

Overview

This manual provides instructions for the CKIKH Handheld Steamer for Clothes. This device is a 2000W garment steamer designed for quick wrinkle removal.



Features and Specifications

Key Features

- **2000W Power:** Provides strong, penetrating steam for efficient wrinkle removal.
- **Fast Heat-up:** Heats up in approximately 9 seconds.
- **Handheld Design:** Portable and easy to maneuver.

Parts and Components

The steamer includes the main unit and an accessory kit. Refer to the product packaging for a complete list of included components.

Safety Information

- Read all instructions before using the steamer.
- Use the steamer only with the provided power adapter or a compatible one as specified.
- Do not use the steamer if it has been dropped, damaged, or is leaking.
- Always unplug the steamer before filling it with water or when not in use.
- Keep the steamer away from children.
- Do not direct steam at people, animals, or electrical equipment.
- The steamer emits hot steam. Avoid contact with the steam jet and the metal plate.
- Use on a stable, heat-resistant surface.

Use Guide

Initial Setup

1. Unpack the steamer and all components.
2. Ensure the power switch is in the OFF position and the unit is unplugged.
3. Fill the water tank with clean, preferably distilled, water. Do not overfill.
4. Securely close the water tank cap.

Operating Instructions

1. Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.
2. Turn the power switch to the ON (I) position. The indicator light should illuminate.
3. Wait approximately 9 seconds for the steamer to heat up. Steam will begin to emit from the nozzle.

4. Hold the steamer vertically, a short distance from the fabric.
5. Gently glide the steamer over the garment in downward strokes, applying light tension to the fabric with your other hand for best results.
6. For stubborn wrinkles, hold the steamer in place for a few seconds to allow the steam to penetrate.

After Use

1. Turn the power switch to the OFF (O) position.
2. Unplug the steamer from the electrical outlet.
3. Allow the steamer to cool completely before storing.
4. Empty any remaining water from the tank before long-term storage.

Fabric Guide

- **Recommended:** Cotton, linen, wool, silk, polyester, and most common garment fabrics.
- **Test First:** Always test the steamer on an inconspicuous area of delicate, synthetic, or specialty fabrics (like velvet or sequins) before general use.
- Do not use on leather, suede, or plastic materials.

Care and Maintenance

- Always unplug and let the steamer cool before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse in water.
- To prevent mineral buildup, use distilled water. If using tap water, descale periodically according to the frequency of your local water hardness.
- Check the nozzle for blockages and clean gently if necessary.
- Store the steamer in a cool, dry place.

Troubleshooting

- **No steam:** Ensure the unit is plugged in, switched on, and has had sufficient time to heat up. Check that the water tank is filled.
- **Weak steam:** The water tank may be empty or the nozzle could be partially blocked. Check and clean the nozzle.
- **Water dripping:** Do not overfill the water tank. Ensure the steamer is held in the correct vertical position during use.
- **Unit not turning on:** Check the power connection and outlet. Ensure the power switch is in the ON position.
