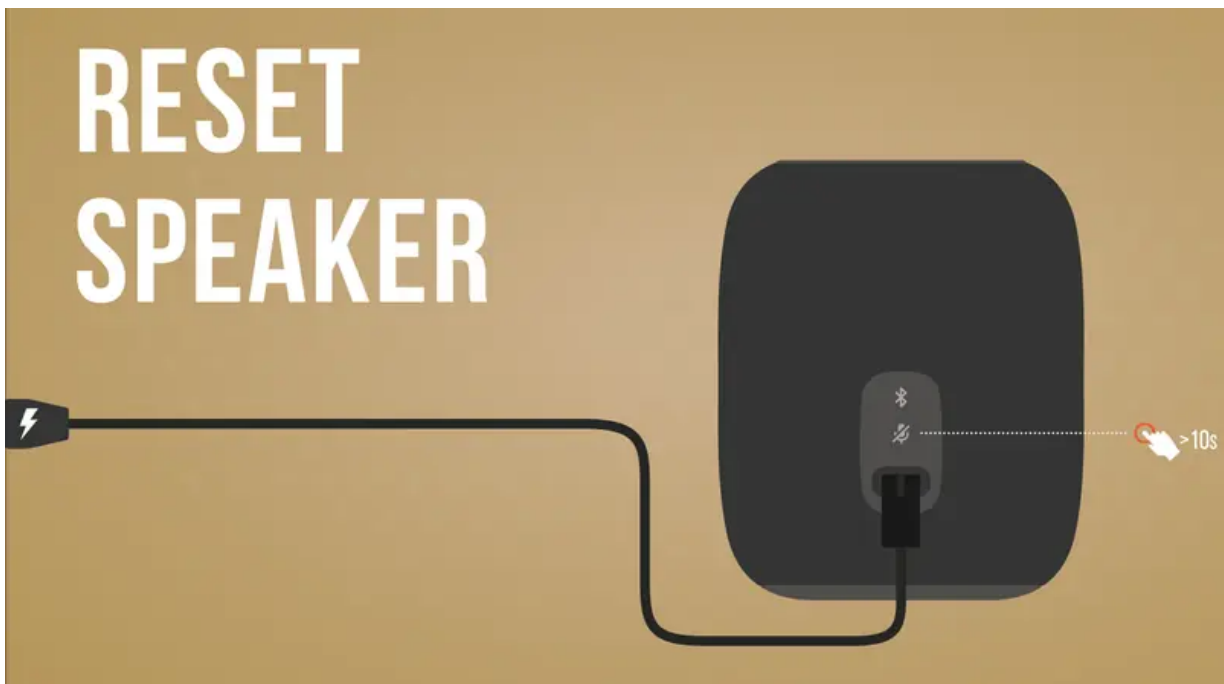


Apple home

1.
