

1. Overview

The ZENY Large Exercise Equipment Mat is a protective floor covering designed for home gym equipment. Its primary functions are to protect floor surfaces from damage, reduce noise and vibration, and provide a stable, non-slip base for exercise machines.

3. Features and Components

The mat incorporates several design features for its intended use.



3.1. Physical Construction

- **High-Density PVC:** The 6mm thick material provides a durable barrier.
- **Textured Surface:** Both sides of the mat feature a textured pattern. This design enhances grip between the mat and the floor, and between the mat and equipment.
- **Rectangular Profile:** The 8ft by 3ft size is intended to accommodate the footprint of most large exercise equipment.

3.2. Functional Features

- **Floor Protection:** The mat is designed to act as a buffer, protecting hardwood, laminate, tile, and carpeted floors from scratches, dents, and indentations caused by heavy equipment.
- **Shock Absorption & Noise Reduction:** The PVC material absorbs vibrations from equipment operation, helping to reduce noise transmission to floors below.
- **Non-Slip Base:** The textured bottom surface helps prevent the mat from sliding on smooth floors during use.
- **Equipment Stability:** The textured top surface helps prevent exercise equipment from shifting or sliding during workouts.
- **Waterproof & Easy to Clean:** The PVC material resists moisture, sweat, and oil. It can be wiped clean with a damp cloth and mild soap.
- **Flexible for Storage:** The mat can be rolled up for compact storage when not in use.

4. Intended Use & Compatibility

This mat is designed to be placed under stationary exercise equipment on residential floor surfaces.



4.1. Compatible Equipment

- Treadmills
- Exercise Bikes / Spin Bikes
- Elliptical Trainers
- Rowing Machines
- Weight Benches
- Multi-Gym Stations
- Other heavy fitness equipment

4.2. Compatible Floor Types

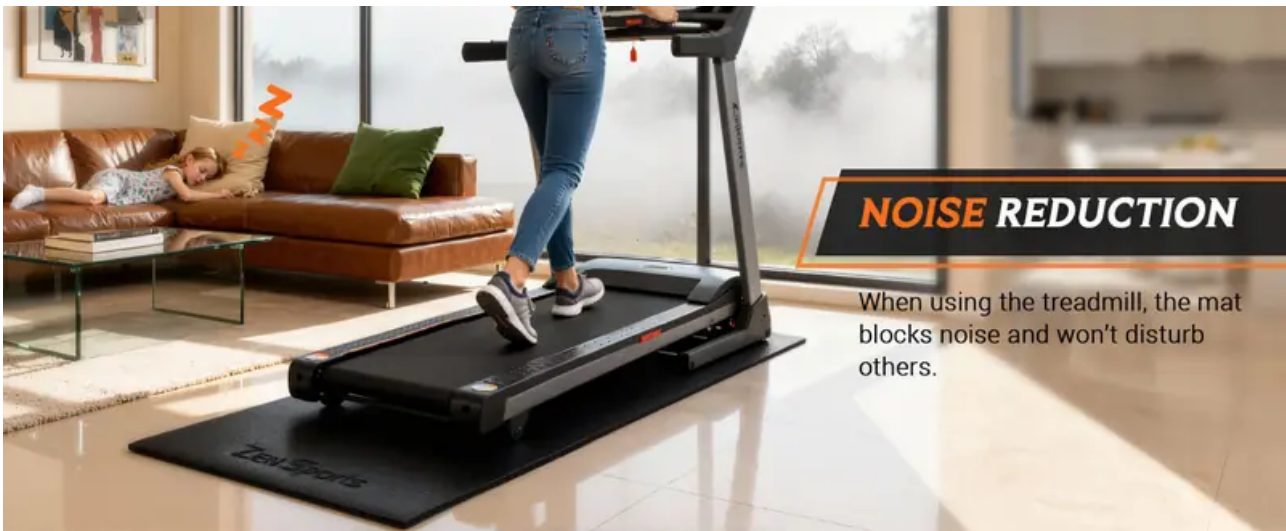
- Hardwood
- Laminate
- Vinyl / Linoleum
- Tile
- Carpet (Low-pile is recommended)

Note: The mat is 6mm thick. On very soft, high-pile carpet, the mat may compress and not provide a perfectly firm base. Ensure your equipment remains stable.

5. Use Guide

5.1. Initial Setup and Placement

1. **Unroll the Mat:** Unroll the mat completely on a flat, clean section of your floor. Allow it to lie flat for several hours if it has been tightly rolled for shipping, as this will help remove any curling at the edges.
2. **Position the Mat:** Place the mat in your desired workout area. Ensure the textured side is facing up. The mat can be used with either side down, but the textured pattern on both sides provides grip.
3. **Align Equipment:** Carefully position your exercise equipment onto the center of the mat. For larger equipment like treadmills, ensure all feet or supports are within the mat's boundaries.
4. **Check for Stability:** Gently test your equipment for stability. The mat's non-slip surface should prevent shifting. If the equipment or mat slides, ensure the floor surface is clean and dry.



5.2. During Use

- Use your exercise equipment as you normally would.
- The mat will dampen vibrations and sound. Some noise reduction may be noticeable, particularly on hard floors.
- If any liquid (sweat, water) is spilled on the mat, wipe it up promptly to maintain the non-slip properties of the surface.

5.3. Cleaning and Maintenance

1. **Regular Cleaning:** Wipe the surface with a damp cloth or sponge. For deeper cleaning, use a mild soap or detergent mixed with water.
2. **Drying:** Dry the mat with a clean towel or allow it to air dry completely before rolling for storage or placing equipment back on it.
3. **Avoid:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals (like bleach or ammonia) as they may damage the PVC surface.

5.4. Storage

1. Ensure the mat is clean and completely dry.
2. Starting from one of the shorter (38-inch) ends, roll the mat tightly.
3. Secure the rolled mat with a strap or cord, if desired, to keep it compact.
4. Store the rolled mat in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight or extreme heat sources.

6. Safety Information

Important Safety Instructions:

- This mat is a floor protector and stability aid, not a safety device. Always follow the safety instructions provided with your exercise equipment.
- Ensure the mat lies flat with no curled edges or wrinkles that could create a tripping hazard.
- Do not use the mat on uneven or severely sloped surfaces.
- Inspect the mat periodically for signs of excessive wear, tears, or damage. Discontinue use if the mat is damaged.
- This product is not a toy. Keep away from children and pets to prevent a suffocation hazard when the mat is rolled or folded.
- The mat is not intended for use as a primary exercise surface for floor exercises (e.g., yoga, stretching).

7. Troubleshooting

Issue	Possible Cause & Solution
Mat slides on floor	Ensure the floor surface is clean, dry, and free of dust or polish. The textured underside provides grip on most surfaces, but extremely smooth floors may require extra care.
Equipment slides on mat	Ensure the mat surface is clean and dry. The textured top surface is designed to grip equipment feet. Check that your equipment's feet are clean and dry.
Mat will not lie flat	If the mat has been rolled for shipping, unroll it and let it sit flat, weighted down if necessary, for 24 hours to allow it to relax.
Strong odor from mat	A mild PVC odor is possible when new. Unroll the mat in a well-ventilated area for a few days before use. The odor should dissipate.
Mat seems too thin	The mat is 6mm (0.24") thick, designed for protection and noise reduction, not for significant cushioning. For high-impact activities, a thicker exercise mat is required.
