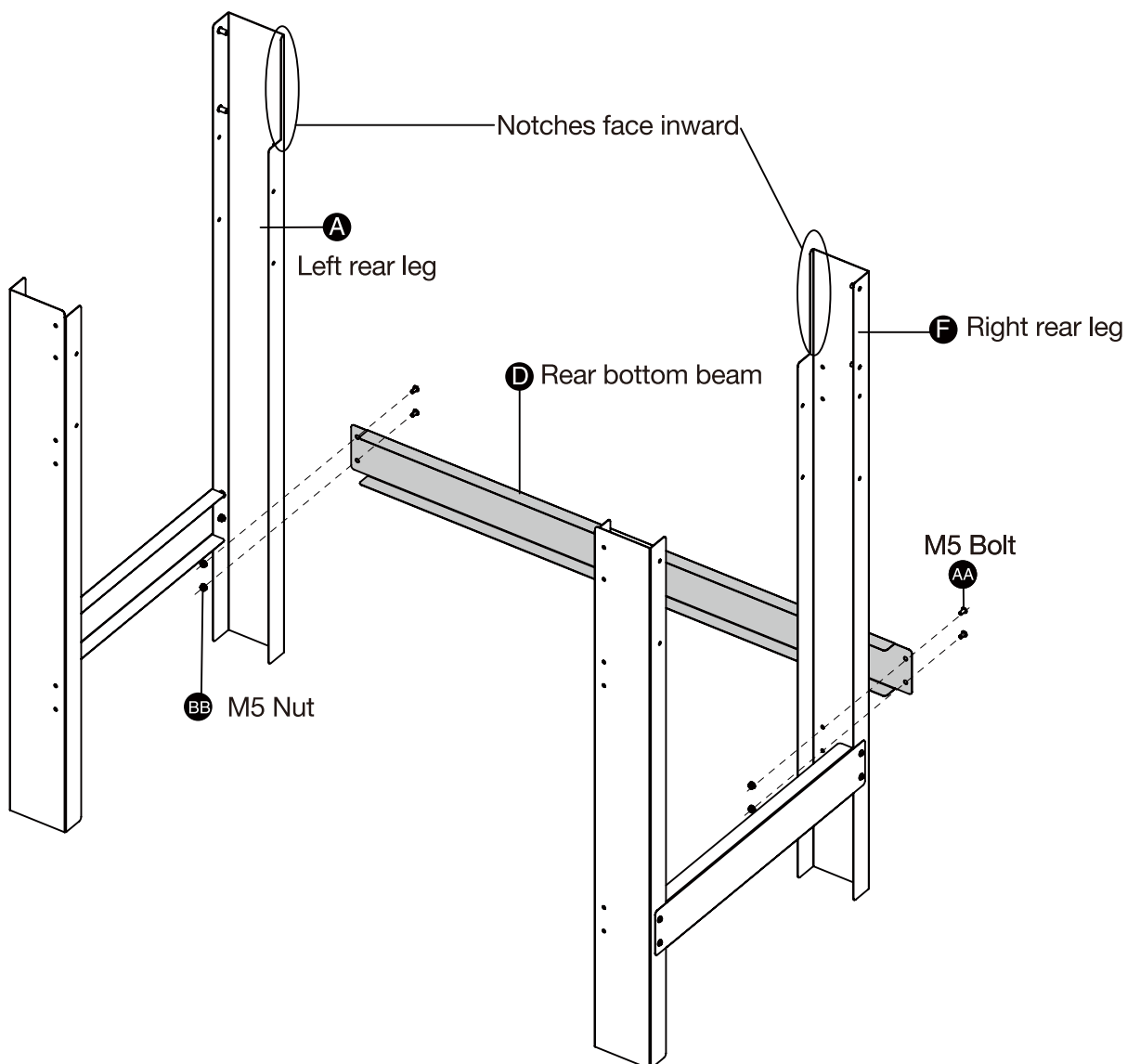

STEP 2: INSTALL THE REAR BOTTOM BEAM

Standing and attach the rear bottom beam (D) to the left rear leg (A) and right rear leg (F) and finger tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB). Do not tighten the bolt and nuts completely.

i NOTE:

Make sure the rear legs (A&F) with notch facing inward.

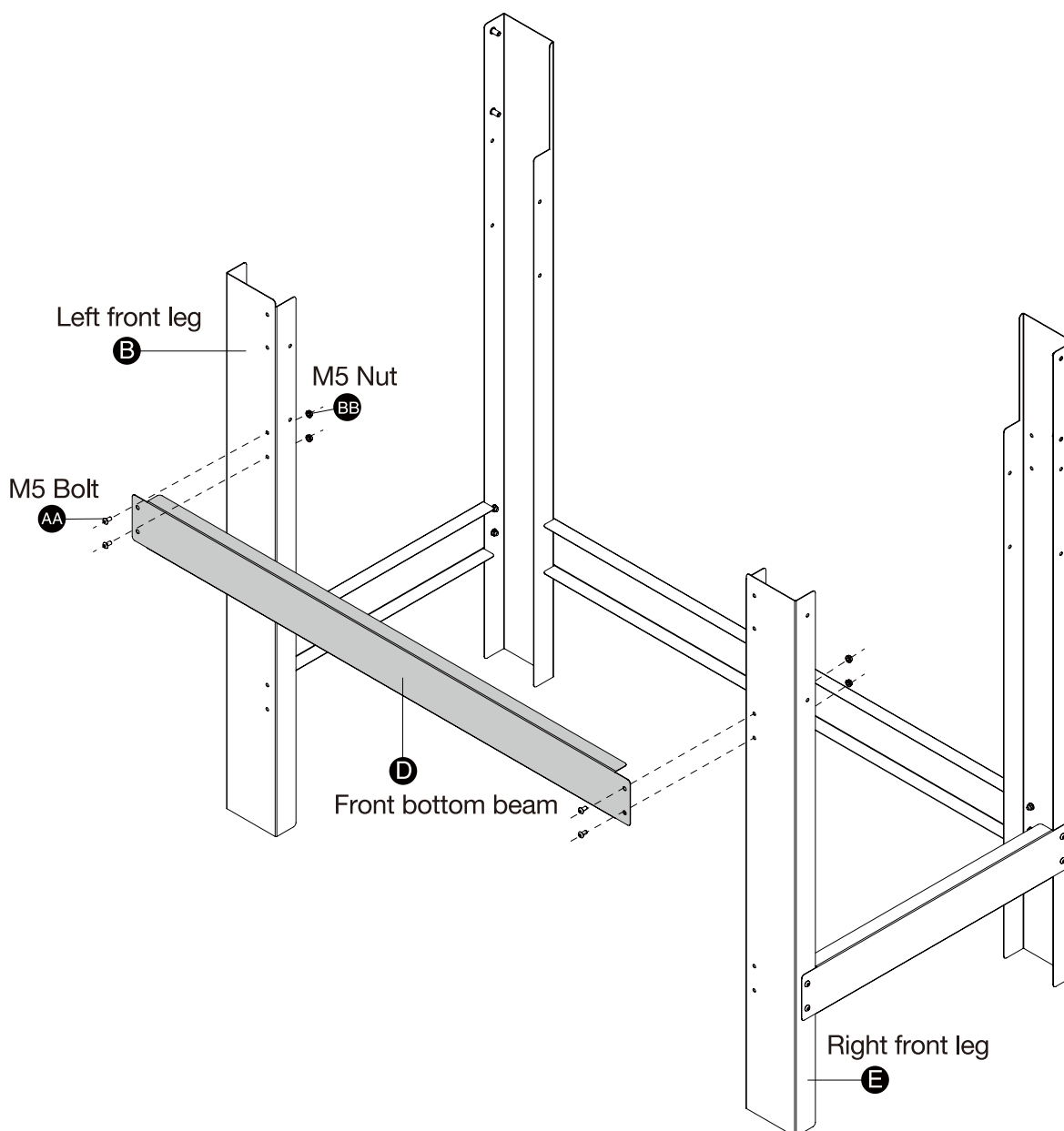
STEP 3: INSTALL THE FRONT BOTTOM BEAM

NOTE:

The rear bottom beam (D) can be attached **on the top or at the bottom of front legs (B&E)**. Attach it at your desired position as you need. Do not tighten all the bolt and nuts completely.

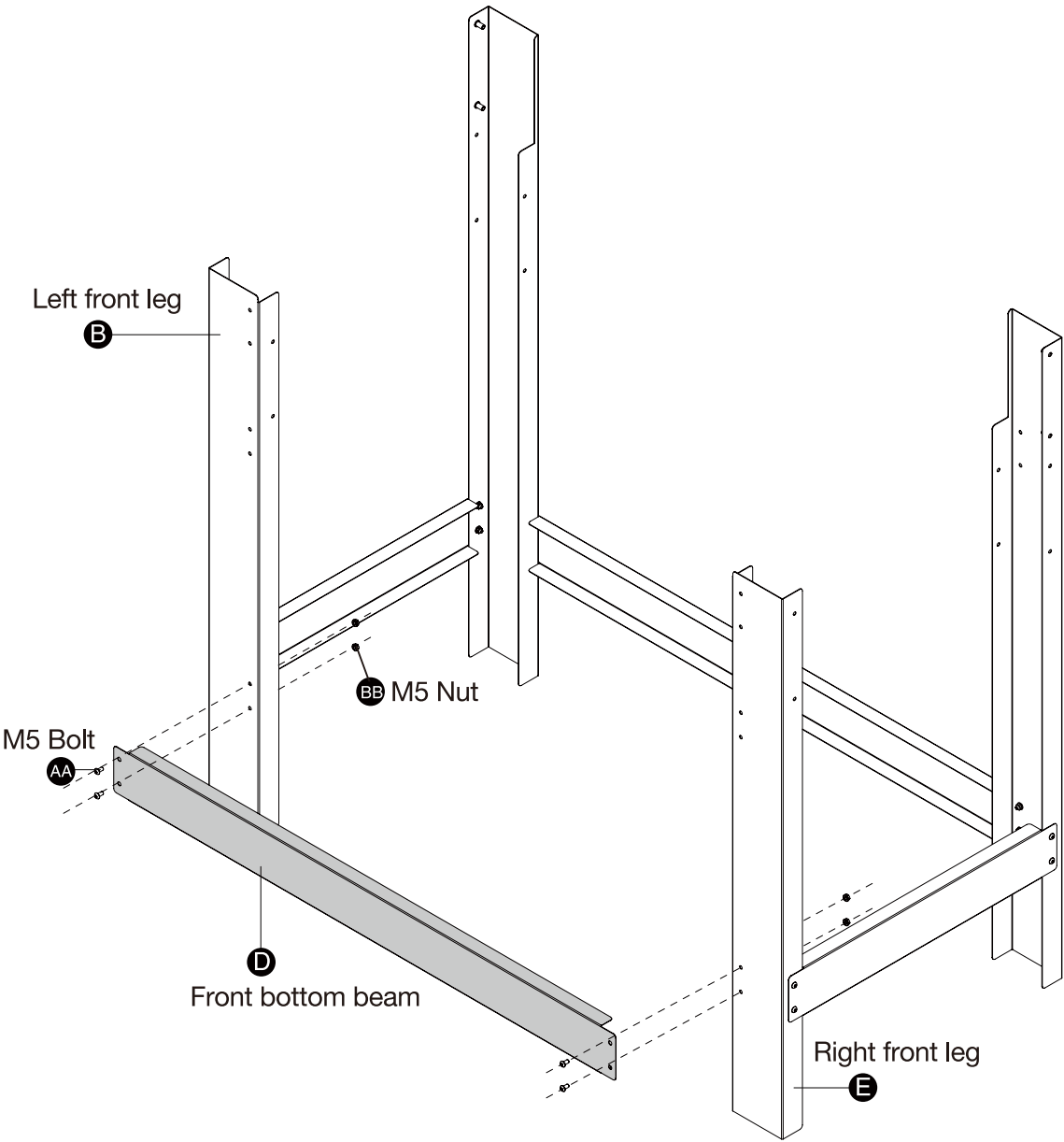
Attach the front bottom beam (D) to the left front leg (B) and right front leg (E) and finger tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB). Do not tighten the bolt and nuts completely.

Option 1: Attach the Front Bottom Beam (D) on the Top of Front Legs

Option 2: Attach the Front Bottom Beam (D) at the Bottom of Front Legs (B&E).

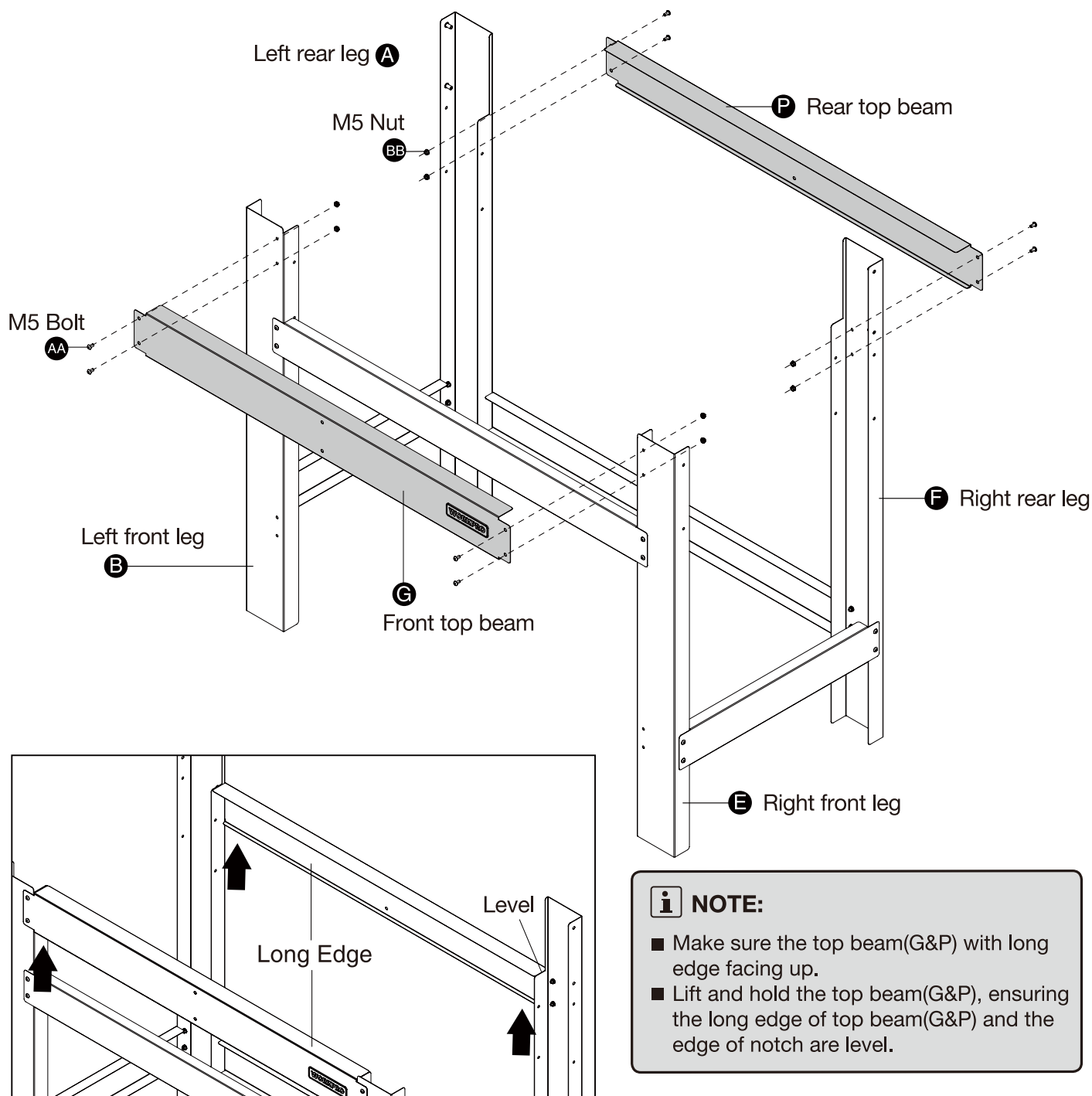

STEP 4: INSTALL THE FRONT TOP BEAM AND REAR TOP BEAM

- Attach the front top beam (G) to the left front leg (B) and right front Leg (E) and finger tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB). Make sure the front top beam (G) with long edge facing up. Do not tighten the bolt and nuts completely.
- Connect the rear top beam (P) to the left rear leg (A) and right rear leg (F) and finger tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB). Make sure the rear top beam (P) with long edge facing up. Do not tighten the bolt and nuts completely.

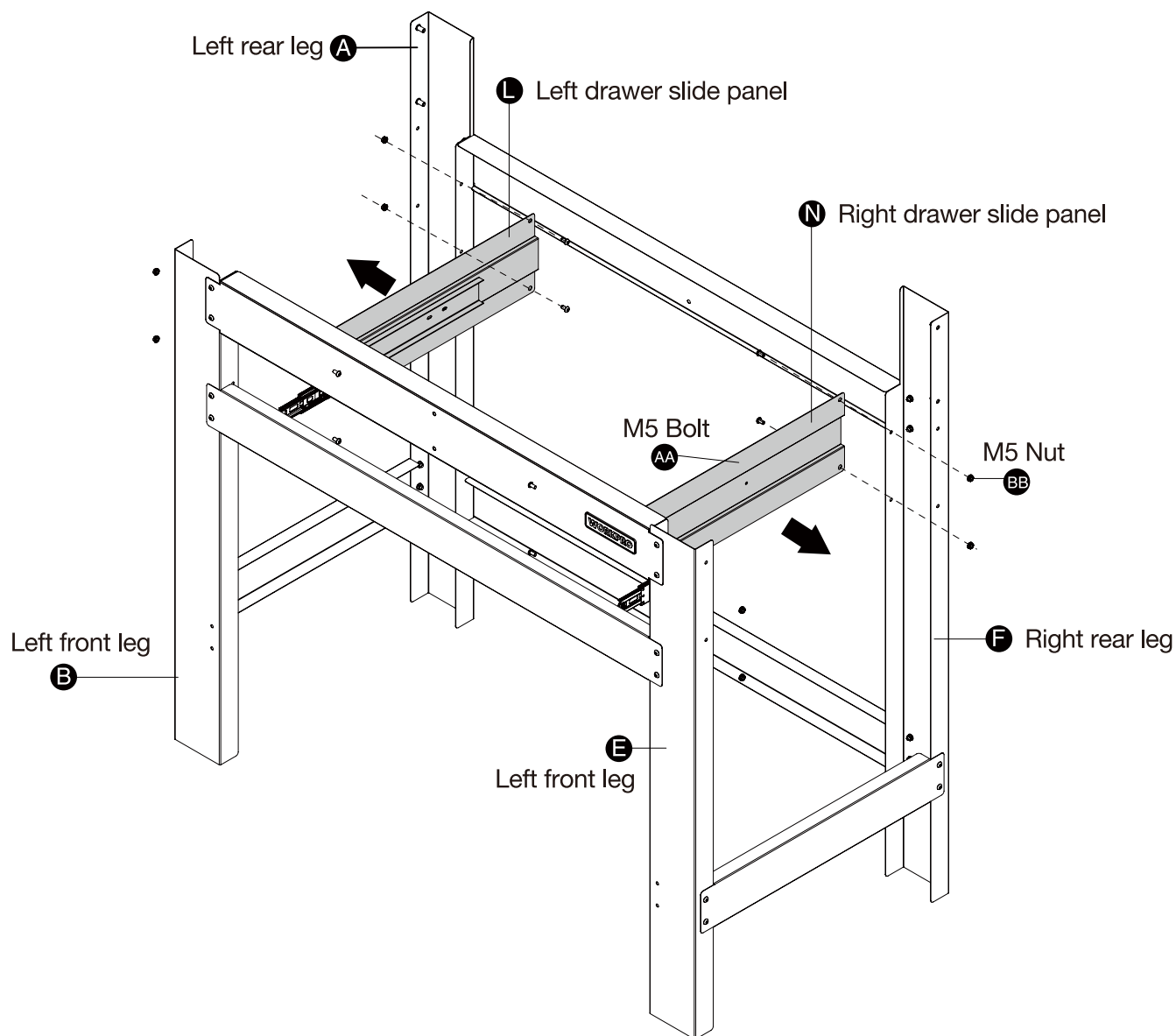

STEP 5: INSTALL THE DRAWER SLIDE PANEL

- Place the left drawer slide panel (L) between the top beam (G&P). Make sure the outer drawer slide on the left drawer slide panel (L) is pulled out facing forward.
- Align the left drawer slide panel (L) with the pre-drilled holes on the left legs (A&B), ensuring the slides are toward the front of the unit. Attach and finger tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB). Do not tighten the bolt and nuts completely.
- Repeat with the right drawer slide panel (N).

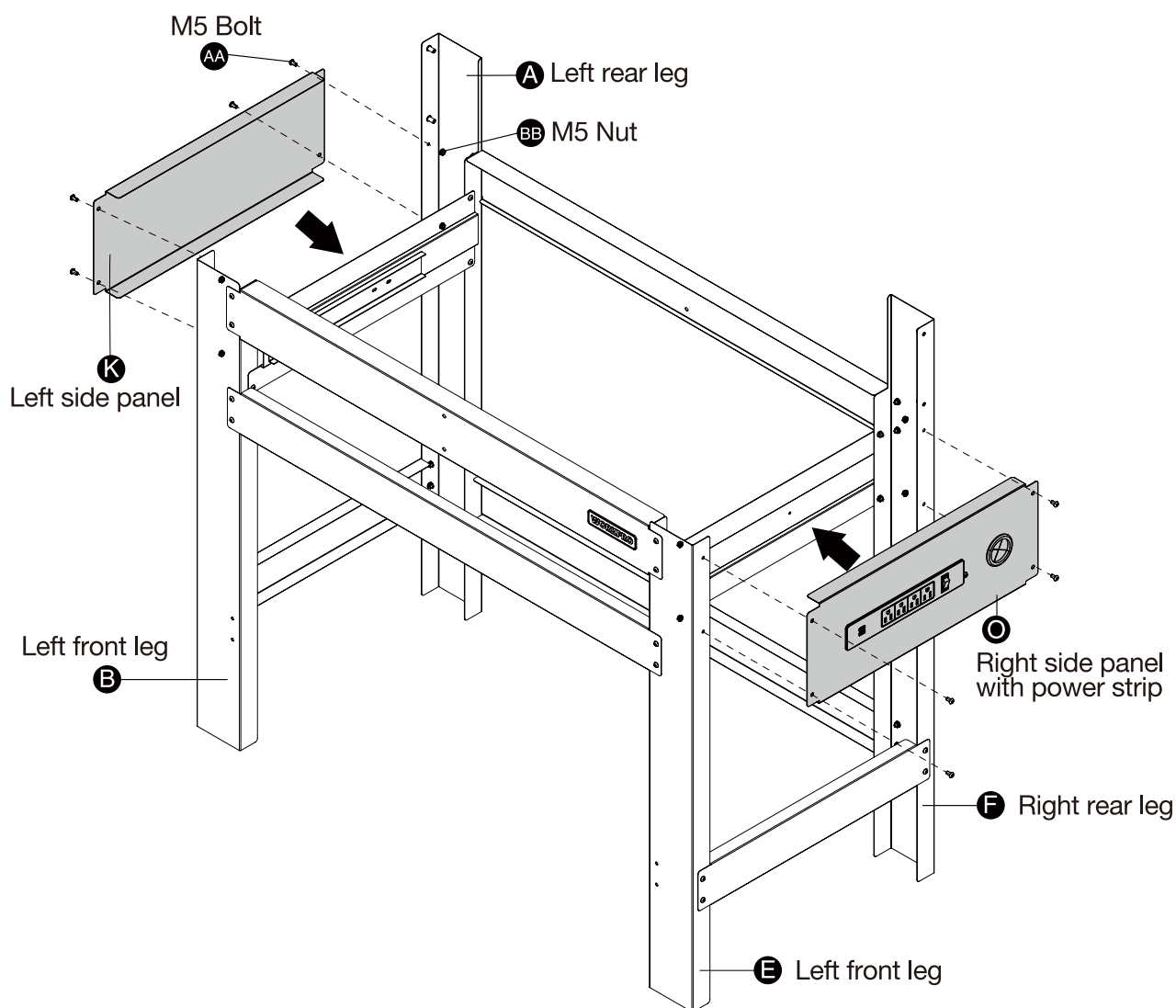

STEP 6: INSTALL THE LEFT AND RIGHT SLIDE PANEL

- Align the left side panel (K) with the pre-drilled holes on the left legs (A&B), attach and finger tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB). Do not tighten the bolt and nuts completely.
- Repeat with the right side panel with power strip (O).

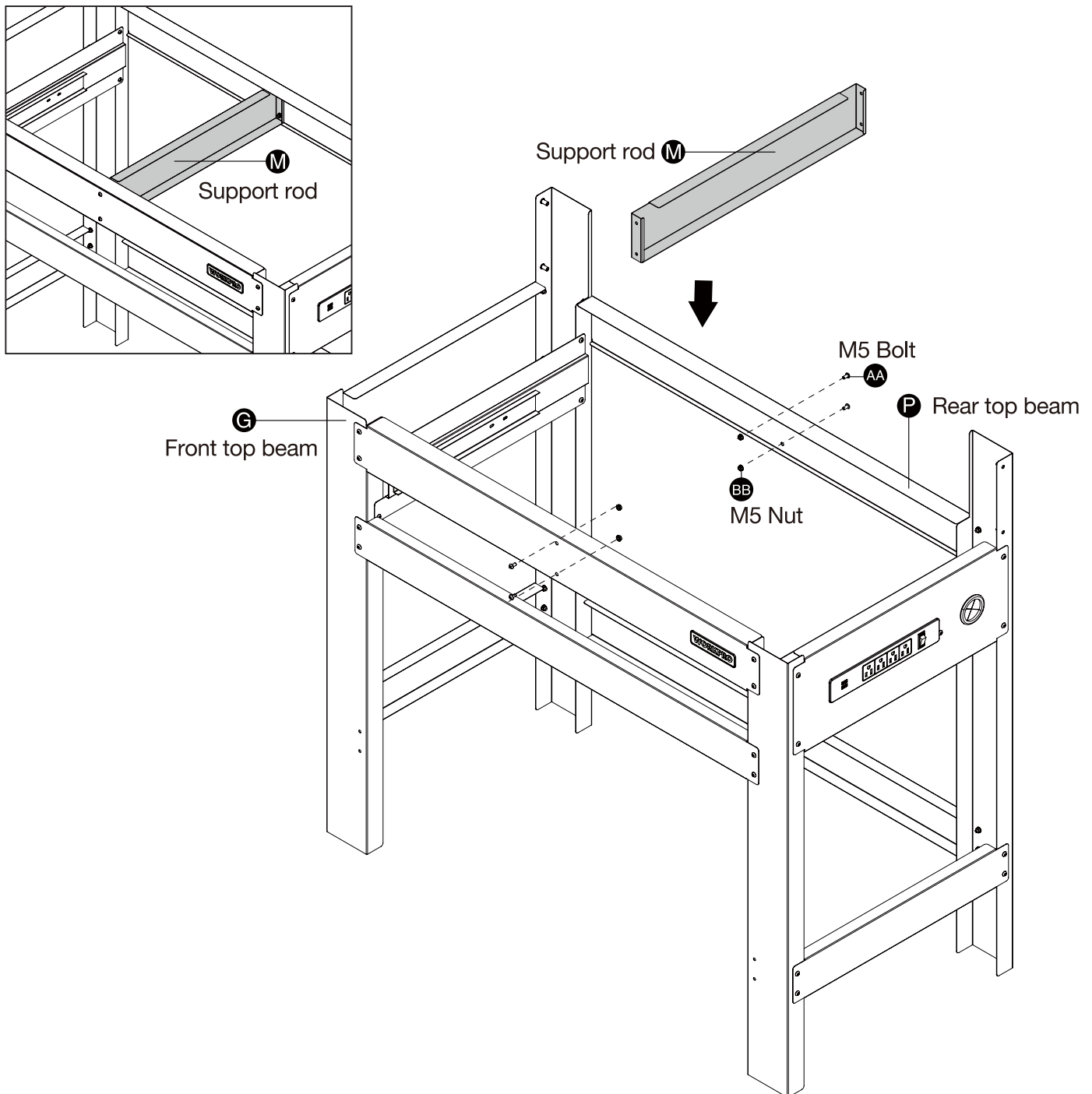

STEP 7: INSTALL THE SUPPORT ROD

- Slide the bolts (AA) through the front top beam (G) and into the support rod (M), nuts are then applied on the other end of hole. Attach and finger tighten to desired tightness using two M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB).
- Repeat above step as shown in the figure. Secure the support rod (M) to the rear top beam (P) using two M5 bolts (AA) and M5 nuts (BB).

NOTE:

Tighten all the bolts and nuts completely using a 5mm hex key.

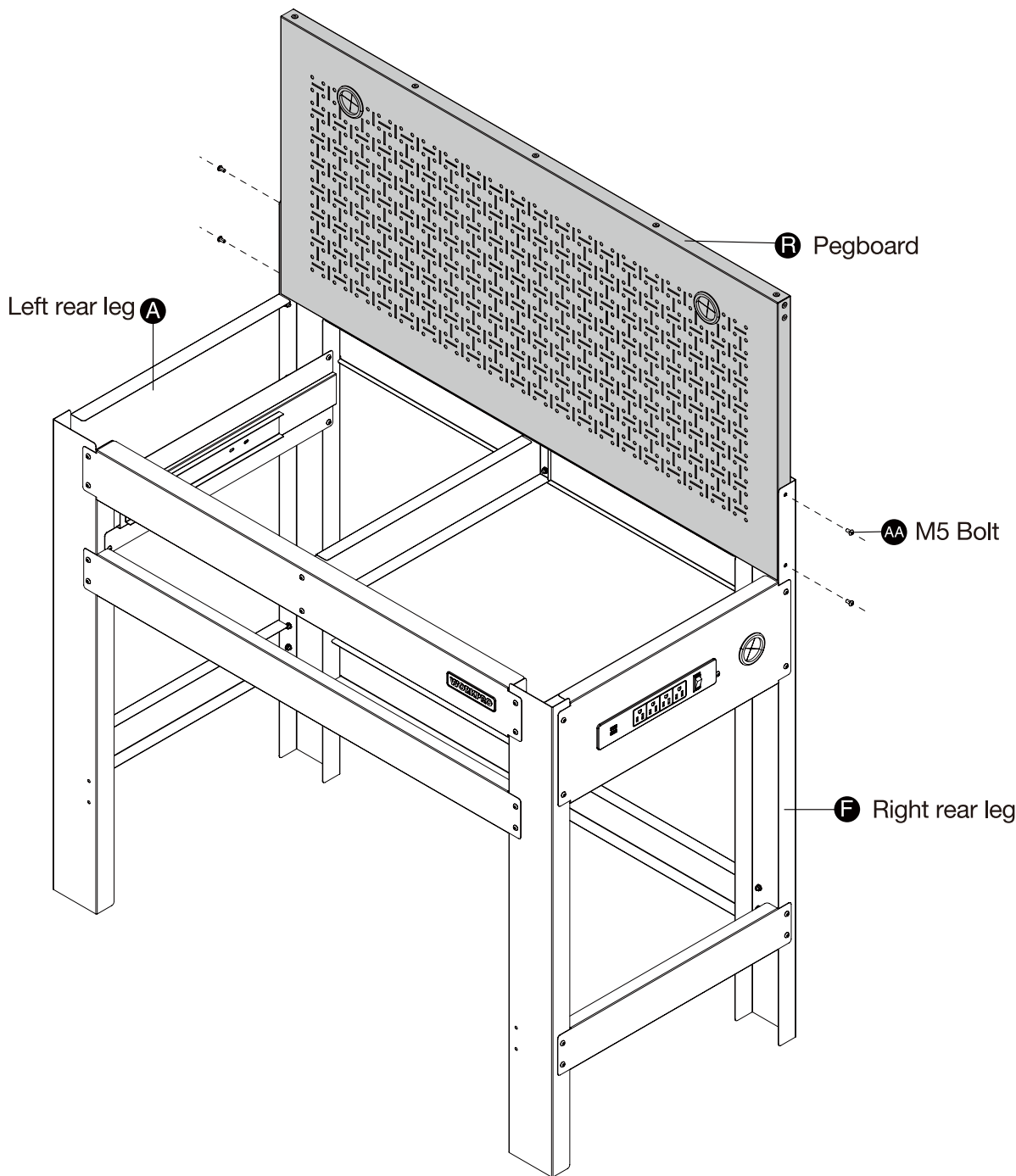

STEP 8: INSTALL THE PEGBOARD

Attach the pegboard (R) to the left rear leg (A) and the right rear leg (F) using bolts (AA), and tighten to desired tightness using four M5 bolts (AA) by a 5mm hex key.

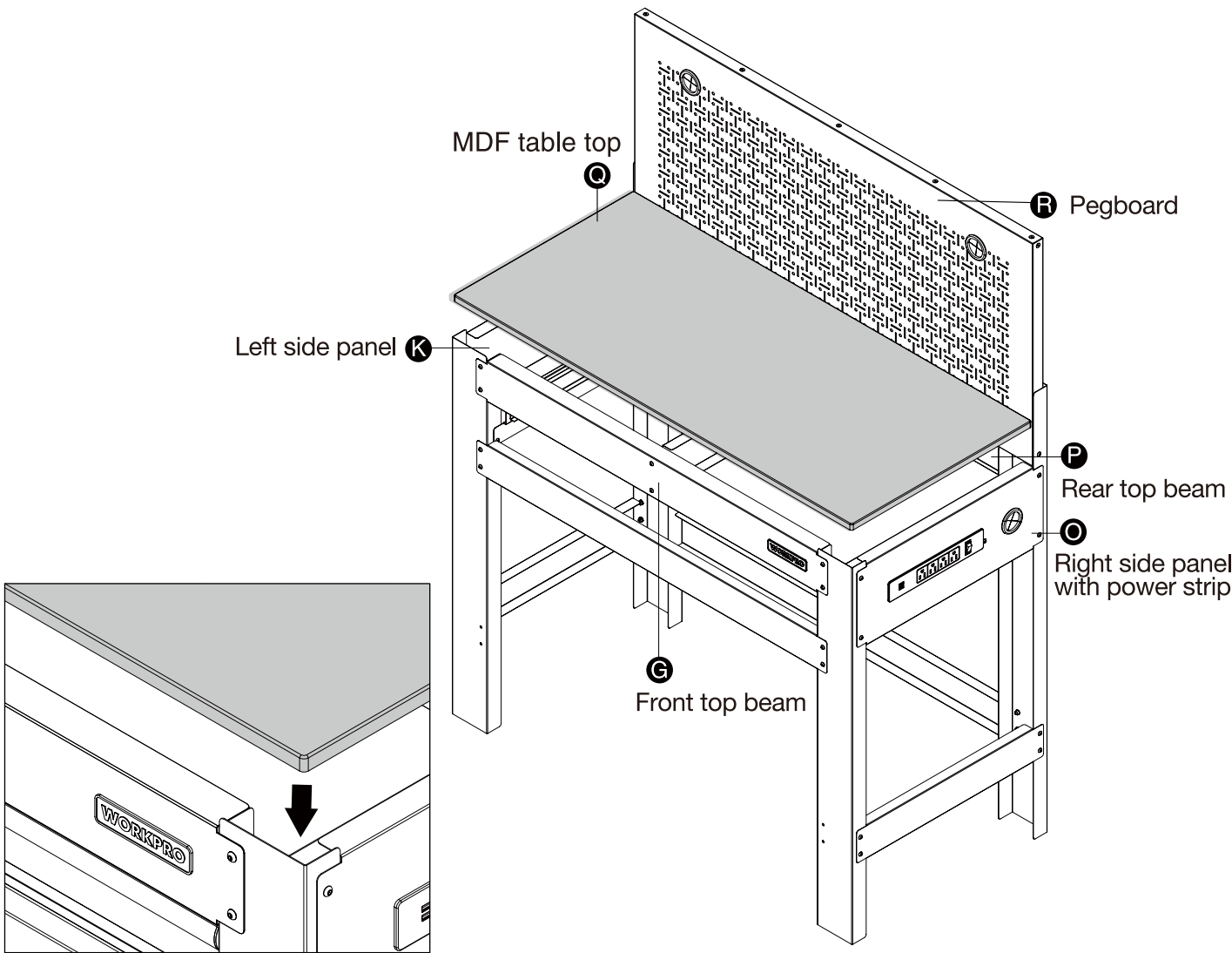

STEP 9: INSTALL THE MDF TABLE TOP

Place the MDF table top (Q) on the workbench.

NOTE:

If the table top is not level, loosen the bolts on the top beams (G&P) , side panel (K&O) and pegboard (R) again, lift and hold the top beam(G&P) and side panel (K&O), ensuring the frame is level, then tighten all the bolts (AA).



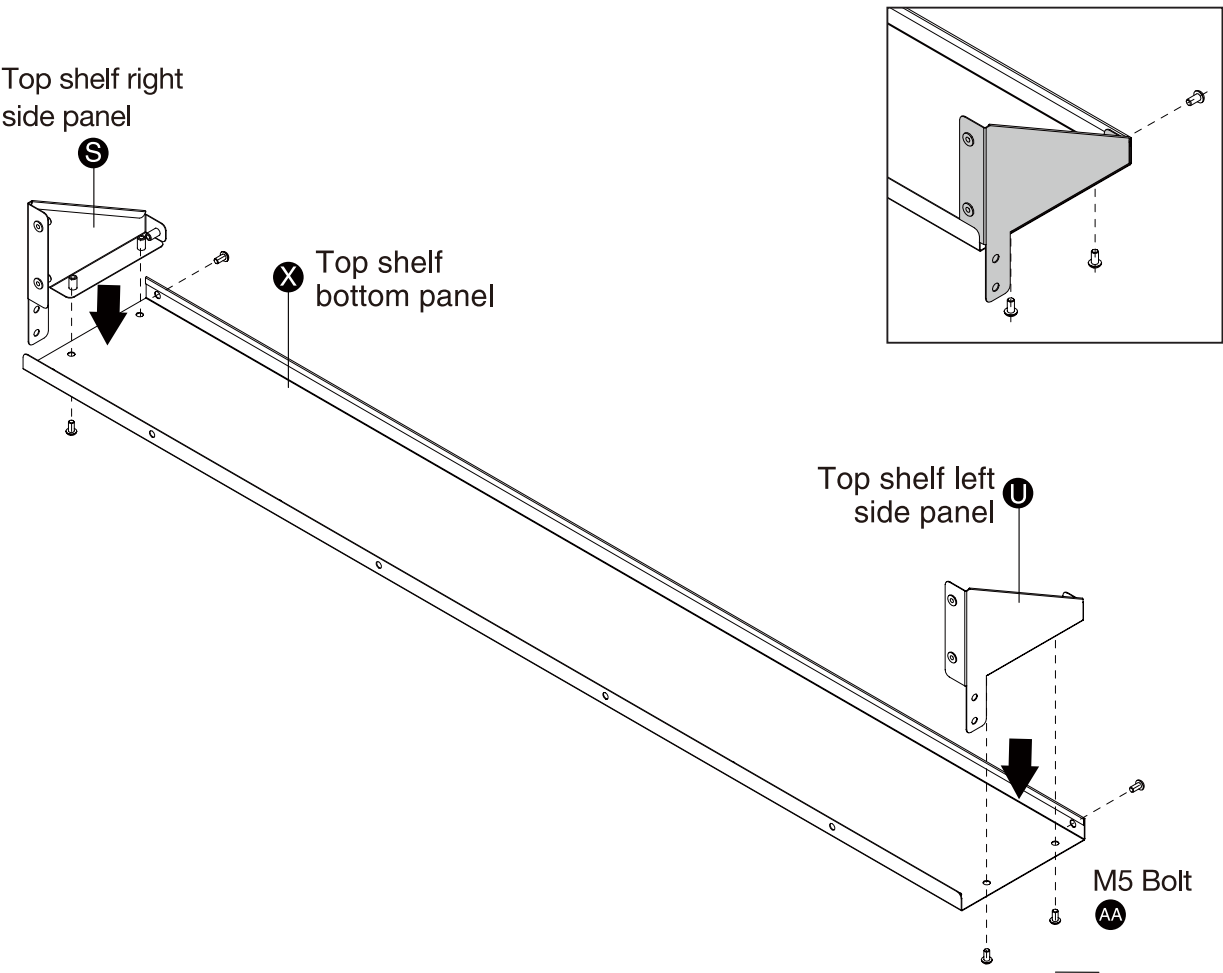

STEP 10: INSTALL THE TOP SHELF

Step 10.1: Assembly the Top Shelf Side Panel and Bottom Panel

Attach the top shelf side panel (U&S) on the corresponding position of the top shelf bottom panel (X) as shown, and tighten to desired tightness using six M5 bolts.

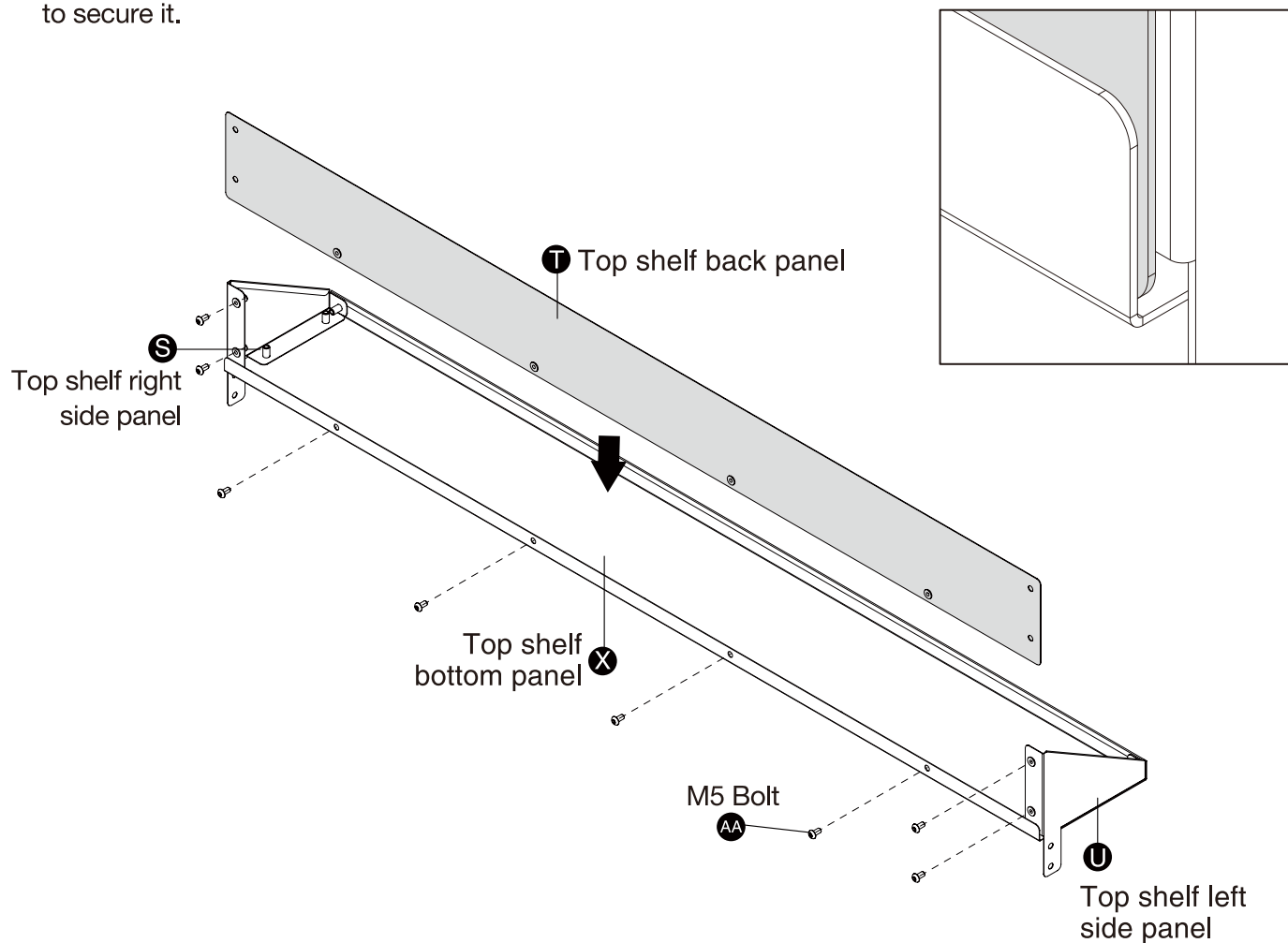

Step 10.2: Assembly the Top Shelf Back Panel

- Insert the top shelf back panel (T) into the groove between the side panel of the top shelf (S&U) and top shelf bottom panel (X).
- Slide the top shelf back panel (T) down until it meets the top shelf bottom panel (X). And use eight bolts (AA) to secure it.



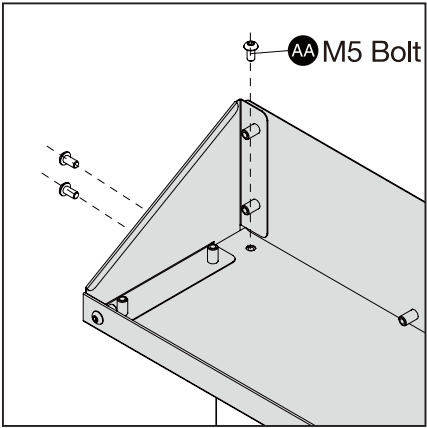
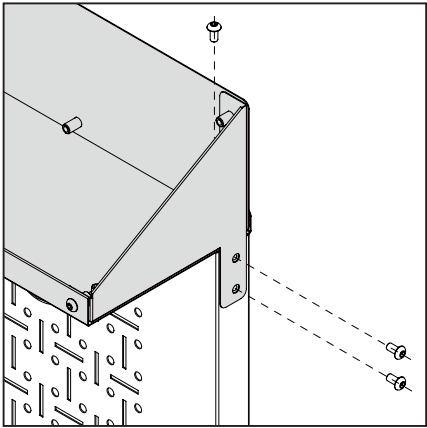
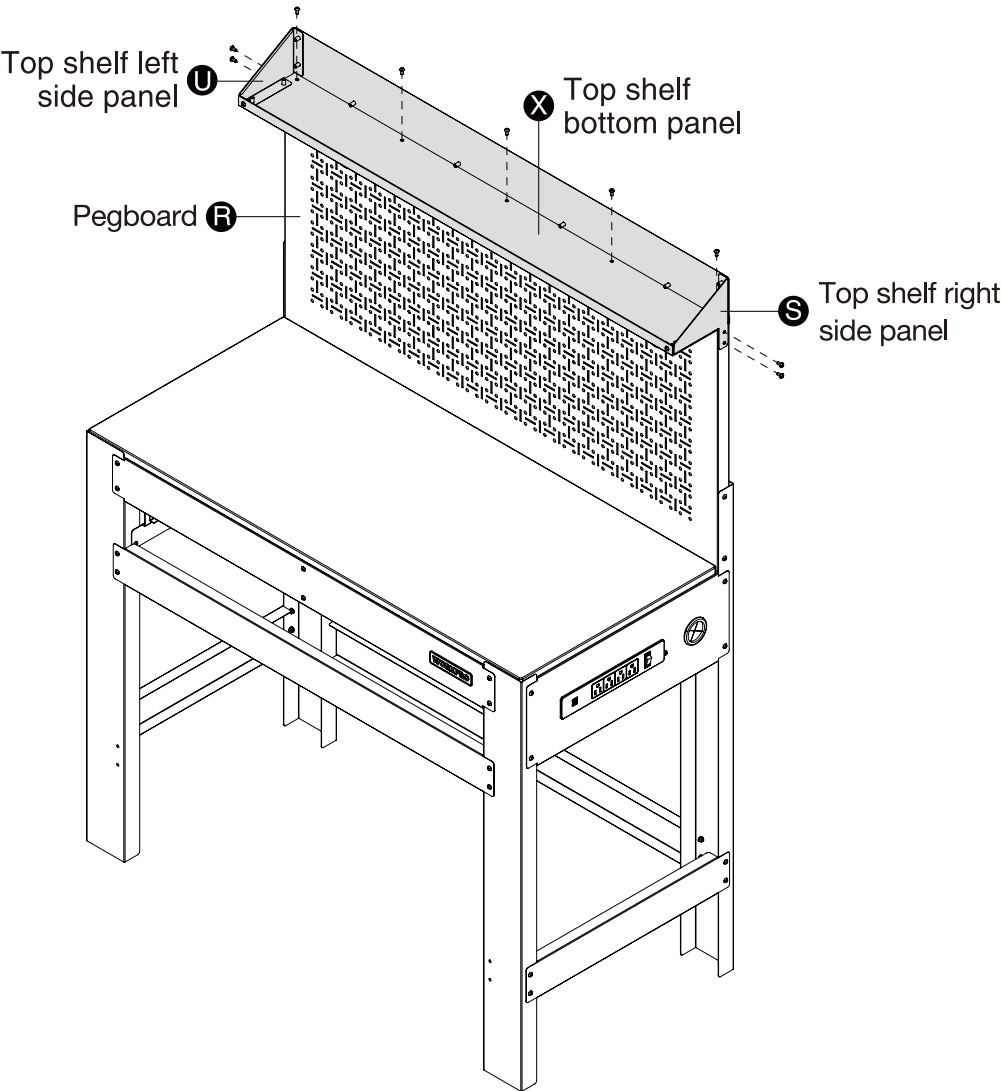

Step 10.3: Install the Top Shelf

Fix the assembled top shelf onto the pegboard (R) with nine M5 bolts (AA), as shown in the figure.

 **NOTE:**
Tighten all the bolts completely.



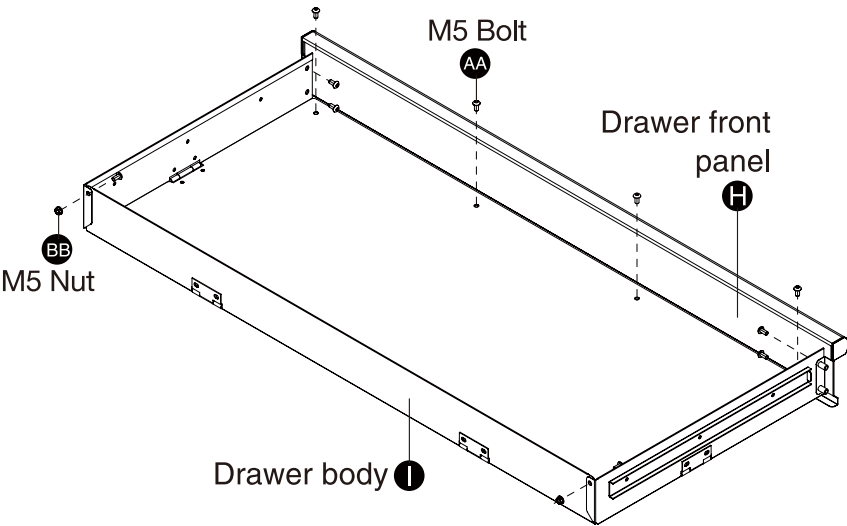
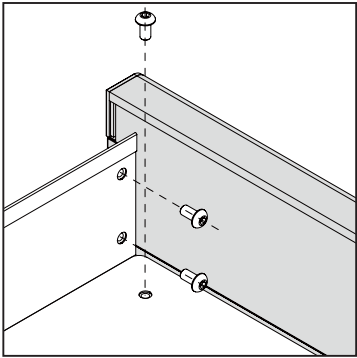
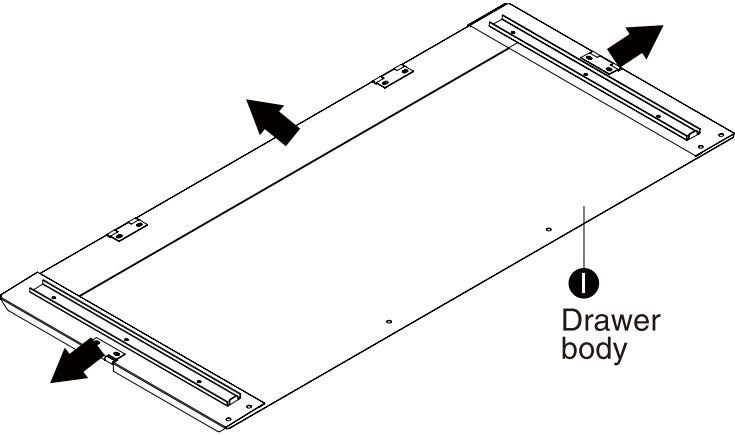

STEP 11: INSTALL THE DRAWER AND DRAWER MAT

Step 11.1: Assembly the Drawer

- Lay the drawer body (I) on a flat surface.
- Fold up sides of the drawer, then fold up the back side.
- Connect and secure the side panel and back panel of the drawer body (I) using two bolts (AA) and nuts (BB); and then using eight bolts (AA) to connect the drawer front panel (H) to the front of the drawer body (I).

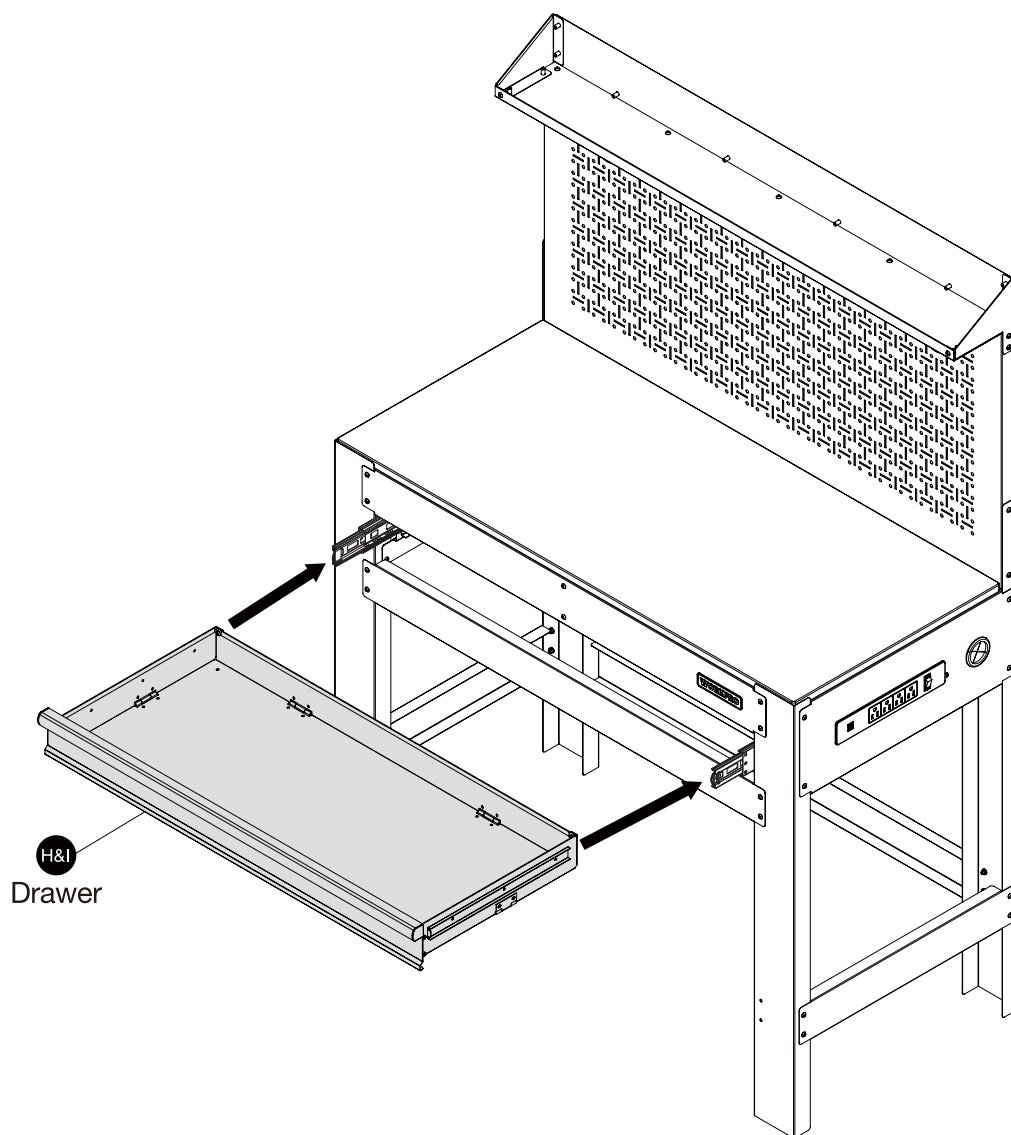

Step 11.2: Install the drawer

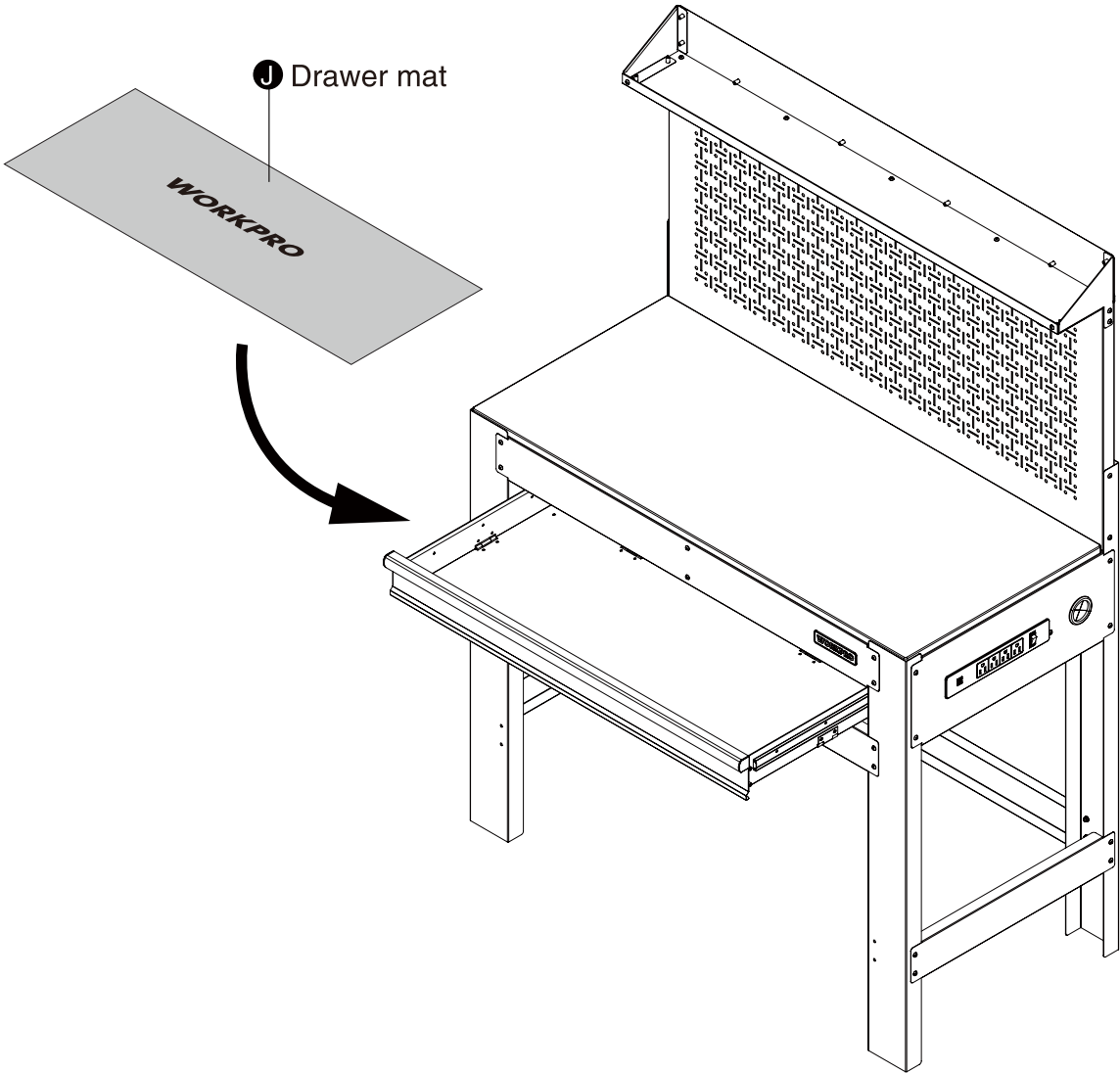
- Pull the outer drawer slides out until fully extended.
- Hold the outer drawer slide on the drawer slide panel while aligning them with inner drawer slides on the drawer.
- Slightly insert one side and repeat for the other side.
- Slowly push the drawer until it is fully closed to engage the slide.
- Open the drawer (H&I) and close it to verify proper operation.

Place the drawer mat (J) on the drawer as you need.



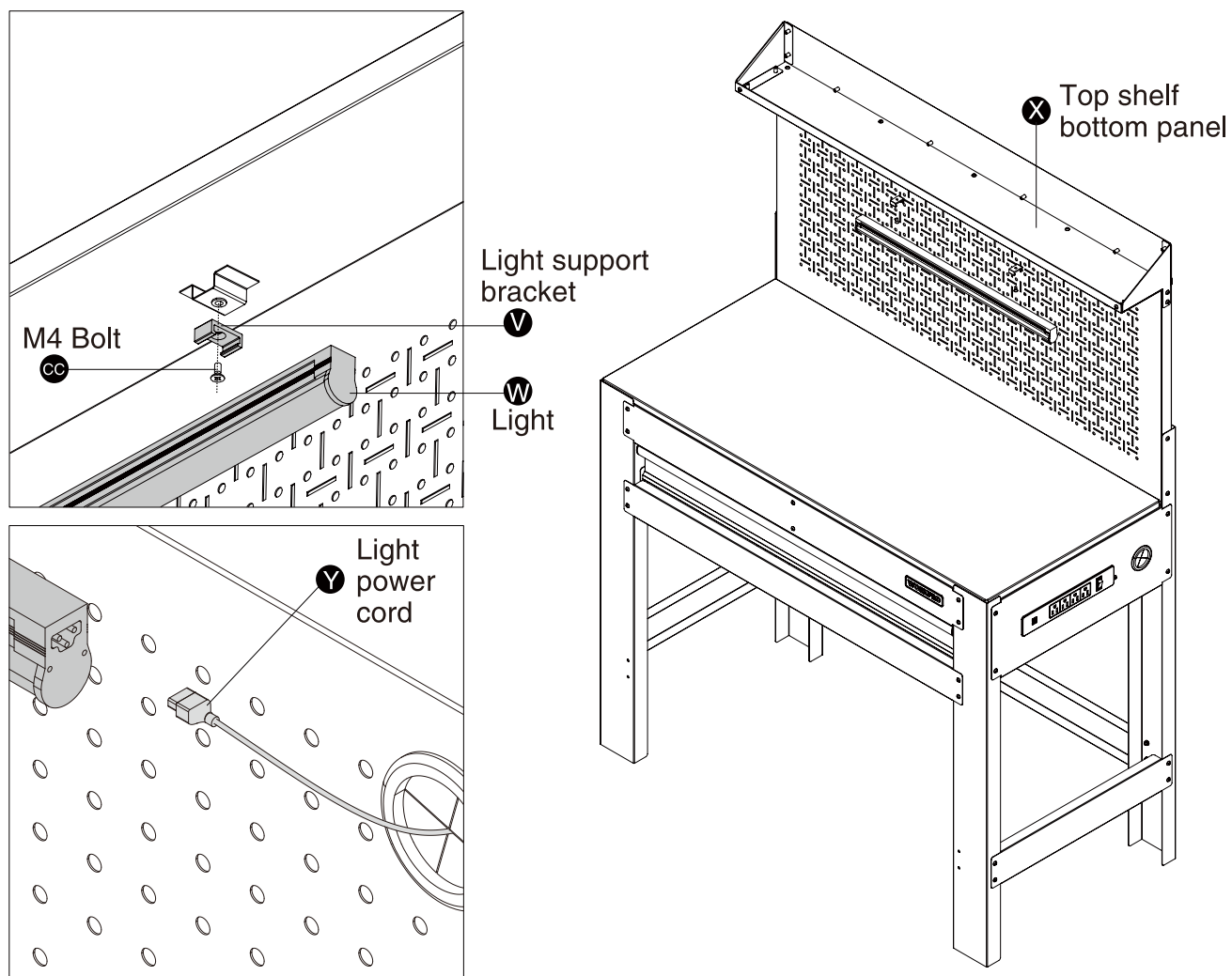

STEP 12: INSTALL THE LIGHT SUPPORT BRACKET AND LIGHT

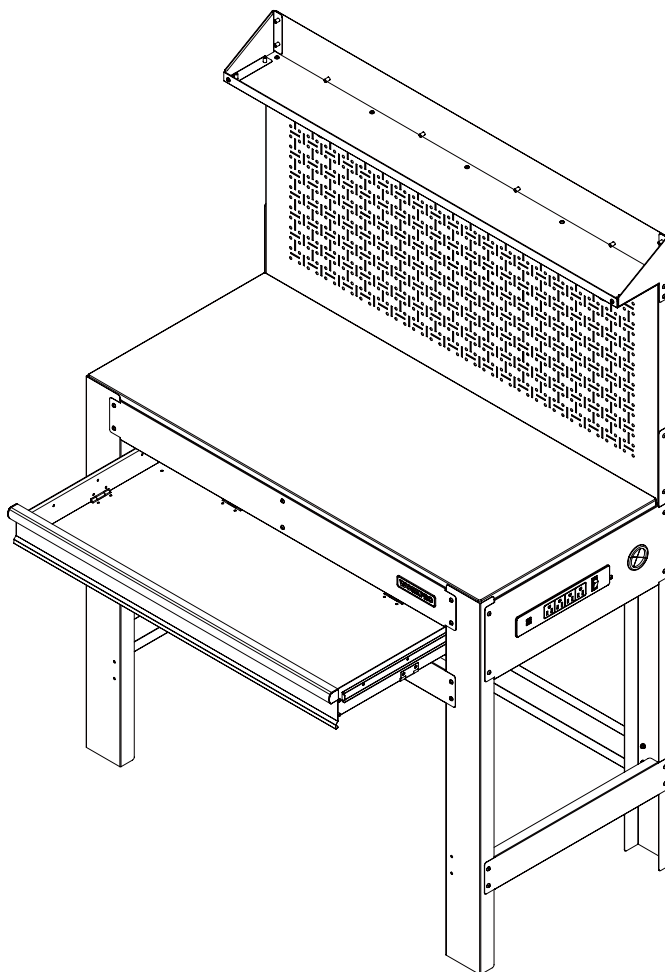
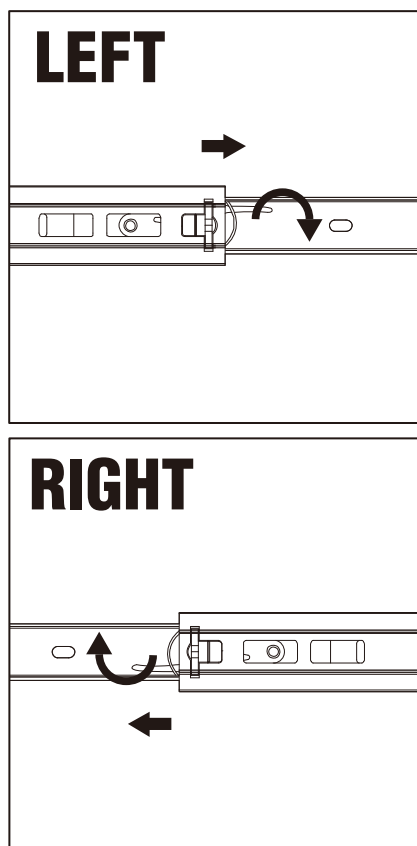
- Attach the light support brackets (V) to the bottom of the top shelf bottom panel (X) using two bolts (CC) packaged with the light support bracket (V) using a PH2 screwdriver (not included).
- Slide the Light (W) into the light support brackets (V).
- Feed the light power cord (Y) through the grommet in the pegboard (R). Plug the light power cord (Y) into the Light (W).

REMOVING THE DRAWER

- Fully extend and empty the drawer.
- Push up the one release lever while pulling down on the other release lever.
- Pull the drawer outward until it is released from the drawer slide.



REMOVING THE DRAWER

- Clean the metal parts using a mild liquid soap, rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly. Do not clean with abrasive detergents.
- Clean off water or other liquids spilled or splashed on the workbench immediately and dry the unit thoroughly.
- Keep your workbench covered to protect it from dust and moisture that could potentially damage the unit.
- Drawer maintenance: Lubricate the slides semi-annually with high-quality bearing grease.
