## Overview and specification of the remote control

### Overview

- Instructions for using the Premium Magic Remote control are in the TV manual. this remote uses RF(Radio Frequency) instead of IR (InfaRed light). this remote will operate

within 10m of the tv and does not require it be pointed at the tv.(voice recognition support)

## Specifications

- Range of frequency 2.400 GHz ~ 2.4835 GHz

- Power source AA 1.5 V, 2 alkaline batteries are used
- Operational temperature range 0 °C ~ 40 °C

## Precautions

1. After replacement of the battery, use the remote control following pairing in accordance with user manual.
2. If the unit does not operate after replacement of battery, reattempt pairing in accordance with the user manual.

4. Do not dismantle or exert heat to the battery.

1. Is this controller compatible with lg 75up7070pud?

- This model is compatible with: 2021: OLED A1, B1, G1, C1, Z1, R1; QNED 90, 91,95, 97, 99; Series Nano (Nano\*\*\*P\*) 75, 80, 81, 85, 86, 88, 90, 91, 96, 99; UP70\*\*, UP71\*\*

(only in some countries) UP75\*\*, UP76\*\*, UP8\*\*\*, UP9\*\*\* 2020: CX, BX, GX, WX, ZX, Series Nano all models Nano 80, 81, 86, 90, 91, 95, 99, UN70\*\*, UN...

2. How to reset the Magic Remote?

- Please press the (Home) button and hold it for 10 seconds.

3. How to connect with the TV?

- Please press the Wheel(OK) on the Magic remote for 5 seconds.

4. How to use the Magic Remote?

- Please refer to the User Manual of your TV.

5. How to pair with Bluetooth device?

- Pairing is required when you want to use Bluetooth function. You can search devices by Bluetooth function in advance. If you want to connect a new device, please search and pair the devices as below.

6. Will this work on the lg up76? (costco version)

- Yes, this remote is compatible with UP7670 models.

7. Will this remotes work for up7000 series led 4k uhd smart webos tv

- Yes, this model Magic Remote control #AN-MRGC will work with the UP7000 TV.

8. Does it work in LG UP7000 ?

- The LG person says the UP7000 doesn't have Bluetooth but mine appears to have Bluetooth capabilities. Also at first startup, my 65UP7000 asked to press the scroll wheel on the magic remote or enter button on the regular. It came with the regular but the TV sure thinks it can use a magic remote.

9. Did this remote have pointer and voice recognition?

- Yes, the Magic Remote control #AN-MR21GC does have a pointer and voice recognition.

10. Can this remote work with the lg nano90 4k uhd (2020)? or is there a way to configure it somehow ?

- Yes, this remote will work with your TV.

11. Is it compatible with the 2012 lg smart tv, model number 47lm7600? i cant seem to find a replacement remote for this tv?

- No, this is a 2021 remote and only supports 2021 models.

12. Will this remote work with 55up7000pua?

- Yes, the #AN-MR21GC Magic Remote control will work with the 55UP7000PUA TV.

13. Is this first party lg, and will it work with oled65c1pub?

- This remote will work with OLED65C1PUB and is an LG original part.

14. Will this work for 75up7070pud lg tv 2021?

- Model 75UP7070PUD does not have Bluetooth connectivity to support a Magic Remote.
