

1. Overview

The Conambo JBT900 is a single-ear Bluetooth headset designed for hands-free communication. It features Bluetooth 5.0, noise cancellation, and a mute function, suitable for use with cell phones, computers, and in office or driving environments.



Key characteristics include an on-ear form factor, a rotatable microphone boom, and an adjustable headband.

2. Features

2.1 Bluetooth Connectivity

- **Bluetooth Version 5.0:** Provides a stable connection with lower power consumption.

- **Multi-Device Connection:** Can be connected to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously and switch between them.
- **Wireless Range:** Up to 33 feet (10 meters).



2.2 Audio & Microphone

- **Noise Cancellation:** Uses active noise cancellation technology to reduce background noise for clearer calls.
- **270° Rotatable Microphone:** The microphone boom can be rotated for optimal positioning and can be worn on either ear.
- **Mute Function:** A dedicated button allows you to mute the microphone during calls.

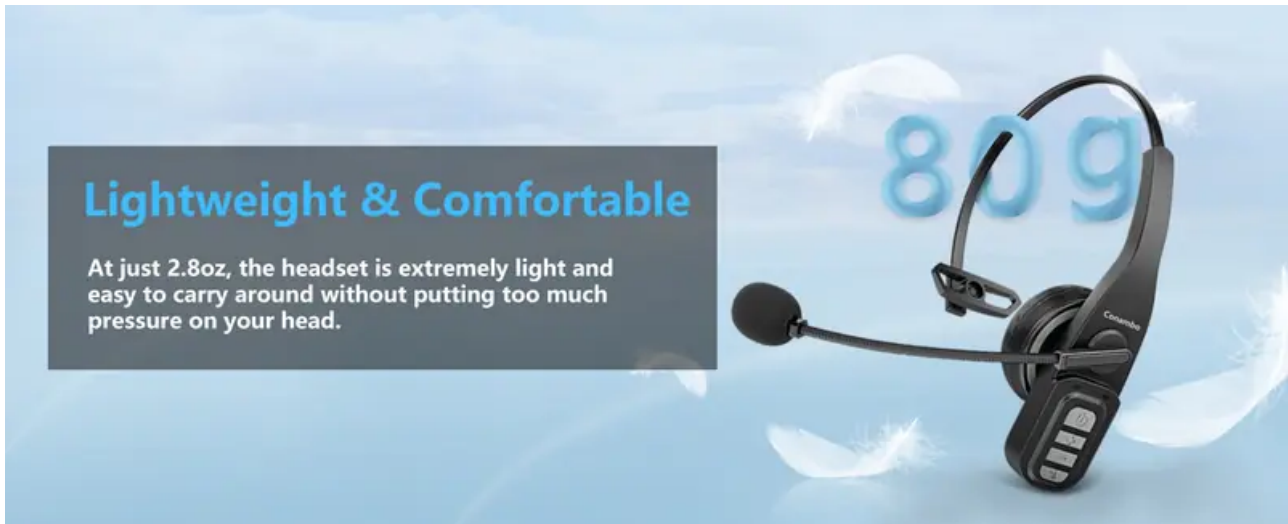
2.3 Battery

- **Talk Time:** Up to 22 hours on a single charge.
- **Standby Time:** Up to 240 hours.
- **Charging Time:** Approximately 4 hours to full charge.

- **Charging Port:** Standard micro-USB.

2.4 Design & Comfort

- **Adjustable Headband:** A stretchable headband allows for a custom fit.
- **Ear Cushion:** Soft protein memory-foam padding for comfort during extended wear.
- **Single-Ear Design:** On-ear form factor allows for ambient awareness.



3. Use Guide

3.1 Parts Identification

The headset features four main control buttons, typically located on the outer housing of the earpiece:

- Power/Pairing button
- Volume Up button
- Volume Down button
- Mute/Multi-function button

The microphone is located at the end of the rotatable boom. The micro-USB charging port is located on the bottom or back of the earpiece.

3.2 Charging the Headset

1. Connect the provided micro-USB cable to the charging port on the headset.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port or wall adapter).
3. A red indicator light typically signifies charging. The light may turn off or change color when fully charged.

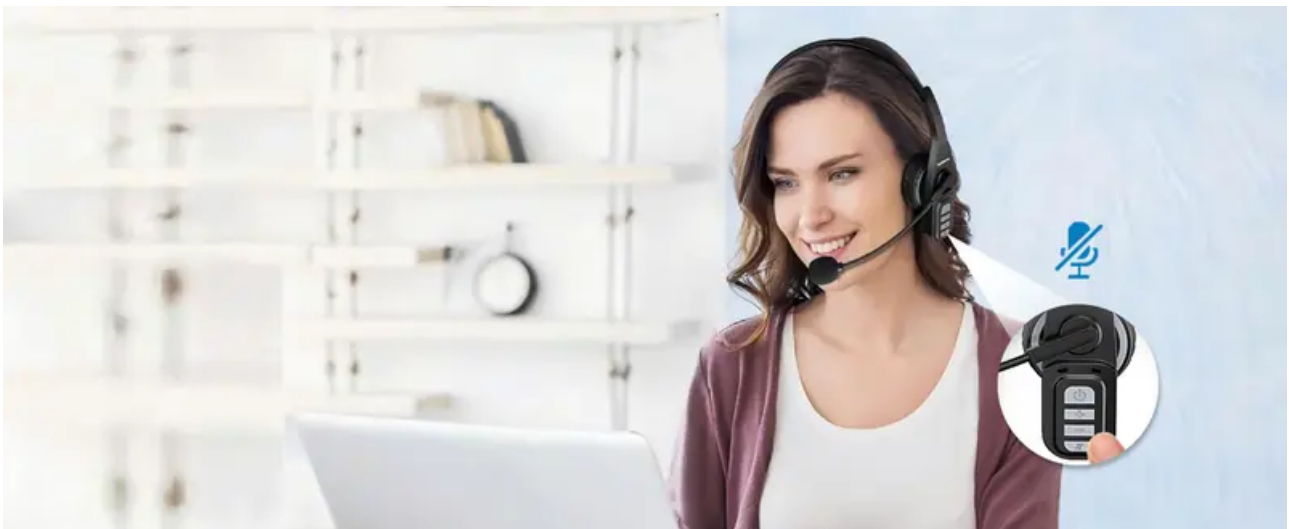
4. A full charge takes approximately 4 hours.

3.3 Powering On/Off & Pairing

1. **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until you see a blue indicator light and/or hear a power-on tone.
2. **To Enter Pairing Mode:** With the headset powered off, press and hold the Power button for about 5 seconds until the indicator light flashes blue and red rapidly. The headset is now discoverable by your Bluetooth device.
3. On your phone or computer, enable Bluetooth and select "Conambo JBT900" from the list of available devices.
4. If prompted, enter the passcode "0000".
5. **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until you hear a power-off tone and the indicator light turns off.

3.4 Basic Operations

- **Answer a Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **End/Reject a Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Mute/Unmute During a Call:** Press the dedicated Mute button.
- **Activate Voice Assistant (Siri/Google):** Press the Mute button when not on a call.
- **Adjust Volume:** Press the Volume Up (+) or Volume Down (-) buttons.
- **Redial Last Number:** Press the Multi-function button twice quickly when not on a call.

5. Care and Maintenance

- Clean the headset with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquids or abrasive cleaners.
- Store the headset in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- The headset is water-resistant but not waterproof. Avoid exposure to excessive moisture.
- To extend battery life, avoid completely draining the battery frequently. Charge the headset when the low battery warning is heard.

6. Troubleshooting

- **Headset won't power on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to power for at least 30 minutes and try again.
- **Cannot pair with device:** Ensure the headset is in pairing mode (rapid blue/red flashing). Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and it is within range. Delete "Conambo JBT900" from your device's Bluetooth paired list and try pairing again.
- **Poor audio quality or dropped calls:** Ensure you are within the 10-meter wireless range. Reduce interference from other wireless devices. Ensure the microphone boom is positioned close to your mouth.
- **Device not connecting automatically:** Ensure the headset is powered on and was the last connected device. Manually select the headset from your device's Bluetooth menu.
- **Short battery life:** The battery may degrade over time. Ensure you are using the correct charging cable and adapter. A full charge cycle takes approximately 4 hours.

7. Compliance and Safety

This device complies with relevant RF exposure standards. It is designed to be worn on the ear. Maintain a safe distance from other electronic devices to avoid interference.

Warning: For safety, do not use this headset while driving in situations that require your full attention. Always obey local traffic laws and regulations regarding the use of mobile devices.
