

Overview

The JONYJ Handheld Car Vacuum Cleaner is a portable, cordless cleaning device designed for use in cars, homes, and offices. It functions as both a vacuum for suctioning debris and an air duster for blowing. The unit is lightweight, features a built-in LED light, and includes multiple nozzles for various cleaning tasks.



Features

2-in-1 Suction and Blow Function

The vacuum cleaner operates in two modes:

- **Suction Mode:** For removing dust, pet hair, food scraps, and other debris from surfaces.
- **Blow Mode:** For inflating items like swimming rings or pumping air to compress bags for storage.

Power and Performance

- **Suction Power:** 16000PA maximum suction.
- **Motor Speed:** 84000 RPM.
- **Rapid Heat Dissipation:** Prevents motor overheating to extend product life.

Battery and Charging

- **Battery:** Built-in 4000mAh rechargeable Li-ion battery.
- **Runtime:** Up to 30 minutes on a full charge.
- **Charging:** Type-C charging port. Full charge takes approximately 2.5 hours.



Filtration System

- **Dual Filtration:** Uses a combination of a Metal Filter and a HEPA Filter.
- **Metal Filter:** Captures larger particles to protect the vacuum motor.
- **HEPA Filter:** Traps fine dust and allergens. Both filters are washable and reusable.

Design and Portability

- **Weight:** 0.8 lbs (12.8 ounces).

- **Cordless Design:** Allows for flexible movement without power cord restrictions.
- **Built-in LED Light:** Illuminates dark areas for better visibility during cleaning.
- **Dimensions:** 8.14" L x 2.75" W x 7.08" H.



Accessories and Nozzles

The vacuum comes with multiple nozzles and accessories for different applications:

- Suction accessories for focused cleaning.
- Blowing accessories for inflation tasks.



Use Guide

Initial Setup

1. Unpack all components: Vacuum cleaner, accessory kit, metal filter, HEPA filter, Type-C charging cable, and owner's manual.
2. Ensure both the metal and HEPA filters are correctly installed inside the dust cup.
3. Fully charge the vacuum using the provided Type-C cable before first use.

Charging the Vacuum

1. Connect the Type-C charging cable to the port on the vacuum cleaner.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power adapter or computer port.
3. The unit is fully charged when the charging process is complete (approximately 2.5 hours).

Operating the Vacuum

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button to turn the vacuum on. Press again to turn it off.
2. **Selecting Mode:** The unit defaults to suction mode. To use the blow function, attach the appropriate blowing nozzle. The motor will reverse airflow when the blowing accessory is attached and the unit is powered on.
3. **Using the LED Light:** The LED light turns on automatically when the vacuum is powered on to illuminate the cleaning area.
4. **Attaching Nozzles:** Align the desired nozzle with the vacuum's intake and twist or push until it locks securely into place.

Emptying and Cleaning the Dust Cup

1. Turn off and unplug the vacuum.
2. Press the release button or twist the dust cup to detach it from the main body.
3. Empty the collected debris into a trash bin.
4. Remove the metal and HEPA filters for cleaning.

Cleaning the Filters

1. Rinse the metal and HEPA filters under running water. Do not use detergents.
2. Gently tap off excess water and allow both filters to air dry completely before reinstalling.
3. Ensure filters are fully dry to prevent mold and maintain suction power.

Storage

After use and cleaning, store the vacuum and all accessories in a dry place. Due to its compact size, it can be stored in car glove compartments, closets, or under seats.

Troubleshooting

- **Vacuum does not turn on:** Check battery charge level. Ensure the unit is fully charged. Confirm the power button is firmly pressed.
- **Weak suction power:** Check and empty the dust cup. Clean the metal and HEPA filters. Ensure nozzles and filters are properly seated and not clogged.
- **Vacuum stops during use:** The battery may be depleted. Recharge the unit. The motor may have overheated; turn off the vacuum and allow it to cool for 15-20 minutes.
- **LED light does not work:** The light is tied to the main power. If the vacuum runs but the light is off, there may be an internal fault.

Safety Information

- Use only the provided Type-C cable for charging.
- Do not use the vacuum to pick up liquids, burning materials, or sharp, hard objects.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all body parts away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not block the air intakes or exhaust vents during operation.
- Allow the vacuum and battery to cool before charging.
- Store in a dry place, away from extreme heat or cold.
