1. Connect the Microphone

- Plug the XLR end of the included cable into the bottom of the microphone.
- Connect the 1/4" plug into your mixer, amplifier, or audio interface.

2. Using the Microphone

- Slide the ON/OFF switch to the "ON" position.
- Hold the mic 2 to 6 inches from your mouth and speak directly into the grill.
- Avoid cupping the grill, which can distort sound pickup.

3. Adjust Sound Settings

- Use your connected audio system to fine-tune the volume, bass, treble, and gain for the best sound.
- Always test levels before a performance or recording session.

Cleaning, Maintenance & Storage

Cleaning:

- Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth or lightly damp cloth if necessary.
- Use a soft brush to clean dust or debris from the mesh grill.
- Avoid getting moisture inside the microphone.

Maintenance:

- Inspect cables and connectors for wear or corrosion.
- Store the microphone in a dry, padded case or pouch.
- Avoid dropping or striking the mic, which may damage internal parts.

Storage:

- Coil the cable loosely to avoid bends or breaks.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and humidity.
- Keep the mic in a protective case or foam compartment if transporting.

Safety Tips

- Always turn the mic OFF when not in use to extend its lifespan.
- Keep the cable away from walkways to prevent tripping.
- Don't expose the mic to rain or submerge it in water.
